Page 33 – Off-Shore Services

Remove the last sentence of the last paragraph.

Page 35 – State Personnel

Replace “Contractor” with “The Ohio Colleges of Medicine Government Resource Center.”

Page 37 – Suspension and Termination

Paragraph 4 – Remove “...and will indemnify the State for any liability to them.”

Page 37 – Contract Remedies

Replace this section with: To the extent permitted by Ohio law, including but not limited to the Ohio Constitution, Ohio Revised Code Chapter 2743 et seq. and Ohio Revised Code Section 3345.40, the Contractor agrees to be responsible for those damages or losses which arise directly from the negligent acts or omissions of Contractor employees in performance of the agreement, as may be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction.

Page 44 – General Warranties

Paragraph 3 – Remove all references to indemnification.

Page 45 – Indemnity

Replace this section with: To the extent permitted by Ohio law, including but not limited to the Ohio Constitution, Ohio Revised Code Chapter 2743 et seq. and Ohio Revised Code Section 3345.40, the Contractor agrees to be responsible for those damages or losses which arise directly from the negligent acts or omissions of Contractor employees in performance of the agreement, as may be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction.
