The Department of Administrative Services has accepted Proposals submitted in response to Request for Proposal (RFP) No. CSP900215 that opened on 3/28/14. The evaluation of the Proposal responses has been completed. The Offeror listed herein has been determined to be the highest ranking Offeror and has been awarded a Contract for the services listed. The respective Proposal response including, Contract Terms & Conditions, any Proposal amendment, special Contract Terms & Conditions, specifications, pricing schedules and any attachments incorporated by reference and accepted by DAS become a part of this Services Contract.

This Requirements Contract is effective beginning and ending on the dates noted above unless, prior to the expiration date, the Contract is renewed, terminated, or cancelled in accordance with the Contract Terms and Conditions.

This Requirements Contract is available to the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, all State Agencies, State institutions of higher education and properly registered members of the Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, as applicable.

The agency is eligible to make purchases of the contracted services in any amount and at any time as determined by the agency. The State makes no representation or guarantee that department will purchase the volume of services as advertised in the Request for Proposal.

SCOPE OF WORK

Objective:

This RFP is to solicit Proposals for In-Vessel Composters to be used at our institutions to compost food waste and divert it from the landfill by producing quality compost for use on farm fields. This includes the purchase of the composter, training, installation/assistance and warranty. Listed in section 7.0 Supplement A Service Requirement of this document are the food waste quantities that illustrate the volume which will need to be composted.

The Offeror should submit a Work Plan with its Proposal to demonstrate and/or describe how it will meet the following requirements. Failure to demonstrate may result in a lower possible Technical Score.

- a) Compost will be of high quality and ready to use and no further methods needed to break down materials (e.g., wind rows);
- b) Minimal chemicals or additives are needed in the composting process and minimal staff supervision, as well as, hands-on dealing with process;
- c) System will utilize minimum maintenance, repairs and upkeep;
- d) Provide a safe and secure environment, as this vessel will be placed within institutions and offenders will have access to the equipment. (Prison Package);
- e) How energy consumption is minimal for this type of equipment/use so that this can fit into the ODRC energy conservation program;
- f) Operator control panel is available to view temperature and display settings in order to monitor progress;
- g) Equipment is stainless steel for durability and ease of cleaning;
- h) Proper ventilation for equipment in order to eliminate odors to avoid complaints regarding this matter;
- i) Ability to install indoors and/or outdoors due to best space utilization;
- j) Ability for a continuous feed of food waste due to the facilities having a 3 times a day 7 days a week feeding schedule;
- k) Life expectancy of the machine will be a minimum of twenty (20) years in order to provide for the best return on investment available and warranty manages most risks to ODRC during the full lifetime of the unit;
- l) Ability to train staff and offenders on the operation, as well as, preventative maintenance of equipment in order to maintain the upkeep and proper monitoring needed;
- m) Aspects of assembly and production of equipment that can be completed in-house by ODRC in order to train offenders in such technology;
- n) Reasonable return on investment though life cycle of equipment;
- o) Provide dimensions of the equipment in order to best evaluate the system being offered;
- p) Provide Preparation, delivery, installation and support due to DRC not having capabilities for movement, installation and support of equipment.

The installation will be done by the prison staff and offenders as specified in the technical proposal and RFP questions and answers at question #30865. EC ALL Ltd will approve of the installation and sign the installation letter which will also be signed by the Agency Project Representative.

The State is responsible for the following costs

- Arranging accessibility for the machines to be transported from site of unloading to site of installation within prison grounds (site specific).
- Preparation of installation site; including but not limited to moving items/machinery currently installed in order to make space for Big Hanna, make holes in walls for ventilation & drainage piping, making available electricity to installation site, arranging a washable concrete floor, construct cover over machinery (if installed outdoors), piping outside over roof tops etc. (site specific).
- Purchase of necessary piping and cables (site specific).
- Installation work; connect machine to electricity, ventilation and drainage, remove plastic cover, leveling etc. – Circa 6-8 hours.
- Biofilter (manufactured by Noble Correctional Institution), including media (bark, wood chips).
- 2-3 staff present at basic training covering all shifts – 2 hours minimum.
- Operation of equipment according to operator manual.
- Pellets (or sawdust) for operation of the composter.

Pricelist for all others

The following is a pricelist for all other agencies and/or Coops. Note that generally, unloading, delivery and positioning at site will be quoted separately since we only have information for the five (5) different locations specified in the RFP (per RFP p. 13 – 7.0 Supplement A – Service Requirement). Thus, for the general pricelist, installation would be quoted separately from EC ALL Ltd since non-DRC sites, i.e. a school may possibly not have available staff for installation like they have at ODRC sites.
