The Department of Administrative Services has accepted bids submitted in response to Invitation to Bid No. OT908009 that opened on 03/27/09. The evaluation of the bid response(s) has been completed. The bidder(s) listed herein have been determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder(s) and have been awarded a contract for the items(s) listed. The respective bid response, including the [Terms and Conditions for Bidding, Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, and Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions](#), special contract terms & conditions, any bid addenda, specifications, pricing schedules and any attachments incorporated by reference and accepted by DAS become a part of this Requirements Contract.

This Requirements Contract is effective beginning and ending on the dates noted above unless, prior to the expiration date, the Contract is renewed, terminated or cancelled in accordance with the Contract Terms and Conditions.

This Requirements Contract is available to State Library of Ohio 274 East First Avenue Suite 100, Columbus, OH, 43201, as applicable.

Agencies are eligible to make purchases of the listed supplies and/or services in any amount and at any time as determined by the agency. The State makes no representation or guarantee that agencies will purchase the volume of supplies and/or services as advertised in the Invitation to Bid.

SPECIAL NOTE: State agencies may make purchases under this Requirements Contract up to \$2500.00 using the state of Ohio payment card. Any purchase that exceeds \$2500.00 will be made using the official state of Ohio purchase order (ADM-0523). Any non-state agency, institution of higher education or Cooperative Purchasing member will use forms applicable to their respective agency.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

SPECIFICATION QUESTIONS: Through the indicated inquiry closure date, Bidders may visit the State Purchasing website to post Bid related questions at <www.ohio.gov/procure>. Answers to all Bidder questions will be posted on the State Purchasing website and linked to the Bid number. The State will make every effort to respond to website inquires within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt. The State will not respond to any verbal or written questions received through any other medium. No prospective Bidder shall respond to any verbal instructions or changes to this Bid. Only communications issued by the Department of Administrative Services, State Purchasing in the form of an addendum, will be considered valid.

MANDATORY/REQUIRED SUBMISSIONS: As specified, mandatory submissions must be submitted with the Bid Response. Required documentation/materials should be submitted with the Bid. If not submitted with the Bid, the Bidder must provide the said documentation/materials within five (5) business days, after notification, to the Office of Procurement Services. Failure to provide mandatory submissions with the Bid Response or failure to provide the required documentation/materials, as applicable, within the stated time period may result in the Bidder being deemed as not responsive.

For specific submission requirements, Bidders should refer to the Bid Submission Check List for a listing of those mandatory submissions due with the Bid Response and those other submissions that should be submitted with the Bid Response, but which do not become mandatory until requested during the Bid evaluation period.

DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE: The Bidder may be required to submit descriptive literature of the supplies or services being offered. If requested, the literature will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder. If not provided as part of the Bid Response, the Bidder must provide said literature within ten (10) calendar days after request/notification by the Office of Procurement Services to do so. Any references, that may appear in the descriptive literature, that may alter the terms and conditions and specifications of the Bid (e.g. F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change), will not be part of any Contractor and will be disregarded by the State of Ohio. Failure of the Bidder to furnish descriptive literature either as part of their Bid Response or within the time specified herein will deem the Bidder not responsive.

PRODUCT SAMPLES: The Bidder(s) may be required to submit samples of the supplies being offered. The samples will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder. If not included as part of their Bid Response, the Bidder will be required to provide the samples within ten (10) calendar days after notification. Failure to provide the samples within the stated time period will result in the Bidder being deemed not responsive. After award of the Contract, the samples will be used as a basis of comparison with actual product delivered under Contractor. Any variation between the samples and product being delivered will be considered as an event of default. Any variations between the samples and actual product being delivered that are due to manufacturer changes may be acceptable and shall require prior written approval from DAS.

INCURRED COSTS: The State is not liable for any costs incurred by the Bidder prior to issuance of a Contract.

SPECIAL CHARGES: There shall be no assessment, surcharge, small order charge, broken case charge, minimum order charge, single item charge nor any other unspecified additional charge allowed by the State that is not specifically mentioned in this Bid or in any Contract awarded pursuant to this Bid. The Contractor must provide merchandise/service in unit quantity(s) as indicated in the Bid/Bid Response/Contract.

