AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

BRAND NAME OR APPROVED EQUAL SPECIFICATION: The products in this Invitation To Bid (ITB) are being bid as Brand Name Or Approved Equal. The use of the brand name is for the purpose of describing the base standard of quality, performance and characteristics desired and is not intended to limit or restrict competition. Substantially equivalent supplies or services to those designated will be considered for award in accordance with the Ohio Administrative Code 123:5-1-10 (I) and with paragraph I-32 of the Instructions and Terms and Conditions for Bidding.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Supplies will be delivered to the participating agency within thirty (30) days after receipt of order and, in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. Failure to deliver within the thirty (30) days (or by a due date specified by the state agency, provided the due date is later than the specified contract date) is a breach of this contract. The state of Ohio may pursue actual, direct, or appropriate liquidated damages because of such breach, as well as any other remedies specified in section IC (Termination/Suspension) and section II (Contract Remedies) of the "STANDARD CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS". Scope: The purpose of this solicitation is to acquire a use of force training simulator system and related items as specified below for use by the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (ODRC) Training Academy. ODRC desires a comprehensive training system that will allow trainers the ability to provide presentations and classes, conduct interactive testing and assessment, and provide immersive hands-on scenario based exercises with detailed debriefing and after action review. The system should provide training in Firearms, OC, Unarmed Self Defense, PR-24, Use of Force and other functions as specified. The system must be portable.
