Bidder declares to have read and understood and agrees to be bound by all of the instructions, terms, conditions and specifications of this Invitation to Bid and agrees to fulfill the requirements of any awarded contract at the prices bid.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE: The Bidder may be required to submit descriptive literature of the supplies or services being offered. If requested, the literature will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not provided as part of the bid response, the Bidder must provide said literature within seven (7) calendar days after request/notification by the Office of Procurement Services to do so. Any references, that may appear in the descriptive literature, that may alter the terms and conditions and specifications of the bid (i.e. F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change), will not be part of any contract and will be disregarded by the state of Ohio. Failure of the bidder to furnish descriptive literature either as part of their bid response or within the time specified herein will deem the bidder not responsive.

FLOOR PLAN AND SECUREMENT SYSTEM: The Bidder may submit a description, in detail, with supporting drawings (may be clear hand drawn sketches) and literature showing the type and location of the securement system being offered as part of their bid submission. Bidder may submit a floor plan (may be clear hand drawn sketches) indicating seat and wheelchair locations with your bid. If said information is not provided with the bid submission the bidder will have seven (7) calendar days after request/notification by the Office of Procurement Services to do so. Failure of the bidder to furnish the said information either as part of their bid response or within the time specified herein will deem the bidder not responsive.

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the State will multiply the required quantity by the unit price to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

CONTRACT AWARD: The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder by line item.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Supplies will be delivered to the participating agency 90-180 days after receipt of order and, in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The delivery location will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Acceptance (transfer of title) will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the supplies delivered conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, acceptance shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud. No dealer name signs, clips, license plate brackets or other devices shall be affixed to any part of the delivered vehicle. Any affixed dealer information may be cause for the return of the vehicle.

CERTIFICATE OF TITLE: The contractor is to furnish the Certificate of Title for the new vehicle and deliver the Certificate of Title within three (3) days after delivery of the vehicle. The Bidder agrees that no changes will be made to this list of subcontractors or locations where work will be performed or data will be stored without prior written approval of DAS. Any attempt by the Bidder/Contractor to change or otherwise alter subcontractors or locations where work will be performed or locations where data will be stored, without prior written approval of DAS, will be deemed as a default. If a default should occur, DAS will seek all legal remedies as set forth in the Terms and Conditions which may include immediate cancellation of the Contract. Failure to complete this page may deem your bid not responsive.

ADVERTISEMENT: Dealer name-signs shall not be affixed to any part of the delivered vehicle.

DEALER LICENSE: In reference to ORC 4517.12 DAS may ask for proof of a Dealer written authority from the manufacturer or distributor to sell new vehicles.

SALES LICENSE: In reference to OAC 4501:1-3-05 (See Section II.I), DAS may ask for proof of a salesperson’s license after bid opening if not provided at bid opening. If requested, the dealer will have five (5) business days to respond.

AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY INSURANCE: Automobile Insurance is required for anyone coming onto State Property to deliver goods or to perform services using a vehicle, which is owned, leased or rented by the Contractor. Any Bidder, Broker or Sub Contractor who will be on State Property, but not delivering goods or performing services, is required to carry Automobile Liability insurance that complies with the State and Federal laws regarding financial responsibility.

Contractor will indicate, by checking the appropriate box(es) below, which mode of transportation will apply to this contract.

- Bidder/Broker (“The Contractor”) or their Sub Contractor will make delivery or be performing services using a vehicle that is owned, leased or rented. Provide Certificate of Insurance documenting automobile liability with a Combined Single Limit of \$500,000.00.

- No employee or representative of the contractor will have cause to be on state property to make deliveries or to perform services.

SPECIFICATIONS

SPECIFICATION SHEET: Shown below are the specifications requirements for equipment that the Department of Development Disabilities desires to purchase. These specifications are only considered as necessary to establish functional requirements. Proprietary design, exact dimensions, capacities, or restrictive features will not preclude acceptance of other recognized alternates meeting comparable performance requirements as determined by the Department of Administrative Services. Bidder signifies compliance or non-compliance with the specifications by indicating in the bid factor questions. List all deviations from specifications in the bid response. Failure to comply may deem the bid non responsive.

A. GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS:

1. This item shall be a wheelchair accessible passenger transportation vehicle consisting of an extended length full size van which has additional interior headroom and clearances for improved passenger accessibility. It is the responsibility of the contractor to supply the basic van and to convert or modify it in accordance with these specifications.
2. The contractor shall provide a complete operating vehicle and the vehicle shall conform in strength, quality of material and workmanship to what is provided by the automobile industry generally. The vehicle to be provided shall be at least the latest current model vehicle, incorporating the latest engineering changes. All parts necessary to provide a complete passenger transportation vehicle shall be provided and all parts shall be new.
3. The vehicle shall conform to all applicable Motor Vehicle Laws of the State of Ohio, and to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 38, Sub-parts A and B, in addition to these specifications. The vehicle shall conform to all applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS) and American with Disabilities Act (ADA).
4. The contractor shall provide with the van upon delivery a pamphlet, brochure or similar literature describing (and instructing) the use of the securement system and shall demonstrate to the recipient the proper method of using the system.
 - a. Demonstration of the securement system must be performed to insure correct use of the system. The contractor's representative shall be thoroughly trained in the system's use so that he or she can properly instruct the agency representative in its use.
 - b. As part of the instruction process, the instructor shall have the student actually use the securement system and tie down a mobility aid in its proper location in the vehicle. Arrangements for having a mobility-aid available should be made with the agency prior to delivery of the vehicle. This process ("hands on" instruction) shall be repeated until the student completely understands the system's use and will be able to instruct others in its use.
 - c. Adequate time shall be allowed to accomplish this instruction and costs shall be included in the bid price.
5. Service: The vehicle will be completely dealer serviced and conditioned according to the manufacturer's pre-delivery recommendations and all equipment is to be completely installed with all adjustments made which are required to prepare the vehicle for immediate and continuous operations upon delivery. Unit shall conform to all current Federal Safety Regulations including OSHA. All standard equipment not specifically mentioned shall be furnished.
6. DIFFERENTIAL TYPE/RATIO: For the purposes of this bid the terms limited slip, anti-spin, automatic locking, rear locking, TRAC-LOC, etc. are to have the same meaning. The bidder is to state the standard rear axle ratio being provided and is to quote any additional ratio that may be available when preparing their bid.

