The United States Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement - Watershed Cooperative Grant Program and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency - Clean Water Act 319 (h) Grant Program are supplying a portion of the funds for this project. The construction completion date for this project is October 31, 2011. THE ESTIMATE FOR THIS PROJECT AS DETERMINED BY THE DIVISION OF MINERAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT IS \$345,709.00.

A MANDATORY pre-bid meeting will be held on MAY 12, 2011 AT 10:30AM, at the project site. It is the intent of the DMRM to commence the pre-bid meeting at the designated time. Prior to commencement of the meeting, an attendance sign-in form shall be distributed among the contractors present. This form will be collected by DMRM staff when the pre-bid meeting begins. Only those contractors signed in prior to collection of the form who remain in attendance through the discussion of the plans and detailed specifications shall be deemed present for the purpose of determining eligibility for bid submission acceptance. Project Description

The West Branch Headwaters 2 Project is located in Salt Lick Township, Perry County, Ohio. Directions to the site are as follows: From Shawnee, Ohio take S.R. 155 east toward the town of Corning, Ohio. Follow S.R. 155 for 2 miles and the project site is along the road .1 miles west of the ODOT outpost located on the north side of S.R. 155.

The project consists of the collection and treatment of mine drainage on both the north and south sides of S.R.155. An Iron Aeration pond system shall be constructed on the north side of SR155 consisting of a mine drainage settling pond that is pumped onto a fabriform pad and into an iron aeration wetland. A Limestone Leach bed shall be constructed on the south side of SR155 by tapping into a previously installed mine drainage collection system from Phase 1 of the project. Temporary erosion and sediment controls include the use of silt fence and straw bale dikes (as directed). Once the site is final graded it shall be fertilized, seeded and mulched. Additional work items shall include clearing and grubbing of seven (7) acres, hauling and depositing to grades of all excess materials removed (approx. 16,000 c.y.) from construction of treatment structures and regrading of known landslide, installation of erosion control matting, installation of underdrains, installation of vinyl sheet piles, installation of floating pond baffles, backfilling of a channel subsidence and installation of permanent water pump, housing and electric power supply.
