Bidder declares to have read and understood and agrees to be bound by all of the instructions, terms, conditions and specifications of this Invitation to Bid and agrees to fulfill the requirements of any awarded contract at the prices bid.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Supplies will be delivered to the participating agency within 15 days after receipt of order and, in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The delivery location will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Acceptance (transfer of title) will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the supplies delivered conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, acceptance shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE: The Bidder may be required to submit descriptive literature of the supplies or services being offered. If requested, the literature will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not provided as part of the bid response, the Bidder must provide said literature within seven (7) calendar days after request/notification by the Office of Procurement Services to do so. Any references, that may appear in the descriptive literature, that may alter the terms and conditions and specifications of the bid (e.g. F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change), will not be part of any contract and will be disregarded by the state of Ohio. Failure of the bidder to furnish descriptive literature either as part of their bid response or within the time specified herein will deem the bidder not responsive.

PRODUCT SAMPLES: The bidder(s) may be required to submit samples of the supplies being offered. The samples will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not included as part of their bid response, the bidder will be required to provide the samples within seven (7) calendar days after notification. Failure to provide the samples within the stated time period will result in the bidder being deemed not responsive. After award of the contract, the samples will be used as a basis of comparison with actual product delivered under contract. Any variation between the samples and product being delivered will be considered as an event of default. Any variations between the samples and actual product being delivered that are due to manufacturer changes may be acceptable and shall require prior written approval from DAS.

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the state will multiply the estimated annual usage of each item by its corresponding unit price and then add these totals together for each category. Although there will be separate category awards made, bidders are eligible to receive awards of multiple categories providing he/she is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder meeting all bid specifications and requirements listed within the categories. Failure to bid all items in a category may result in the bidder being deemed as not-responsive.

CONTRACT AWARD: The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder by category

FIXED-PRICE WITH ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT: The contract prices(s) will remain firm for the first twelve (12) months duration of the contract. Thereafter, the Contractor may submit a request to increase their price(s) to be effective sixty (30) calendar days after acceptance by DAS. No price adjustment will be permitted prior to the effective date of the increase received by the Contractor from his suppliers, or on purchase orders that are already being processed, or on purchase orders that have been filled and are awaiting shipment. If the Contractor receives orders requiring quarterly delivery, the increase will apply to all deliveries made after the effective date of the price increase.

The price increase must be supported by a general price increase in the cost of the finished supplies, due to increases in the cost of raw materials, labor, freight, Workers' Compensation and/or Unemployment Insurance, etc. Detailed documentation, to include a comparison list of the contract items and proposed price increases, must be submitted to support the requested increase. Supportive documentation should include, but is not limited to: copies of the old and the current price lists or similar documents which indicate the original base cost of the product to the Contractor and the corresponding increase, and/or copies of correspondence sent by the Contractor's supplier on the supplier's letterhead, which contain the above price information and explains the source of the increase in such areas as raw materials, freight, fuel or labor, etc.

Should there be a decrease in the cost of the finished product due to a general decline in the market or some other factor, the Contractor is responsible to notify DAS immediately. The price decrease adjustment will be incorporated into the contract and will be effective on all purchase orders issued after the effective date of the decrease. If the price decrease is a temporary decrease, such should be noted on the invoice. In the event that the temporary decrease is revoked, the contract pricing will be returned to the pricing in effect prior to the temporary decrease. For quarterly deliveries, any decrease will be applied to deliveries made after the effective date of the decrease. Failure to comply with this provision will be considered as a default and will be subject to Provision I.C. "Termination/Suspension" and Provision II. of the "Contract Remedies:" of the "Standard Contract Terms and Conditions".

USAGE REPORTS: Every six (6) months the contractor must submit a report (written or on disk) indicating sales generated by this contract. The report shall list usage by customer, by line item, showing the quantities/dollars generated by this contract. SPECIFICATIONS

I. SCOPE

The state of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services (DAS) on behalf of the Ohio Department of Health (ODH), Division of Family and Community, Health Services, Bureau of Nutrition Services is soliciting bids for a contractor to provide Breast Pumps, Kits, Shields and Accessories to be delivered F.O.B. Destination to seventy-five sites for the Special Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC). The delivery sites are shown on pages 7 through 9.

The equipment and supplies required are detailed in the specifications below and on the Price page of this Invitation for Bid (ITB). The Contract period is for October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2017, unless renewed or terminated.

Examples of acceptable manufacturers' products are: Bailey Medical Engineering, Hollister (Ameda), Medela, Hygeia and DAO Health. This is not an all-inclusive list. Other manufacturers' equivalent products may be considered and this list of manufacturers is for information only – not to be construed as being brand specific.

- II. WARRANTY: Manufacturers' standard warranties shall apply and will not begin until a pump is issued to a client. The local project agency will document the date of issue, product name, and serial number, and maintain these records for warranty and local project agency purposes. A copy of the manufacturer's warranty shall be supplied with each equipment product delivered.
- III. TRAINING: The successful bidders(s) will be required to provide detailed training, at no additional cost to the agency, to each of the Ohio Department of Health's regional sites at a minimum of one time per year. The contractor(s) shall provide all training materials at no cost to the State. Instructions shall be given on assembly, use, handling and storage of pumped milk, and cleaning of pumps. The five regions for training are Northwest, Northeast, Central, Southeast and Southwest Ohio.

IV. PACKAGING & LABELING INSTRUCTIONS

- A. Each pump must be individually packaged and labeled "not for resale." Each pump must include instructions printed in English and Spanish, which are at a low literacy level (5th grade reading level) and include assembly, use, cleaning instructions, and handling and storage of pumped milk. The Ohio WIC Program staff will approve the instructions prior to printing. Each pump shall also include an instructions card containing a pictorial description of how to assemble the pump kit and attach it to the pump. Agency prefers either DVD or video assembly and use instructions, but it is not mandatory. Please specify what method you will provide assembly and use instructions in your bid response on page 12.

V. DELIVERY

- A. Products will be delivered to 75 local agencies within Ohio. On pages 7 through 9 is the list of addresses for deliveries. The Site location address list will be maintained and updated by ODH. ODH will specify the delivery address and named director prior to each shipment. The Director named at each delivery location may change throughout the Contract and will be updated by ODH as needed and coordinated with the Contractor.
- B. Each shipment to a local site will need to include a packing slip that includes the contract number, purchase order number, order date, quantity and types of pumps, kits, shields and accessories delivered.
- C. The Contractor will invoice the Ohio WIC Program after each delivery with detailed documentation to include but not limited to: purchase order number, order dates, delivery dates, site location, item numbers, description of items and quantities delivered.

VI. EQUIPMENT TRADE-IN

During the course of any resulting Contract from this bid, the Contractor will make an effort to give credit towards the purchase of new or reconditioned pumps specified in this Bid from previously purchased breast pumps purchased by the State that have trade-in value. Any credit/trade-in units will be accounted for on the resulting invoices with the newly purchased items.

VII. EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLY ITEM CHANGES

When items become discontinued and/or are replaced with new items, the Contractor will notify the State that the items are discontinued and are no longer available.
