PROPOSALS WILL BE OPENED IN THE SECOND FLOOR CONFERENCE ROOM OF 2045 (BUILDING H-2) OF THE FOUNTAIN SQUARE OFFICES OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES. The United States Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement and the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District each are funding a portion of this project. The construction completion date for this project is November 18, 2011. THE ESTIMATE FOR THIS PROJECT AS DETERMINED BY THE DIVISION OF MINERAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT IS \$423,100.00.

A MANDATORY pre-bid meeting will be held on JUNE 14, 2011 AT 11:00 A.M., at the project site. It is the intent of the DMRM to commence the pre-bid meeting at the designated time. Prior to commencement of the meeting, an attendance sign-in form shall be distributed among the contractors present. This form will be collected by DMRM staff when the pre-bid meeting begins. Only those contractors signed in prior to collection of the form who remain in attendance through the discussion of the plans and detailed specifications shall be deemed present for the purpose of determining eligibility for bid submission acceptance. Participation in the site viewing subsequent to the completion of the discussion of the detailed specifications will not be required in establishing attendance. **NO PLANS OR SPECIFICATIONS WILL BE SOLD AT THE PRE-BID MEETING.**

Project Description


Background: This site was surface mined in the late 1960s by B & N Coal Company, under permit A-194. This site is one of the thirty individual sites identified within the Ales Run Watershed as an excessive contributor of sediments, not only to Ales Run, but also to the Duck Creek Watershed. This site is plagued with in-stream spoils, deep erosion gullies and barren strip benches/slopes.

Directions to Site: The Ales Run #15 Reclamation Project is located in Jefferson Township, Noble County, Ohio. Take State Route 821 (South from Caldwell, North from Macksburg) to County Road 2 (Low Gap Road), head east on County Road 2 (under I-77) for approximately 2.7 miles, turn right on to County road 42 (Ogles Ridge Road) for approximately 0.8 miles, turn left and continue on County Road 42 for another 0.8 miles, continue on to Township Road 272/274 (Hupp's Ridge) for approximately 0.5 miles, the site is on the east side of the road.

Scope of Work: The scope of work for this site will be to establish drainage controls from the barren benches, re-establish natural drainage corridors and stabilize with rock channel protection, stabilize barren out slopes, capture seeps from the highwall, and resoil and revegetate all barren/disturbed portions of the site.

The Ohio Department of Natural Resources and/or its authorized representative reserves the right to adjust the size of the work area and the sequence of construction operations as necessary, based on conditions encountered during the implementation of the abatement program.
