This Requirements Contract is available to the Ohio State Racing Commission (OSRC) as applicable.

Agencies are eligible to make purchases of the listed services in any amount and at any time as determined by the agency. The State makes no representation or guarantee that agencies will purchase the volume of services as advertised in the Request for Proposal.

Contract Requirement Synopsis: This section gives only a summary of the Project Requirements. The Contractor shall provide:

- All personnel, equipment, and supplies necessary to meet the collection, testing, and reporting requirements. This does not include the veterinarians.
- Test result records and chain of custody documentation.
- Summary reports.
- Qualified staff persons for evidentiary hearings, court proceedings, and OSRC periodic meetings.
- Maintenance program for all laboratory functional requirements/equipment.
- Required instruments and equipment.
- A Quality Assurance Program and resultant record keeping requirements.
- All items necessary for the collection and shipping of samples.
- OSRC pre-approved courier companies only.
- Systems/reports to communicate all test results.

RFP Response Clarifications – OSRC Equine and Human Drug Testing Services

1. The Contractor agrees to the payment terms as described in Attachment Three, Part One of the RFP. The Contractor shall submit a monthly invoice with costs based on the number of samples collected during the month multiplied by the cost per sample according to the type of sample (i.e. post-race urine sample, post-race blood sample, TCO2 test sample, or human sample).
2. The Contractor affirms that Soobeng Tan has been designated as the key contact person for this Contract, agrees that he shall continue in that capacity except as provided below, and shall use all reasonable efforts to ensure his continued availability. The Contractor reserves the right to remove Soobeng Tan or other named persons from the Project if it is deemed necessary for legal or disciplinary reasons.
 - a. The Contractor agrees that it shall notify the OSRC immediately in the event that Soobeng Tan is no longer available or able to function in this capacity.
 - b. The Contractor agrees that it shall seek qualified personnel to replace Soobeng Tan in the event that he is no longer available or able to function as the key contact person. The Contractor agrees that it will submit any successor candidates to the State for approval prior to hiring.
3. EQUINE TESTING: Every horse urine or blood sample submitted to the official laboratory shall be tested to detect the presence, of prohibited substances, regardless of concentration.
4. HUMAN TESTING: The laboratory shall identify and determine concentrations of amphetamine, methamphetamine, benzoylecgonine, barbiturates, benzodiazepines and their metabolites, opiates, phencyclidine, and marijuana metabolites in urine samples collected from humans.

EQUINE TESTING: Every horse urine or blood sample submitted to the official laboratory shall be tested to detect the presence, of prohibited substances, regardless of concentration.

HUMAN TESTING: The laboratory shall identify and determine concentrations of amphetamine, methamphetamine, benzoylecgonine, barbiturates, benzodiazepines and their metabolites, opiates, phencyclidine, and marihuana metabolites in urine samples collected from humans.

Cost per human sample tested: \$ 100.00

Costs for this program begin on July 1, 2007 (FY 2008) and shall be based upon a cost per sample basis as indicated above. The State is not willing to renegotiate the cost per sample if the number of samples collected and tested falls below the estimated numbers.
