This Requirements Contract is effective beginning and ending on the dates noted above unless, prior to the expiration date, the Contract is renewed, terminated or cancelled in accordance with the Contract Terms and Conditions.

Agencies are eligible to make purchases of the listed supplies and/or services in any amount and at any time as determined by the agency. The State makes no representation or guarantee that agencies will purchase the volume of supplies and/or services as advertised in the Invitation to Bid.

SPECIAL NOTE: State agencies may make purchases under this Requirements Contract up to \$2500.00 using the state of Ohio payment card. Any purchase that exceeds \$2500.00 will be made using the official state of Ohio purchase order (ADM-0523). Any non-state agency, institution of higher education or Cooperative Purchasing member will use forms applicable to their respective agency.

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SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Supplies will be delivered to the participating agency within seven (7) days after receipt of order and, in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The delivery location will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Acceptance (transfer of title) will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the supplies delivered conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, acceptance shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

MINIMUM ORDER: No order shall be placed against a contract awarded pursuant to this bid for less than one (1) case of eggs.

DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE: The Bidder may be required to submit descriptive literature of the supplies or services being offered. If requested, the literature will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not provided as part of the bid response, the Bidder must provide said literature within ten (10) calendar days after request/notification by the Office of Procurement Services to do so. Any references, that may appear in the descriptive literature, that may alter the terms and conditions and specifications of the bid (e.g. F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change), will not be part of any contract and will be disregarded by the state of Ohio. Failure of the bidder to furnish descriptive literature either as part of their bid response or within the time specified herein will deem the bidder not responsive.

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the State will use the base rate as established in Section IV of the bid specifications and add / subtract the amount bid above or below the based price; then multiply that total by the estimated annual requirements to arrive at a total price per institution. For purpose of evaluation, the base price per case for the week prior to that of bid opening will be used. If the estimated usage is unknown a quantity of one (1) thirty dozen case will be used for evaluation purposes only. Although there will be separate institution awards made, bidders are eligible to receive multiple awards provided he/she is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder meeting all bid specifications and requirements listed for the institution.

CONTRACT AWARD: The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder by institution.

USAGE REPORTS: Every six (6) months the contractor must submit a report (written or on disk) indicating sales generated by this contract. The report shall list usage by customer, by line item, showing the quantities/dollars generated by this contract. The report shall be forwarded to the Office of Procurement Services, 4200 Surface Road, Columbus, OH 43228-1395, Attn: Jennifer Dammeyer, CPPB.

SPECIFICATION

I. SCOPE AND CLASSIFICATION

A. Scope

The purpose of this bid is to obtain contractor(s) to supply fresh shell eggs for food service at state of Ohio institutions. The contractor(s) shall deliver eggs to the institution(s) weekly, every two (2) weeks, monthly, or as otherwise indicated on the bid pricing pages. The term of any contract issued pursuant to this bid shall be approximately three (3) years, from February 28, 2011 through January 31, 2014.

B. Classification

1. Eggs, Fresh Shell, White

- a. Large
- b. Medium

II. APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS

- A. Ohio Revised Code Sections 925.01 to 925.13
- B. U.S. Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act of 1938 (21 U.S.C. 301) and amendments
- C. 21 CFR Part 110
- D. The Current Regulations Governing the Voluntary Grading of Shell Eggs (7 CFR 56) and The U.S. Standards, Grades, and Weight Classes for Shell Eggs (AMS 56)

III. REQUIREMENTS

A. Product Description

1. Shell eggs, fresh, U.S. Grade A
2. Either natural shells or shell protected
3. Product, plant facilities, equipment, and all processing operations must comply with all USDA requirements.
4. Eggs shall be stored and transported under refrigeration, at a temperature not to exceed 45° F.

B. Packaging

1. Eggs shall be packed in new commercial fiber cases.
2. Case capacity
 - a. 30 dozen with 200 psi minimum burst strength or 32 Edge Crush Test (ECT)
 - b. 15 dozen with 175 psi minimum burst strength or 29 Edge Crush Test (ECT)
3. Cases shall be properly sealed with paper tape or cellophane tape. Staples are not acceptable.
4. Case weights shall meet United States weight classes for eggs.

SPECIFICATION (Cont'd)

C. Certification

1. Each case shall bear the USDA Grade A shield.
2. Each case shall bear the USDA contract compliance stamp with certificate number.
3. All deliveries of more than thirty (30) dozen eggs (360 eggs; 1 - 30 dozen case or 2 – 15 dozen cases) shall be accompanied by a USDA grading certificate. Any product not accompanied by a properly executed certificate shall be refused at the destination, shall remain the property of the contractor, and shall be returned at the contractor's expense.
4. Product shall have been graded and stamped not more than five (5) calendar days prior to date of delivery to the institution.
5. The date appearing on the USDA certificate will determine whether the product was inspected within the time limit specified above.

IV. BASE PRICE/TOTAL PRICE

A. Base Price

1. The base price shall be determined by price published each Friday in the Urner Barry's Price-Current. The price utilized shall be the price per dozen listed for White, Midwest, Spot Market.
 - a. If a price is not published on a Friday, due to a holiday, the price for the next business day shall prevail.
2. The Office of Procurement Services shall post to our web site a price advertisement weekly, to advise all concerned parties of the base price per dozen, the base price per 15 dozen case, and the base price per 30 dozen case, for both medium and large eggs, for all weeks of the contract term.
3. The base price for a Friday shall govern the price to be charged for all shipments made the following week.

B. Amount Bid Above or Below the Base Price

1. Bidder(s) may offer an amount to be added to the base price per case (above or +) or may offer an amount to be subtracted from the base price per case (below or -) or may offer "Market" (base price to be total price or 0).
2. Although contractor(s) may pack eggs in either 15 dozen cases or 30 dozen cases, the price to be entered on the bid pricing pages shall be the amount above or below the base price of a 30 dozen case.

C. Total Price

1. Total price per 15 dozen or 30 dozen case for any week shall be determined by the base price as specified in paragraph IV. A. above, adjusted by the price offered on the bid response, as specified in paragraph IV.B. above.

SPECIFICATION (Cont'd)

V. ORDER PROCEDURE

- A. At least seven (7) days prior to the beginning of each month, using institutions shall issue to the contractor a local purchase order.
 - 1. The purchase order shall list the requirements for the coming month, including size and quantity required.
 - 2. The purchase order shall list the delivery date(s).
- B. Upon receipt of the price advisement showing price of eggs for an applicable delivery week, the ordering institution shall issue a purchase order (ADM-524) to the contractor for the delivery made that week. The purchase order shall bear the statement "Do not ship—Confirming order only".
- C. No order shall specify delivery to exceed thirty (30) days beyond the expiration and/or cancellation date of the contract.

VI. DELIVERY

- A. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to contact the using institution(s) for establishment of a delivery schedule which is mutually acceptable.
- B. Institutions shall pay the price in effect at the time of the scheduled delivery.
- C. Delivery shall be made within seven (7) days ARO, if necessary.
- D. Eggs shall be transported to institution(s) under refrigeration, at a temperature not to exceed 45° F.

VII. SPECIAL NOTES

- A. Guaranty: By the signature affixed on page 1 of this bid, contractor guarantees that, as of the date of delivery to the State or the State's agent, the product(s) offered is (are) not adulterated or misbranded within the meaning of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act ("the ACT"), and not an article which may not, under the provisions of section 404, 505, or 512 of the Act, be introduced into interstate commerce.