TRANSPORTATION CHARGES: All transportation costs shall be the responsibility of the awarded Contractor.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Services will be performed as set forth in the Contract and in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The location of performance will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Payment for services rendered will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the services provided conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, payment shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: In the event that an awarded Contractor fails to perform within the timeframe specified by the Contract and/or purchase order, the agency will contact the Contractor to determine when the purchase order will be fulfilled. If the Contractor cannot fulfill the purchase order requirements within a timeline acceptable to the agency, the agency may procure like-kind supplies/services from another resource and invoice the Contractor for the full additional amount charged by the third party provider. Invoices for said liquidated damages must be deducted from subsequent Contractor invoices prior to payment by the agency.

Under these damage recovery provisions, the agency may: (1) elect to procure any portion of the original order from another source; and/or (2) charge the Contractor for any difference in cost for the service/merchandise procured; and/or (3) cancel any portion of the original order without Contractor penalty. Also reference Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions, Article S-9, Time of Delivery, and Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Section II, Contract Remedies.

FIXED-PRICE WITH ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT: The Contract prices(s) will remain firm for the first twelve (12) months duration of the Contract. Thereafter, the Contractor may submit a request to increase their price(s) to be effective thirty (30) calendar days after acceptance by DAS. No price adjustment will be permitted prior to the effective date of the increase received by the Contractor from his suppliers, or on purchase orders that are already being processed, or on purchase orders that have been filled and are awaiting shipment. If the Contractor receives orders requiring quarterly delivery, the increase will apply to all deliveries made after the effective date of the price increase.

The price increase must be supported by a general price increase in the cost of the finished supplies, due to increases in the cost of raw materials, labor, freight, Workers' Compensation and/or Unemployment Insurance, etc. Detailed documentation, to include a comparison list of the Contract items and proposed price increases, must be submitted to support the requested increase. Supportive documentation should include, but is not limited to: copies of the old and the current price lists or similar documents which indicate the original base cost of the product to the Contractor and the corresponding increase, and/or copies of correspondence sent by the Contractor's supplier on the supplier's letterhead, which contain the above price information and explains the source of the increase in such areas as raw materials, freight, fuel or labor, etc.

Should there be a decrease in the cost of the finished product due to a general decline in the market or some other factor, the Contractor is responsible to notify DAS immediately. The price decrease adjustment will be incorporated into the Contract and will be effective on all purchase orders issued after the effective date of the decrease. If the price decrease is a temporary decrease, such should be noted on the invoice. In the event that the temporary decrease is revoked, the Contract pricing will be returned to the pricing in effect prior to the temporary decrease. For quarterly deliveries, any decrease will be applied to deliveries made after the effective date of the decrease. Failure to comply with this provision will be considered as a default and will be subject to Provision I.C. "Termination/Suspension" and Provision II. of the "Contract Remedies:" of the "Standard Contract Terms and Conditions".

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the State will determine the annual lot total cost by summing the List Prices together to get the Total List Price. The analyst will then determine the annual lot total cost by multiplying the Total List Price by the Service Charge percentage for years 1 and 2 to determine the Service Charge Cost. The Total List Prices are then added to the calculated Service Charge Cost for years 1 and 2 to determine the Total Charge each year. The two year totals will be added together to determine the low Bid. Failure to Bid all items may result in the Bidder being deemed not responsive. Years 3-5 will not be included in the evaluation.

CONTRACT AWARD: The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder by low lot total.

***CONTRACT RENEWAL:** The expected term of the Contract is for a period of two (2) years. However, this Contract may be renewed solely at the discretion of DAS for a period of one month. Any further renewals will be for an appropriate period of time. The cumulative time of all renewals may not exceed thirty-six (36) months unless DAS determines that additional renewal is necessary. List prices will be updated at the time of renewal. It is up to the library to accept or reject new list prices.

