Labor Rate Notes:

1. Standard Time (ST) will consist of a standard, 40 hour week. Work performed on a mobilization in excess of 40 hours/week/site if Overtime (OT) and is chargeable at Time-and-one-half (1.5 X ST rate). Work performed on State and National Legal Holidays is chargeable at Double Time (DT) (2.0 X ST rate). All time charged for ST must be related to work at actions under this Contract. Hours counting toward OT must be accumulated at a specific site (for cost recovery purposes). OT and DT must be approved in advance by the Contract Administrator or the Ohio EPA Project Coordinator. Unapproved OT or DT will be reimbursed at ST rates.
2. All travel related expenses will be reimbursed in accordance with the Office of Budget and Management's travel rules as set forth in Ohio Administrative Code Rule 126-1-02. Copies of receipts for expenses are required for reimbursement. When an overnight stay is necessary there will be no mileage charge or travel time charged prior to arriving on-site or beginning site related activities, e.g. errands necessary for site work.
3. Mobilization/demobilization costs for personnel shall be at Standard Time rates as listed above. No charge shall be made for personnel travel time or mileage while commuting to and from a job site.
4. No portion of an equipment operator's time or subsistence allowance may be charged for that portion of a day during which the operator's equipment is inoperable due to mechanical failure.
5. Attendance at public meetings, testimony, etc. will be reimbursed at rates consistent with labor categories as listed above.

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ENVIRONMENTAL DRILLING AND SAMPLING

Charges associated with drilling and other intrusive activities not listed in this rate schedule will be billed to the Ohio EPA at a rate as the charge accrued by the Contractor for the service rendered. This includes but is not limited to the use of hollow stem auger, rotary, roto-sonic, direct-push and cable tool type drill rigs for the purpose of but not limited to the installation of monitoring wells, subsurface sampling, geological profiling, etc. The allowable charge shall be the subcontractor's invoice for the completed task, inclusive of all applicable time and material, plus the applicable markup as proposed on the Cost Summary Form, Attachment Ten.

WASTE PICKUP/TRANSPORTATION

Charges associated with waste pickup and waste transportation, not listed in this rate schedule will be billed to the Ohio EPA at a rate as proposed on the Cost Summary Form, page 22 of the Request for Proposals, not greater than 12% of the charge accrued by the Contractor for the service rendered. The allowable charge shall be the subcontractor's invoice for the completed task, inclusive of all applicable time and material, plus the applicable markup.

WASTE DISPOSAL

Charges associated with the disposal, treatment and/or storage of waste material generated resulting from work under this contract not listed in this rate schedule will be billed to the Ohio EPA at the charge accrued by the Contractor for the service rendered. The allowable charge shall be the subcontractor's invoice for the completed task, inclusive of all applicable time and material. All waste must be managed, accumulated and stored in accordance with all federal, state and local laws and regulations.

Vendors that own or operate a treatment, storage or disposal facility shall provide a separate rate schedule listing the unit cost for treatment, storage, and disposal for materials that the facility is permitted to accept.

Notes for Waste Disposal:

1. Charges for disposal will not be paid until actual disposal is confirmed by a manifest showing location and invoice cost of disposal.
2. The proper selection of a disposal facility shall be documented in the response action final report.

Notes for Waste Storage:

1. Containers smaller than thirty (30) gallons containing compatible wastes must be consolidated in fifty-five (55) gallon overpack drums.
2. All other details (e.g. quantity, duration, non-permitted waste) shall be addressed in the Site-Specific Work Plan (SSWP).

CHEMICAL TESTING AND ANALYSIS

All analytical costs shall be borne directly by the Ohio EPA. All chemical sampling shall be done via the methods specified in the Site-Specific Work Plan and shall conform to procedures outlined in the Site-Specific Quality Assurance Plan. Vendor will submit samples to the designated Laboratory approved by Ohio EPA.

Vendor will coordinate sampling events with the Ohio EPA designated Project Coordinator prior to submitting samples. No markup will be permitted for samples sent to the Ohio EPA Laboratory.

All chemical testing and analysis not performed by the Ohio EPA contract laboratory shall be done via the methods and the detection limits specified in the Site-Specific Work Plan and shall conform to procedures outlined in the Site-Specific Quality Assurance Plan. Turn-Around-Time (TAT) shall be calculated from the date of receipt of the samples by the laboratory to the postmark date on the results. Normal TAT is considered 28 days, however faster TAT may be requested with approval of the Contract Administrator.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

For all work under this contract requiring less than two (2) hours working time at the location of the response action, the Vendor shall be compensated for all personnel and equipment mobilized as if said working time had been two (2) hours. Items billable as daily rates, only, will be billed at the daily rate.

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The State of Ohio is exempt from federal excise and all Ohio state and local taxes. The State does not agree to pay any taxes on commodities or services acquired from any Vendor. However, the State may reimburse the Vendor for taxes incurred from a third party.

Brand names, trade names, manufacturer's names, and/or catalog numbers listed in this Rate Schedule are used only for the purpose of description and to establish a base level of quality. Items considered to be of equal or better quality may be offered and/or utilized.
