Revised

A. Statement of Needs:

The successful bidder will furnish all labor (and tools necessary) to install fifteen (15) Food Pass Kits in existing security doors **at the Ohio River Valley Juvenile Correctional Facility**, address as listed on page one of this bid request. The installation will include a cylinder food pass lock and food pass hinges with the 90 degree stop. The successful bidder must use a Detention Equipment Contractor as the provider of materials. Space within the maintenance shop will be made available for the contractor as well as ORVJCF staff assistance for transporting doors from the unit to the workshop. Staff will also assist in transporting doors from the workshop, back to the unit, as well as re-hinging and repainting. Hours of operations are Monday-Friday, 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

The successful bidder should also price labor and material to make necessary adjustments to existing cuff port locks. Installation of new Food Passes shall not exceed 15 doors. The number of existing doors to be modified shall not exceed 60.

The contractor will cut an opening in 15 youth rooms' doors that are approximately 20 x 5 inches. Contractor will then install the 15 cuff-ports (door flaps) on the exterior and attach an inset to the flap. The two pieces will be welded together. ORVJCF will furnish the door lock that is to also be installed.

** In addition, the successful bidder shall provide two (2) steel vantage-wall detention doors with ¼" rods woven 2" ssq. Opg. In a 12-gauge steel frame, prepared for hardware as supplied by others, cuff-port opening with a baked polyester powder finish.*

Site Visit: Bidders should contact the project representative listed on the first page to arrange for a site visit.

Start Date: Bidders should indicate the number of days required to begin and finish the project after receipt of an order (ARO). Begin/completion time quoted may be a factor in award of this bid.

Evaluation of bids: Award will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder as determined by ODYS under the Ohio Revised Code.
