The Ohio Department of Commerce (COM) is soliciting proposals for professional services.

## 1. PROJECT INFORMATION.

- 1.1 Project Title: State Fire Marshal Academy Heavy Rescue Truck Refurbishment, Rescue Tools and Equipment
- 1.2 Posting and Due Dates: March 23, 2021 through April 09, 2021
- 1.3 Inquiry Period: March 23, 2021 through April 7, 2021
- 1.4 Project Objective. The project objective is to refurbish a heavy rescue truck and purchase rescue tools and equipment for use by instructors and students of the Fire Academy.
- 1.5 Project Budget. \$193,000.00
- 1.6 Project Award. One award.

## 2. PROJECT REQUIREMENTS.

- 2.1 Contractor Experience Requirement: Contractor shall be qualified and experienced to provide services to perform refurbishment of a heavy rescue truck and provide tools and equipment as specified in the scope of work.

## 4. INSTRUCTIONS.

### 4.1 Proposals shall:

- Be received by COM via email by no later than 3:00 p.m. the day the proposals are scheduled to be due.
- Be emailed to [carol.cook@com.state.oh.us](mailto:carol.cook@com.state.oh.us)
- Address all items in the deliverables. Emphasis should be placed on completeness, specificity, and clarity of how the Offeror will perform the responsibilities of the project.
- Include a short narrative describing the following:
  - Description of the Offeror's experience and expertise conducting projects of similar size and scope.
  - Offeror's ability to meet minimum requirements.
  - Offeror's capacity to provide the services required.
- Identify any proposed Subcontractors and services provided.
- Include Offeror's proposed completion date and compensation by deliverable in the gray columns of section three. If in the event a contract ensues, the Contractor will be required to fulfill the Contractual obligations

at the amount proposed. The proposed cost must include all costs associated with performing the work, travel, shipping, overhead, etc.

- Include samples or examples of work, at the Offeror's expense, when requested.

- 4.2 When it has been determined that it is in the Agency's best interest to conduct negotiations, COM may request a submission of a best and final quotation.
- 4.3 COM Project Manager will evaluate the proposals and recommend to the Director of Commerce the award of a Contract based upon obtaining the best value and advantage to COM. The Director's award of a Contract will be identified by the Director's signature on the Contract. The Director's award is final and not appealable.
- 4.4 COM may determine that a Contract is not in the best interest of COM and may reject, cancel, or re-issue the RFP in whole or part.
- 4.5 COM expects the Offeror to commence work upon contract execution. If the Offeror is unable or unwilling to commence work, COM reserves the right to cancel the award and resume the evaluation process with the next most advantageous proposal.

