PROPOSALS WILL BE OPENED IN THE SECOND FLOOR CONFERENCE ROOM OF 2045 (BUILDING H-2) OF THE FOUNTAIN SQUARE OFFICES OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES. The United States Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement is supplying 100% of the funds for this project. The construction completion date for this project is September 30, 2010. THE ESTIMATE FOR THIS PROJECT AS DETERMINED BY THE DIVISION OF MINERAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT IS \$88,323.02.

**A MANDATORY pre-bid meeting will be held on APRIL 7, 2010 AT 10:00 A.M., at the project site.** It is the intent of the DMRM to commence the pre-bid meeting at the designated time. Prior to commencement of the meeting, an attendance sign-in form shall be distributed among the contractors present. This form will be collected by DMRM staff when the pre-bid meeting begins. Only those contractors signed in prior to collection of the form who remain in attendance through the discussion of the plans and detailed specifications shall be deemed present for the purpose of determining eligibility for bid submission acceptance. Participation in the site viewing subsequent to the completion of the discussion of the detailed specifications will not be required in establishing attendance. **NO PLANS OR SPECIFICATIONS WILL BE SOLD AT THE PRE-BID MEETING.**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION  
FOR  
FRY LANDSLIDE  
MEIGS COUNTY, OHIO  
PROJECT NUMBER MG-Sb-75**

The project is located in Salisbury Township, Meigs County, Ohio. From the intersection of SR7 and CR 5 (Bradbury Rd), travel west on Bradbury Rd 1.0 mile and turn left onto TW Rd 174 (Noble-Summit Rd). Then travel 0.23 mile to TW Rd 195 (Neece Rd), and the project is 0.42 mile, and located at 30877 Neece Road, Middleport, OH 45760.

This project is a reconstruction of the Fry site completed in 2005 under the “SEO Ohio Underground Project”. The original project attempted to stabilize the landslide by improving drainage and off-loading saturated material. The original project drained the mining pit, installed an underdrain in the pit bottom and in the toe of the landslide, installed a rock channel and lateral diversions and closed two mine entries. The underdrains have failed to capture all of the subsurface drainage and the slope continues to slowly move. The landslide threatens the Fry home at the base of the slope.


Reclamation of the Fry site will include stabilizing the landslide by installing three new deeper underdrains (totaling 860 LF) to collect the subsurface water. The design includes the installation of three new diversion ditches (totaling 622 LF) to transfer surface water to the existing rock ditch. The excavated trench material will be wasted on site and included in the final grading plan, to include correcting a small rotation slump (approx 250 CY). The project also requires installing and/or repairing up to 200 (LF) of  $\frac{3}{4}$ ” waterline. The entire disturbed area (2 AC) will be reseeded and mulched immediately upon completion of the final grading.




**FRY LANDSLIDE**

 Middleport, Oh 45760




MEIGS COUNTY

**Directions to the site:**

-From the West, travel North on SR7 to the intersection of SR7/CR5 (Bradbury Rd) and turn left. Continue on Bradbury Rd for 1.0 mile and turn left on to Tw Rd 174 (Noble-Summit Rd). Proceed 0.23 mile and turn left on to Tw Rd 195 (Neece Rd), the project is at 30877 Neece Rd.

-From the East, at the intersection of U.S.33/SR7 travel South on SR7 4.85 miles to County Road 5 (Bradbury Rd) and turn right. Continue on Bradbury Rd for 1.0 mile and turn left on to Tw Rd 174 (Noble-Summit Rd). Proceed 0.23 mile and turn left on to Tw Rd 195 (Neece Rd), the project is at 30877 Neece Rd.
