This Requirements Contract is effective beginning and ending on the dates noted above unless, prior to the expiration date, the Contract is renewed, terminated or cancelled in accordance with the Contract Terms and Conditions.

This Requirements Contract is available to Ohio Department of Public Safety, Services/OHSP, State institutions of higher education and properly registered members of the Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, as applicable.

Agencies are eligible to make purchases of the listed supplies and/or services in any amount and at any time as determined by the agency. The State makes no representation or guarantee that agencies will purchase the volume of supplies and/or services as advertised in the Invitation to Bid.

SPECIAL NOTE: State agencies may make purchases under this Requirements Contract up to \$2500.00 using the state of Ohio payment card. Any purchase that exceeds \$2500.00 will be made using the official state of Ohio purchase order (ADM-0523). Any non-state agency, institution of higher education or Cooperative Purchasing member will use forms applicable to their respective agency.

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## SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Police motorcycle(s) will be delivered as indicated within sixty to ninety (60-90) days after receipt of order and in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The delivery location will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Acceptance (transfer of title) will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the police motorcycles delivered conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, acceptance shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

Orders for the Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS) Ohio State Patrol (OHSP) are to be delivered to the Ohio State Patrol, Attn: Mr. Dennis Zwyer, Fleet Manager, 1583 Alum Creek Drive, Columbus, OH 43209, other destination within the state of Ohio as specified by the ODPS, or other locations specified by other ordering entities participating in the cooperative purchasing program. Freight and setup charges are to be included in the delivered price of each manufacturer / model bid.

If requested by the ODPS a manufacturer or dealer representative is to be present at the time of delivery. The motorcycles will be inspected at the time of delivery, at the delivery site, by the ODPS. Any motorcycle that shows defects, damage(s) or does not meet the specifications and requirements will not be accepted.

LITERATURE: Descriptive literature and technical data are crucial to the state's evaluation. Therefore, all bidders should submit a complete description, including guaranteed specifications and any or all technical data sufficient, in the opinion of the Office of Procurement Services, to reasonably and properly evaluate all bids. This information should include notations of deviations from specifications and/or additions that will be made to satisfy the specifications furnished with this bid. Any deviations taken from these specifications should be listed on company letterhead, describing in detail, the nature of the deviation. In the event the required literature and information are not submitted with the bid, the bidder will be required to provide the information within five (5) business days after notification. Failure to provide the information within the stated time period will result in the bidder being deemed as not responsive

AUTHORIZED DEALER STATEMENT: Bidders responding to this Invitation to Bid must be an authorized dealer or manufacturer of the police motorcycle brands they are bidding. Bidders should submit a letter with their bid response certifying that they are the manufacturer or an authorized dealer of the manufacturer of the police motorcycles being bid. This certification must be on the manufacturer's letterhead and must be signed by a duly authorized manufacturer's representative. The bidder will be required to provide said certification letter within five (5) business days after notification to the Office of State Purchasing, if it is not submitted with the bid response. Failure to submit the certification letter within the stated time period will result in the bid response being deemed as not responsive.

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the state will evaluate the bid based upon the unit price of the police motorcycles with all equipment installed, operational and adjusted to factory specifications and includes the 36 month warranty.

CONTRACT AWARD: The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

FIRM FIXED-PRICE CONTRACT: The contract is a Firm Fixed-Price Contract. The Contractor(s) is required to provide to the using agency supplies or services at the listed price(s) for the duration of the contract, and any extensions thereto.

**PURCHASE ORDERS:** Purchase Orders for item(s) listed in this contract will be placed directly with the contractor by the ordering agency. All purchases, made by state agencies only, will be placed using the official State of Ohio Purchase Order (ADM-0523). The state will not be obligated to pay for purchases of any supplies or services, made by any other method. No order shall specify delivery to exceed thirty (30) days beyond the expiration, termination, or cancellation date of the contract. A Purchase Order will authorize the contractor to provide the required supplies or services and, upon delivery, acceptance and submission of a proper invoice will obligate the ordering agency to pay for the supplies or services furnished by the contractor.

When applicable, purchase orders may be placed for delivery to the agency on a quarterly basis. Any orders issued prior to the expiration, termination, or cancellation date of the contract, which require delivery up to ninety (90) days beyond the approved expiration, termination, or cancellation date are to be fulfilled by the contractor.