#### Refurbishment of Heavy Rescue Truck Unit Information

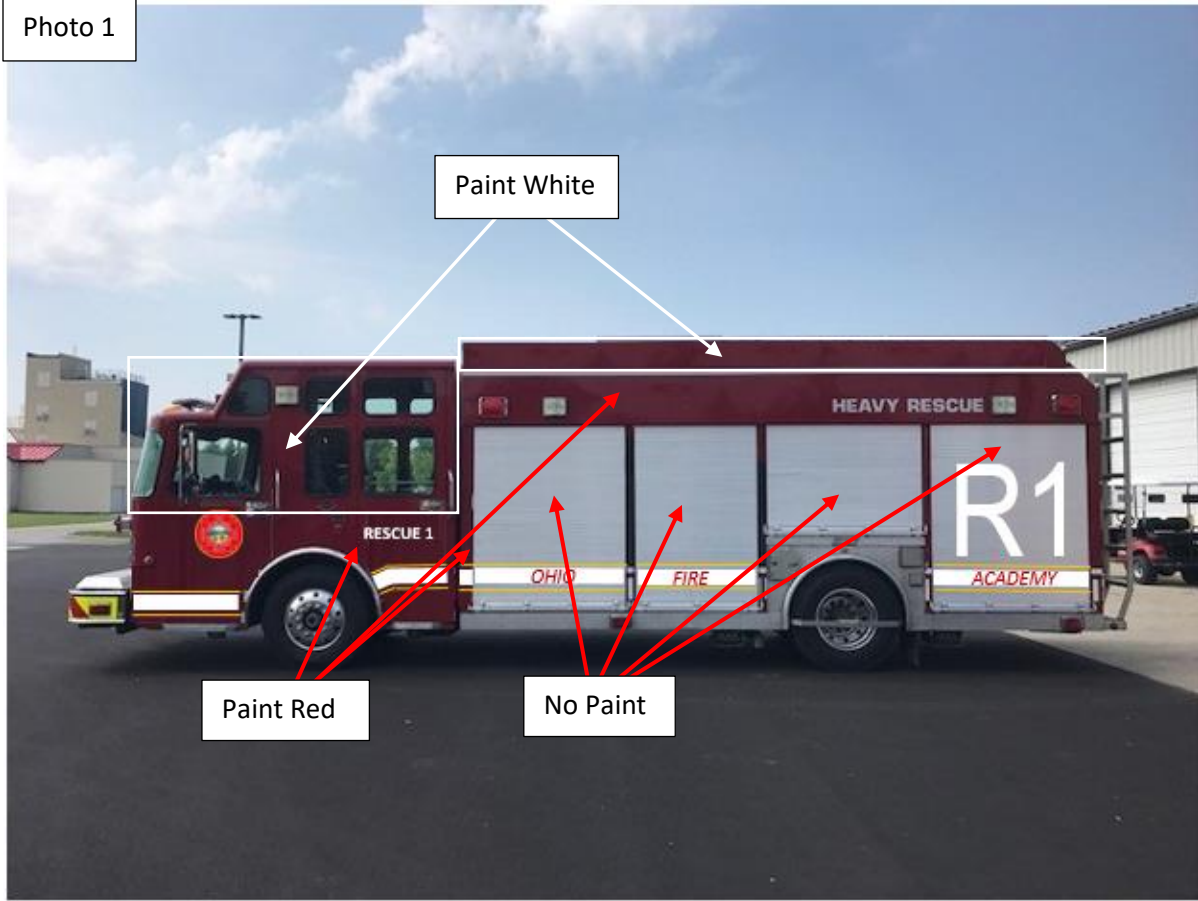
- 2001 Summit/Spartan Heavy Rescue – Formally Violet Twp. Rescue 592
- Chassis by Spartan
- Body by Summit Fire Apparatus (Aluminum Rescue Body)



#### Body & Paint

- Remove Corrosion from body surfaces, prep, and paint (**use below photos for paint/graphics reference**)
- Upper Cab (top half of cab and above roll-up doors) Paint Sikkens Autocryl #10 white
- Lower half of Cab & lower  $\frac{3}{4}$  of Body Paint Sikkens Autocoat LV # 90 red (roll-up doors remain unpainted)

- **Changes from photo 1:**
  - Reflective Striping,  $\frac{3}{4}$  belt line (top gold strip runs just above front fender well, Color; gold/white/gold, 1"-6"-1", with each stripe outlined in  $\frac{1}{4}$ " black and spaced to provide  $\frac{1}{2}$ " of red between each stripe)
  - Striping on cab to be flush with top of wheel well (per photo 3 & 4)
  - Striping on body to be raised @  $\frac{3}{4}$  compartment height (per photo 3 & 4),
  - 45° kick up occurs on door #1,
  - "Ohio" on door #2,
  - "Fire" on door #3 (above wheel),
  - "Academy" on door #4.
  - Reduce size of "R1" to fit below stripe on door #4. "R1" to be white w/ black outline
  - Remove "Heavy Rescue" above door #4.
- **Front:** "Vinyl, 4" white lettering will be located on bumper and state: "State Fire Marshal"

## Interior

This is to repair or replace items that are worn or unsightly, they include but may not be limited to:

1. Repair & Paint all 4 interior door panels (match existing color)
2. Repair or replace all seatbelts so they are operational to manufacturers specs. Must meet applicable NFPA Std.
3. Replace damaged dash covers on both side of the steering wheel (see included pictures).
4. Replace all dash switch/gage markings with legible ones.
5. Paint cowling with matching existing color.
6. Repaint the base of the forward-facing seat in the back of the cab. Color shall be the same as the exterior red Sikkens Autocoat LV #90

## Rescue Compartments

1. Compartment #3 (above rear wheel),
  - a. Remove cascade bottle holder
  - b. Fabricate full width slide out/drop down shelf for both sides.
2. Left side compartments #1 & 2.
  - a. Fabricate vendor-specific mounts for various hydraulic rescue tools
  - b. Fabricate mounts for hydraulic hoses and ancillary equipment

## Exterior Lighting

Replace all non-functioning and high voltage draw emergency lighting with modern lower energy LED lights. They include but are not limited to:

1. Replace all clear scene lights with LED that are comparable or more than existing lumens. (8)
2. Replace all clear flood lights with LED that are comparable or more than existing lumens. (8)

## Accessories

Replace passenger side non-functioning manual awning with new automatic power-awning. The system shall be a one-button operation to extend or retract the awning.
