AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE: The Bidder may be required to submit descriptive literature of the supplies or services being offered. If requested, the literature will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not provided as part of the bid response, the Bidder must provide said literature within five (5) calendar days after request/notification by the Office of Procurement Services to do so. Any references, that may appear in the descriptive literature, that may alter the terms and conditions and specifications of the bid (e.g. F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change), will not be part of any contract and will be disregarded by the state of Ohio. Failure of the bidder to furnish descriptive literature either as part of their bid response or within the time specified herein will deem the bidder not responsive.

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the State will evaluate the Bid based on the unit price of the Semi-Tractor, all specified equipment, fully operational and adjusted to factory specifications. To determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, the State will multiply the unit price of the vehicle by the quantity. Additional Options of the low bidder will be evaluated by DAS and may be selected for award.

All bidders are required to submit a factory build/order sheet showing all of the standard and option items for each piece of equipment bid to verify each bid is in conformance with the required bid specifications. If not provided as part of the bid response, the Bidder must provide within five (5) calendar days after request/notification by the Office of Procurement Services to do so. Failure of the bidder to furnish factory build/order sheet either as part of their bid response or within the time specified herein will deem the bidder not responsive.

CONTRACT AWARD: The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder by low lot total. The single line item consists of the following; Semi-Tractor, and all required equipment stated in the specification on pages 4 through 8.

OPTION PRICING NOTE: Option prices bid are to be less than the manufacturer's suggested retail price(s). Bidder signifies by their signature on page one (1) of the ITB that the option prices bid are less than MSRP. Any options found to be over charged during bid evaluation may have those options deleted from the award.

Bidders must include a unit cost for each option offered. If the option is included in the base unit, the bidder should enter "included" for the option. Failure to enter a cost or "included" for the options offered may deem your bid response as non-responsive and ineligible for an award. Options will be evaluated and awarded at the discretion of DAS.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Supplies will be delivered to the participating agency as soon as possible after receipt of order or no later the delivery days specified on the price schedule and, in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The delivery location will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Acceptance (transfer of title) will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the supplies delivered conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, acceptance shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud. The transporting and delivery of the vehicle shall be accomplished by surface transport, or by being driven individually. Tow bar delivery is not acceptable. No dealer name signs, clips, license plate brackets or other devices shall be affixed to any part of the delivered vehicle. Any affixed dealer information may be cause for the return of the vehicle.

DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS: Contractor is required to provide the Ohio Department of Natural Resources the final factory build sheet showing all of the standard and option items for each piece of equipment to be delivered to verify each completed piece of equipment is in conformance with the required bid specifications. SERVICE POLICY AND WARRANTY:

The successful contractor shall furnish with the vehicle the manufacturer's owner service policies and warranties for the basic truck, the conversion, and the modification of the vehicle and all equipment.

The motor vehicles, where applicable, will be completely dealer-serviced and conditioned as per the manufacturer's pre-delivery recommendations and all equipment is to be completely installed with all adjustments made which are required to prepare the vehicle for immediate and continuous operation upon delivery.

1. The warranty for the basic truck shall be the manufacturer's standard warranty. The tires shall be covered by the warranty that is standard to the industry.
2. The warranty for the conversion and modification of the vehicle shall provide that all repairs and replacements needed due to factory defects shall be furnished and installed promptly without charge by authorized service representatives for a period of one (1) year after final delivery and acceptance of the vehicle. The warranty for the conversion and modifications of the vehicle shall also provide that all necessary service adjustments shall be made promptly without charge by authorized service representatives within ninety (90) days after the delivery and acceptance of the vehicle.

The cargo box shall be covered by a warranty providing that all replacement parts and repairs due to defects in material or workmanship shall be furnished and installed promptly without charge by an authorized service representatives within the first year after the delivery and acceptance of the vehicle.