All purchase orders placed against this contract are to contain verbiage exactly as to how the title, delivery instructions, etc. are to read, i.e.:

In addition, list on each purchase order an agency contact person with phone number for dealer questions, delivery notification, etc., as shown above.

**CERTIFICATE OF TITLE:** The title shall be filed by the contractor and delivered to the ordering agency within five (5) days after delivery of the vehicle. NOTE: Multiple titles may require additional time to process. Payment of invoice is not to be delayed awaiting title (see Standard Contract Terms & Conditions, Article III, B).

**ADVERTISEMENT:** Dealer name signs will not be affixed to any part of the delivered police motorcycles and/or equipment.

**VEHICLE DESIGN AND SAFETY:** The vehicles purchased and delivered are to comply with all current (as of time of delivery) U.S. Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS), state regulations, requirements, and other regulations applicable to the design and manufacture of police motorcycles.

**COMPONENTS AND ACCESSORIES:** All components, parts, and accessories furnished to the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) by outside vendors or suppliers are to be properly engineered and assembled into the complete vehicle following all instructions and requirements of the manufacturers of these items.

**SERVICE:** The police motorcycles furnished under this contract will be pre-built and ready to use, completely dealer serviced and conditioned as per the pre-delivery recommendations of the manufacturer. All of the police motorcycles must be prepared for immediate and continuous operation upon delivery. The units shall conform to all current Federal Safety Regulations including the Occupational Safety & Health Administration. All standard equipment not specifically mentioned shall be furnished.

**SERVICE POLICY:** The Contractor shall furnish the Manufacturer's Owner Service Policy with each police motorcycle delivered, or within three (3) days after delivery of the police motorcycles. In addition, the Owner Service Policy shall be recognized and accepted by all authorized dealers within the boundaries of the state of Ohio regardless of the location of the district under which the police motorcycle is operated.

**WARRANTY:** The warranty period will start on the date that the motorcycle is put into service. The Contractor will be responsible for all expenses incurred for pick-up and return, or transportation and/or service calls, for repair of any of the equipment or components thereof, awarded as a result of this bid while said equipment is under warranty.

DELIVERY METHOD: Contractor will indicate, by checking the appropriate box(es) below, which mode of transportation will apply to this contract.

- Bidder/Broker ("The Contractor") or their Sub Contractor will make delivery or be performing services using a vehicle that is owned, leased or rented. Provide Certificate of Insurance documenting automobile liability with a Combined Single Limit of \$500,000.00.
- Goods/Services will be delivered via common carrier.
- No employee or representative of the contractor will have cause to be on state property to make deliveries or to perform services.

USAGE REPORTS: Every six (6) months the contractor must submit a report (written or on disk) indicating sales generated by this contract. The report shall list usage by customer, by line item, showing the quantities/dollars generated by this contract. The report shall be forwarded to the Office of Procurement Services, 4200 Surface Road, Columbus, OH 43228-1395, Attn: Rob Rounds.

COOPERATIVE PURCHASING CONTRACT. This Contract may be relied upon by Ohio institutions of higher education and Ohio political subdivisions. Ohio political subdivisions include any county, township, municipal corporation, school district, conservancy district, township park district, park district created under Chapter 1545 of the Revised Code, regional transit authority, regional airport authority, regional water and sewer district, port authority or any other political subdivision as described in the Ohio Revised Code. To qualify to use this Contract the political subdivision must be currently enrolled in the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program. Purchases made from this Contract by a political subdivision that is not properly registered with the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program will be a violation of law and may be contrary to the political subdivision's competitive bidding requirements. If a political subdivision or institution of higher education relies upon this Contract to issue a purchase order or other ordering document, the political subdivision or institution of higher education "steps into the shoes" of the State under this Contract. The political division's or institution of higher education's order and this Contract are between the Contractor and the political subdivision or institution of higher education. The Contractor must look solely to the political subdivision or institution of higher education for performance, including payment. The Contractor agrees to hold the state of Ohio harmless with regard to political subdivisions and institution of higher education's orders and political subdivision's and institution of higher education's performance. DAS may cancel this Contract and may seek remedies if the Contractor fails to honor its obligations under an order from a political subdivision or institution of higher education.

CONTRACTOR QUARTERLY SALES REPORT. The Contractor must report the quarterly dollar value (in U.S. dollars and rounded to the nearest whole dollar) of the sales, to include both state agencies and political subdivisions, under this Contract by calendar quarter (e.g. January-March, April-June, July-September and October-December). The dollar value of the sale is the price paid by the Contract user for the products and/or services listed on the purchase order or other encumbering document, as recorded by the Contractor.

