\* This line item is to provide and maintain the Lab Results System. Specifically Ahlers will:

1. Pre-configure the system for selected tests, results and contact protocol. Agencies can add additional tests and change the contact protocol if they wish.
2. Rather than an on-site training day at each agency we will hold 3 to 5 regional training sessions around the state with these fallback options for agency staff who need additional training:
  - a. Webex sessions where we control their system from Texas while simultaneously conducting a conference call.
  - b. Agency staff is supported by our Customer Service staff during implementation.
  - c. An on-site training day is required but it is paid by the agency rather than under this contract. Four training days are included in the RFP and if they are not needed by ODH they could be used for four agencies.
3. We will waive our usual 'per user' licensing agreement.

\*\* This is the first year total. The second year total is \$88,600 which represents the Data Collection and Analysis Services (\$84,000) plus Lab Results Support fees of \$4,600.