B. SERVICE POLICY AND WARRANTY:

The successful contractor shall furnish with the vehicle the manufacturer's owner service policies and warranties for the basic van, the conversion, and the modification of the vehicle and all equipment.

1. Unless ordered with extended warranty, manufacturer's standard warranty shall apply - Copy of warranty to be delivered with vehicle(s) purchased. Order will be considered incomplete until warranty is delivered.
2. The tires shall be covered by the warranty that is standard to the industry.
3. The warranty for the conversion and modification of the vehicle shall provide that all repairs and replacements needed due to factory defects or defect-related equipment failure shall be furnished and installed promptly without charge or penalty by authorized service representatives for a period of one (1) year after final delivery and acceptance of the vehicle. The warranty for the conversion and modifications of the vehicle shall also provide that all necessary service adjustments shall be made promptly without charge by authorized service representatives within ninety (90) days after the delivery and acceptance of the vehicle.

SPECIFICATIONS (Cont'd)

4. The Owner's Service Policy shall be recognized and accepted by all authorized dealers within the boundaries of the state of Ohio regardless of the location of the district under which he operates.
5. The wheelchair lift shall be covered by a warranty providing that all replacement parts and repairs due to defects in material or workmanship shall be furnished and installed promptly without charge by an authorized service representatives within the first year after the delivery and acceptance of the vehicle.
6. All additional equipment included shall be covered by a warranty providing that all replacement parts and repairs needed due to defects in material or workmanship shall be provided without charge within the first year after delivery and acceptance of the vehicle.

C. DELIVERY:

1. Upon award, contractors are expected to enter orders with the factory within two (2) days after receipt of purchase order. The contractor will confirm receipt of the agency's order and projected shipping date to the ordering agency within two (2) working days, by either FAX or electronic means. The confirmation document shall confirm the contractor's order number, specific item(s), order quantities, unit price, a copy of the order notification and vehicle order number. The confirmation document may be a copy of the agency's order with the contractor's order number entered thereon. Delivery to the ordering agency is to be accomplished within seven (7) days after the contractor receives and services ordered items.

Delivery may be refused by the ordering agency if delivery was not scheduled.

2. The state of Ohio ordering entity must include a contact, phone/fax numbers on the purchase order to the dealership.
3. The transporting and delivery of automobiles shall be accomplished by surface transport, or by being driven individually. Tow bar delivery is not acceptable. All deliveries shall be effected per bid commitment. Failure to meet delivery requirements may be cause for cancellation, only with the approval of the Office of Procurement Services.

D. PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT:

1. The State declares that time is of the essence and the delivery of the vehicle(s) ordered by the projected delivery date is crucial to the ordering agency. The state realizes that there are circumstances beyond the control of the contractor that cause delay in delivery. In the event the contractor is unable to meet the projected delivery date referenced above due to circumstances beyond his control, the contractor must contact the ordering agency and inform the agency why there is a delay, setting forth therein the reasons for the delay and there will be an extension to the delivery date. The contractor's plea that insufficient time as specified is not a valid reason for an extension of time. If accord cannot be obtained, a written request by the agency must be made to the Office of Procurement Services.
2. If the contractor fails to meet the original and/or any revised delivery date, the contractor agrees to pay to the ordering agency liquidated damages according to the following schedule:
 - a. Delivery completed within ten (10) calendar days beyond the original and/or revised scheduled date \$10.00 per vehicle per day beyond the scheduled delivery date.
 - b. Liquidated damages will be deducted from the final invoice submitted by the contractor after delivery and acceptance has occurred.
3. The manufacturer has, upon occasion oversold their productive capability and could not deliver all of the contractor's orders that had been properly entered and acknowledged. When this occurs, the contractor cannot deliver for reasons beyond his control and cannot be held responsible. Usually the manufacturer will complete deliveries with the new model year vehicle at the contractor's bid price.

SPECIFICATIONS (Cont'd.)

E. MANUFACTURER'S PRODUCTION TERMINATION NOTICE (BUILD-OUT):

1. If an award is made to the contractor after the build out date and price protection for the new model year has not been established, the normal delivery timeline for delivery is required.
2. All bidders should have prior knowledge of Manufacturer build-out dates/schedules and bid accordingly. All orders received and accepted by the contractor on, or prior to, the build-out date shall guarantee delivery of the vehicle as described on the purchase order at the bid price.

F. NOTES:

1. Any delivered vehicle not conforming to these specifications shall be rejected and it will be the responsibility of the dealer or manufacturer to comply with state of Ohio requirements (See "Contract Terms & Conditions"). Any extra accessories delivered on vehicles cannot and will not be paid for.
2. Some equipment requested may be available only in combination with other options or subject to additional ordering requirements or limitations. Be sure such requirements are noted. Once awarded, contractors are expected to deliver vehicles as ordered, incurring no additional costs beyond the stated prices.