The Contractor shall be required to report the quarterly dollar value of sales to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) on a form prescribed by DAS. If no sales occur, the Contractor must show zero. The report must be submitted thirty (30) days following the completion of the reporting period.

If the Contractor fails to submit sales reports, falsifies reports or fails to submit sales reports in a timely manner, DAS may terminate or cancel this Contract.

CONTRACTOR REVENUE SHARE. The Contractor must pay the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) a revenue share of the sales transacted under this contract. The Contractor must remit the revenue share in U.S. dollars within thirty (30) days after the end of the quarterly sales reporting period. The revenue share equals 0.75% of the total quarterly sales reported. Contractors must include the revenue share in their prices. The revenue share is included in the award price(s) and reflected in the total amount charged to ordering agencies which includes both state agencies and political subdivisions using this Contract.

The contractor must remit any monies due as the result of the close-out report at the time the close-out report is submitted to DAS. The Contractor must pay the revenue share amount due by check. To ensure the payment is credited properly, the Contractor must identify the check as a "Revenue Share" and include the following information with the payment:

If the full amount of the revenue share is not paid within thirty (30) calendar days after the end of the applicable reporting period, the non-payment constitutes a contract debt to the State. The State may either initiate withholding or setting off payments or employ the remedies available under Ohio law for the non-payment of the revenue share.

If the Contractor fails to pay the revenue share in a timely manner, DAS may terminate or cancel this Contract.

The Contractor shall also submit a close-out report within one hundred and twenty (120) days after the expiration of this Contract. The Contract expires upon the physical completion of the last outstanding task or delivery order of the Contract. The close-out report must cover all sales not shown in the final quarterly report and reconcile all errors and credits. If the Contractor reported all contract sales and reconciled all errors and credits on the final quarterly report, then the Contractor should show zero "0" sales in the close-out report.

## SPECIFICATIONS

### SCOPE:

These specifications define the state's requirements for 2012 motorcycles to be utilized by state agencies and political subdivisions that are members of the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, Cooperative Purchasing program for law enforcement work.

**BRAND SPECIFIC:** The product(s) specified in this bid is/are being bid as Brand Specific. That signifies that no alternates will be accepted for award. Bid is in accordance with the Ohio Administrative Code 123:5-1-10 (I).

The following specifications detail motorcycles that the ODPS intends to purchase for the Ohio State Highway Patrol Motorcycle Unit. The OSHP intends to purchase new police motorcycles. For the purpose of this contract a "new" police motorcycle has never been titled to an individual and does not have more than twenty-five (25) miles on the odometer. The intent of this bid is to acquire an initial 8 police motorcycles for ODPS, additional units may be purchased by political subdivisions that are members of the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, Cooperative Purchasing program. The repair parts must be readily available at the dealer level. Adequate stock of repair parts must be maintained at the national level. Unless otherwise agreed to by the ODPS/OSHP in advance, the Contractor must be able to supply parts within two (2) working days of the request.

The proposed police motorcycle must include all standard equipment for a 2012 police motorcycle at no extra cost including, but not limited to, the following and will be manufactured and sold as a law enforcement specific vehicle:

#### A. Engine:

- The engine will be the Harley-Davidson standard 103ci/1690cc Electra Glide engine.
- Air cooled;
- Overhead valve;
- Two (2) cylinder;
- Belt or shaft driven camshafts; and
- Fuel injection system.
- Minimum of eighty-five (85) foot pounds of torque.

#### B. Police Performance Package to include the following:

- Screamin' Eagle ® Twin Cam Performance Cam - Se 255 cam kit (Part #25638-07)
- Screamin' Eagle ® High Performance Inner Cam Bearings (Part #24018-10)

#### C. Clutch & transmission:

- Nine (9) plate wet clutch or dry, single-plate design requiring disengagement for starter motor operation;
- Low effort hand levers; and
- Six (6) forward speeds.

#### D. Dimensions:

- Length: maximum of ninety-three and seven tenths inches (93.7"); minimum of eighty-seven and eight tenths inches (87.8");
- Height: maximum of sixty-one inches (61.0"); minimum of fifty-six and three tenths inches (56.3");
- Ground Clearance: five and one tenths inches (5.1"), and;
- Wheelbase: maximum of sixty-three and five tenths inches (63.5"); minimum of fifty-eight and four tenths inches (58.4").

