The United States Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement - Watershed Cooperative Grant Program and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency - Clean Water Act 319 (h) Grant Program are supplying a portion of the funds for this project. The construction completion date for this project is November 15, 2011. THE ESTIMATE FOR THIS PROJECT AS DETERMINED BY THE DIVISION OF MINERAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT IS \$231,365.00.

A MANDATORY pre-bid meeting will be held on MAY 25, 2011 AT 10:30AM, at the project site. It is the intent of the DMRM to commence the pre-bid meeting at the designated time. Prior to commencement of the meeting, an attendance sign-in form shall be distributed among the contractors present. This form will be collected by DMRM staff when the pre-bid meeting begins. Only those contractors signed in prior to collection of the form who remain in attendance through the discussion of the plans and detailed specifications shall be deemed present for the purpose of determining eligibility for bid submission acceptance. Participation in the site viewing subsequent to the completion of the discussion of the detailed specifications will not be required in establishing attendance. **NO PLANS OR SPECIFICATIONS WILL BE SOLD AT THE PRE-BID MEETING.**

Project Description

The Orland Gob Reclamation Project is located in Swan Township, Vinton County, Ohio.

Directions to the site are as follows:


From the South at the town of McArthur take SR 93 north for approximately 9.5 miles to the SR 56 intersection.

From the North at the town of Logan take SR 93 south for approximately 13.3 miles to the SR 56 intersection.

From the intersection of SR 93 and SR 56 take SR 56 east for approximately 2.0 miles to Pumpkin Ridge Rd. Turn right (south) onto Pumpkin Ridge Rd. and continue for approximately 250 feet. The project site is on your right and sits adjacent to **Huntley Trucking Company**.

The project consists of but is not limited to grading of a five (5) acre gob pile, incorporating lime into the gob @ 20 tons/acre, the construction of an approximately 980 linear foot open limestone channel, the placement of two (2) low water crossings, the excavation of approximately 19,000 cubic yards of resoil material, and capping of the gob pile with 2 feet of resoil material. The site will be regraded according to the drawing plans. Temporary erosion and sediment controls include the use of silt fence and straw bale dikes (as directed). Once the site is final graded it shall be fertilized, seeded and mulched. Additional work items shall include debris removal and disposal consisting of but not limited to approximately 112 metal barrels, debris/trash, and various scrap metal.
