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Psychology Internship Program

Heartland Behavioral Healthcare (HBH), an innovative multi-service behavioral healthcare organization located in Massillon, Ohio, is interested in contracting with a Psychology Internship Program to provide two (2) interns, in an internship program, to perform specific duties of Psychology Interns. Each intern shall be responsible for delivery of a portion of psychological services to adult & geriatric patients on designated Units B-1, D-1, and C-2 at Heartland Behavioral Healthcare. This contract is effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2013.

Each intern will participate in the psychological therapy group for NGRI (not guilty by reason of insanity) patients for three (3) months, assisting with the on-grounds AA (Alcoholics Anonymous) group the next three (3) months. This assignment may be changed by supervisor, at any time, in order to best meet the needs of the facility, its patients and the Psychology Department. Both interns will be working under the clinical supervision of a licensed psychologist. As members of the clinical treatment team the contractor's duties will include:

- Performing assessments of behavioral traits and
- Determining treatment goals and interventions appropriate to findings
- Individually counsel adult and geriatric patients
- Provide group or individual psychotherapy or other such treatments determined to be appropriated.

When requested, interns will provide updated copies of a curriculum vitae for Heartland Behavioral Healthcare. Interns will work on a one (1) year rotating basis and each is expected to work forty (40) hours per week over the twelve (12) month period.

The internship program must be approved by American Psychological Association and adhere to their guidelines for an internship program.

For purposes of the contract, quality, appropriateness, and timeliness of patient care shall be measured by several parameters among which are:

- Presence of a up-to-date psychological assessment/evaluation in the medical record of appropriate patients.
- Presence of written treatment goals describing intended therapeutic interventions by Psychology Intern and progress notes descriptive of the outcome of those interventions.
- Providing active participation in the clinical team process verified through attendance in team meetings.