#### E. Exhaust:

- Chrome or stainless steel; and
- Dual exhaust system or two into one exhaust system.

F. Brakes:

- Disc brakes for both front and rear wheels; and
- Anti-lock braking system.

G. Suspension system:

- Designed to permit optimum handling conditions suitable for law enforcement;
- Inclusive of telescopic front forks with cartridge style damping; and
- Rear air-adjustable shocks.

H. Wheels & Tires:

- Cast aluminum wheels; and
- Bead retention, four-ply, tubeless highway tires designed to remain on the wheel during a sudden loss of air pressure.

I. Fuel system:

- Minimum fuel tank capacity of six (6) U.S. gallons with a minimum of one (1) gallon of reserve fuel capacity;

- Twelve (12) volt starter: solenoid operated engagement with relay.

K. Lighting: vendor should just provide base light package which is the engine guard lights (TIR-6's) and front red and blue flashing warning lights

- Quartz halogen headlight: fifty-five (55) watt low beam and sixty (60) watt high beam, white;
- Turn signals: self-canceling type;
- Flashers: four-way, integrated into turn signal switches or other separate switch; and
- Harley-Davidson brake light conversion kit (part number 69461-06).

L. Other:

- Electronic ignition;
- Industrial grade, high quality electrical accessory connectors;
- Water-resistant switches; and
- Horn: sound level audible above motorcycle and traffic noise for a minimum of two hundred (200) feet.

M. Visual Displays:

1) Gauges:

- Speedometer: analog or digital, calibrated, range 0-130 miles per hour (mph), re-settable trip meter;
- Odometer: calibrated, cumulative;
- Tachometer;
- Fuel level gauge; and
- Oil pressure or oil temperature indicator or gauge.

2) Indicators:

- Pursuit lamp indicator;
- Sight glass on brake master cylinders;
- Low fuel indicator lamp;
- Turn signal indicators;
- Neutral indicator;
- High beam indicator; and
- Engine diagnostic light.

SPECIFICATIONS (cont.)

N. Seat:

- Deluxe solo air saddle, special police type;
- Breathable material covering; and
- Single air bladder suspension with reservoir and integral gauge.
- Seat laden height: twenty-seven and three tenths (27.3) inches minimum, thirty-three and two tenths (33.2) inches maximum.

O. Service:

- Set-up and labor: removal and disposal of delivery crate, windshield installation, addition of fluids, battery hook up, clean up, et cetera.
- Intervals: first six hundred (600) to one thousand (1000) miles and then every five thousand (5000) or six thousand (6000) miles thereafter, depending on manufacturer's recommendation.

P. Weight:

- Gross vehicle weight rating: minimum of one thousand, eighty-nine (1089) pounds;
- Dry Weight: eight hundred forty-nine (849) pounds maximum, six hundred seventy-nine (679) pounds minimum.

Q. Fairing and windshield:

- Fork mounted fairing; and
- Breakaway Tinted Lexan ® Windshield, 10" Mid Profile (Part #58302-96).

R. Saddlebags:

- Factory installed;
- Injection molded fiberglass;
- Water resistant; and
- Law enforcement type Injection Molded GTX, opens on the top using police style speed latches.

S. Exterior

- Side stand: jiffy stand, rubber bumper design, and interlock;

T. Performance

Standard equipment, including trim, decals, and emblems, are not to be removed from the police motorcycle, unless specified or requested. Each motorcycle is to be delivered with an owner's manual, a full tank of fuel, and with the low maintenance electrolyte battery installed. Upon delivery each police motorcycle shall be clean, serviced, conditioned, and ready for immediate and continuous operation. If the product offered does not conform to the stated specifications, the Bidder must document on their letterhead how non-compliance with the specification will affect the overall performance of the fully functional 2012 Harley-Davidson Model FLHTP Electra Glide Police Motorcycle. The Bidder must describe in detail and provide additional descriptive literature as necessary to explain/justify the exception to the specification.

The State may, at its sole discretion, request a demonstration of the product of the Bidder.

Bidders shall not insert a unit cost more than 3 digits after the decimal point. Digit(s) beyond 3, after the decimal point, shall be dropped by the Office of State Purchasing and not used in the evaluation and any subsequent award.
