The respective Proposal response including, Contract Terms & Conditions, any Proposal amendment, special Contract Terms & Conditions, specifications, pricing schedules and any attachments incorporated by reference and accepted by DAS become a part of this Services Contract.

This Requirements Contract is effective beginning and ending on the dates noted above unless, prior to the expiration date, the Contract is renewed, terminated, or cancelled in accordance with the Contract Terms and Conditions.

MUTUALLY AGREED UPON CLARIFICATIONS AND REVISIONS

Envirotest will operate the following eleven (11) existing E-Check testing stations utilizing one certified inspector per operating lane:

1. 01 - Westlake
2. 02 – Berea
3. 03 – North Royalton
4. 10 – Euclid
5. 11 – Willoughby
6. 12 – Painesville
7. 13 – Chardon
8. 14 – Auburn
9. 16 – Kent
10. 17 – Twinsburg
11. 22 – Spencer

The remaining twelve (12) existing E-Check stations will be operated with an appropriate combination of “OBDII-only” inspection lanes staffed by one certified inspector per operating OBDII-only lane and “tailpipe” testing lanes staffed by at least two certified inspectors per operating lane.

Third-party environmental auditing services are removed from the Scope of Work.

The current customer comment card program and practices that are followed in the existing E-Check program will continue to be followed in the new E-Check program rather than requiring an independent third party to obtain and compile the associated customer feedback comments.

Public Education Program: A minimum of \$3.0 million in public education expenditures must be spent during the length of the Contract, including the costs associated with the monthly inspection notices that must be mailed for the extent of the program to each motorist sixty (60) days prior to his or her registration expiration in the year in which the motorist is required to test in the motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program.
