The ORM is requesting that broker services be proposed on a fee basis. The Offeror's response must clearly present the Offeror's compensation of fee structure for specified core services along with rates for optional services as available.

The State seeks an all-inclusive cost structure that will allow predictability of fees and accuracy in budget planning. The Offeror's plan of compensation for insurance placement and consulting services shall be described in detail, on a flat annual fee basis. The Offeror shall describe in detail the maximum fee for all services the State may elect to purchase.

Any additional services must be individually priced but Offerors should also provide bundling options for these elective services such that there is (1) a fee for core services, (2) a fee for core services plus additional services recommended by the Offeror for the State creating a mid-level price structure, and (3) a fee for full-service, which would be one fee for the core level services plus all additional services.

The successful broker will be required to disclose in detail all compensation received from any source resulting from the marketing of insurance programs for the State. The proposal shall include a clear statement of the services for which compensation would be in the form of fees paid by the State and to what extent, if any, compensation would rely upon commissions paid by underwriters.

There will be no additional reimbursement for travel or other related expenses not included in the Not to Exceed Costs