SUBCONTRACTING: The awarded Contractor shall be solely responsible for the Contract. Subcontracting by the Contractor shall not be permitted without prior approval by the State. On a per project basis, the Contractor shall clearly identify which requirements are subcontracted and identify the subcontracting company, the responsible business contacts therein, and the specific detail of the subcontracted work to be performed. No Contractor shall engage a subcontractor for work on State property or projects without the prior written approval of the Site Facility Manager or authorized designee.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

INSURANCE RENEWAL DOCUMENTS: Upon the policy renewal date, the Contractor must submit, within thirty (30) days, updated insurance documents showing compliance with all applicable coverage required by this Contract. As applicable, the documents must include a current Workers' Compensation Certificate and an Acord Certificate of all applicable insurance coverage and must include all required Commercial General Liability endorsements as described in Articles S-12 and S-13 of the Supplemental Terms and Conditions of this Contract.

Failure to maintain compliant insurance coverage per Article S-14 of the Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions will be considered a default and will be cause for cancellation of the Contract under the Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Section I, Item C, Part 1.

These documents shall be forwarded to the Office of Procurement Services, 4200 Surface Road, Columbus, OH 43228-1395, Attn: Gail Harper.

DMA RENEWAL DOCUMENT: Within thirty (30) days of the annual anniversary date of the Contract inception, the Contractor must submit an updated copy of the Declaration Regarding Material Assistance/Non-Assistance to a Terrorist Organization (DMA) form.

The Terrorist Exclusion List is available at http://www.homelandsecurity.ohio.gov/DMA_Terrorist/terrorist_exclusion_list.pdf. In addition, the Contractor must annually update their registration with the Ohio Business Gateway (OBG) at <http://obg.ohio.gov>.

Failure to maintain a current, compliant certificate will be considered a default and may be cause for termination of the Contract under the Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Section I, Item C, Part 1.

AA/EEO RENEWAL DOCUMENT: Within thirty (30) days of the annual anniversary date of the initial plan acceptance date by EEO, the Contractor must submit an updated copy of their Affirmative Action Program Verification Form from the DAS Equal Opportunity Division. The application form is available at <http://www.das.ohio.gov/Eod/AAEEO.htm>.

Failure to maintain a current certificate in compliance with all State and Federal laws regarding equal employment opportunity, including Ohio Revised Code Section 125.111 and all related Executive orders will be considered a default and may be cause for termination of the Contract under the Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Section I, Item C, Part 1.

USAGE REPORTS: Every twelve (12) months the Contractor must submit a report (written or on disk) indicating sales generated by this Contractor. The report shall list usage by customer, by line item, showing the quantities/dollars generated by this Contractor. The report shall be forwarded to the Office of Procurement Services, 4200 Surface Road, Columbus, OH 43228-1395, Attn: Gail Harper.

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

I. *SCOPE:

The State Library of Ohio (LIB) is requesting proposals from subscription agents. We serve Ohio State government and have an active collection of approximately two million titles. The Contractor is to provide periodical subscriptions and continuations services required by the LIB for calendar years (FY 2010) *and (FY 2011). The Contractor must be able to provide a variety of publications from multiple (different) publishers on behalf of the LIB. The LIB understands that publishers' list prices may change if the publisher increases or decreases the price of its publications, but the service charge percentage charged by the Contractor, as a percentage of the total cost, will be firm for the life of the Contract. The Contractor must specify the service charge percentage that is for each year of a possible five year period.

In the Publications section is a list of the services that must be provided. Submit an itemized response including the list price for each publication, the service charges which would be assessed, and the frequency of the publication. All of the titles are shipped to State Library of Ohio, 274 East First Avenue, Suite 100, Columbus, OH, 43201. For electronic shipping, send items to James Buchman, Head, Patron & Catalog Services at jbuchman@sloma.state.oh.us

II. DEFINITION:

"CLAIM FORM" is a document/method for obtaining items that were expected to be shipped to LIB. A claim document is used for obtaining missing issues of a publication.

III. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- A. LIB will be able to place orders for new titles at any time during the year either by letter/e-mail, or by adding them to the annual renewal notice list.
- B. One account representative will be assigned to the LIB. There must be an 800 telephone number and e-mail address available for discussing problems or answering questions. Account representatives will be knowledgeable about the LIB account and will be available to answer questions on a regular basis. Phone calls and questions will be responded to within two business days, during normal business hours Monday – Friday, 8am – 5pm.
- C. LIB requests one invoice per year based on the annual approved listing of titles. LIB understands there may be other invoices that are issued at other times during the year due to price increases and/or additions.
- D. The Contractor must be able to provide and maintain 96% of the titles listed from the subscription list throughout the life of the Contract. Any deviation from this may result in default of the Contract.

IV. CLAIMING CAPABILITY:

Bidder agrees to provide the following documents upon request or with their Bid submittal prior to the Contract award.

- A. The LIB must be able to submit claim forms electronically to the Contractor and receive confirmation electronically and/or by phone from the Contractor that the request has been processed. The Contractor will provide a response to LIB within two business days regarding the status of the claim.
- B. The Contractor must be able to report monthly to LIB about action taken on claims and have a mechanism for LIB to indicate whether or not further action is required.
- C. The Contractor must have a missing journal depository to enable LIB to obtain missing or back issues of titles no longer available from the publisher.

V. REFERENCES:

- A. The Contractor must be able to demonstrate a relationship with multiple publishers. The Contractor shall provide a list of publishers with whom they have arrangements with, including origination date of arrangement. If there was an interruption in relationship, please indicate this and explain the reason.

* This is a two year Contract for FY' 2010 and FY'2011. There are three years of renewals available by mutual agreement per addendum #1 dated 03/11/09.

V. REFERENCES(Continued):

- B. The Contractor must indicate the names of three special or academic libraries that are similar in size and scope of the collection of the State Library.

VI. RENEWAL INVOICES:

- A. The Contractor will supply an alphabetized list of titles each year to be checked for renewal by LIB. LIB will indicate which titles are to be cancelled or may add new titles to be ordered at that time. The Contractor must be able to submit the invoices in various formats such as Excel for use in calculating totals. The information to be included on the renewal:

1. Title
2. ISSN, ISBN or other publisher number
3. Publisher
4. Number of subscriptions
5. List Price
6. Service charge for each title
7. Format (e.g. print, print + online, online only)
8. Publication date or edition
9. Frequency
10. Pertinent information about each title (for example, bill later, publication ceased, standing order, etc)

- B. The Bidder shall provide a sample of your renewal invoice with their Bid, or upon request during the evaluation period.

VII. REPORTS:

- A. The Contractor shall supply an automatic, monthly report of titles with information about delay in publication, announcement that title ceased, etc. Please provide a sample of this report. Upon award you may be asked to customize this report to LIB specification.
- B. The Contractor must be able to provide LIB with a historical price analysis report detailing the title and any price changes within the last 3 to 5 years. LIB would require this report at the same time as the renewal notice is produced. Please provide a sample of this report.
- C. The Contractor shall provide a catalog of titles which can be supplied by the Contractor to LIB. This list should provide basic citation information including ISSN, cost and format, e.g. print, print + on-line, on-line only. The catalog may be in print format, updated annually, or as an on-line, searchable web catalog.
- D. The Contractor will research any serial title not listed in its catalog but wanted by the LIB to determine whether the title can be provided by the Contractor. If the Contractor determines that a title can be added to the LIB's subscription list, the Contractor will enter the title as a new subscription at anytime throughout the year. The cost will be pro-rated to fall into the LIB's common subscription term for the future renewals (see item VII. G)
- E. In the event of receiving the Contract, the Contractor should have the resources to make a smooth transition to avoid lapses in subscriptions. It is the Contractor's responsibility to transfer subscriptions from the LIB's current subscription agent with no or minimal action required on the part of LIB staff. Please describe how the transfer will work.
- F. The State Library reserves the right to cancel a title which has not been billed.
- G. Subscription Term: To the extent possible, the periodical titles should have a common subscription term of January – December.
