SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Services will be performed as set forth in the Contract and in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The location of performance will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Payment for services rendered will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the services provided conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, payment shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

SITE VISIT: Prior to submitting their bid response, the bidder should visit the institution(s) they are bidding in order to survey the facility(s) and to become familiar with the requirements of the bid. The bidder must contact each institution to schedule an appointment. To schedule an appointment, please refer to page 36 for the institution telephone number and contact person. Once a contract is awarded, failure of the bidder to have requested a site visit to become familiar with the institution and requirements of the bid will be insufficient reason to support any request to be released from the contract.

DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE: The Bidder may be required to submit descriptive literature of the supplies or services being offered. If requested, the literature will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not provided as part of the bid response, the Bidder must provide said literature within ten (10) calendar days after request/notification by the Office of Procurement Services to do so. Any references, that may appear in the descriptive literature, that may alter the terms and conditions and specifications of the bid (e.g. F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change), will not be part of any contract and will be disregarded by the state of Ohio. Failure of the bidder to furnish descriptive literature either as part of their bid response or within the time specified herein will deem the bidder not responsive.

CONTRACT AWARD: The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder by low lot total.

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the state will: for each institution requesting limited services on an "as-required" basis; multiply the Hourly Rate (Per Man) bid by 8 hours, multiply that product by 12 months for a yearly estimated cost per institution. For institutions requesting Total Monthly Cost For Service During Regular Working Hours; multiply the Total Monthly Cost bid by 12 months for a yearly estimated cost per institution, add the yearly estimated costs for all institutions together for an estimated total contract worth (Low Lot Total). Costs for Hourly Rate (Per Man) Emergency Service, Trip Charge (If Applicable) and Repair Parts (percentage above Contractor's cost) will not be used as part of the evaluation.

SUBCONTRACTING: The awarded contractor shall be solely responsible for the contract. All work must be done by direct employees of the awarded contractor. The awarded contractor shall not engage a subcontractor for any work performed in conjunction with this contract without the prior written approval of DRC and DAS.

BUSINESS REFERENCES: All bidders should submit with their bid, a list of at least three (3) companies and/or organizations with which they have had recent (within two [2] years) electronic security system maintenance service contracts. This list shall include the name and phone number of a contact person who will be familiar with the bidder's job performance. The state may verify the bidder's experience based upon the list of business references submitted and any other sources which the state deems appropriate.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: In the event that an awarded Contractor fails to perform within the timeframe specified by the Contract and/or purchase order, the agency will contact the Contractor to determine when the purchase order will be fulfilled. If the Contractor cannot fulfill the purchase order requirements within a timeline acceptable to the agency, the agency may procure like-kind supplies/services from another resource and invoice the Contractor for the full additional amount charged by the third party provider. Invoices for said liquidated damages must be deducted from subsequent Contractor invoices prior to payment by the agency.

Under these damage recovery provisions, the agency may: (1) elect to procure any portion of the original order from another source; and/or (2) charge the Contractor for any difference in cost for the service/merchandise procured; and/or (3) cancel any portion of the original order without Contractor penalty. Also reference Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions, Article S-9, Time of Delivery, and Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Section II, Contract Remedies.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS (Cont'd)

INVOICES: All invoices for services under this contract shall conform to the requirements as stated in Section III.A. (INVOICE REQUIREMENTS) on page 5 of INSTRUCTIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BIDDING.

MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET: The Contractor shall provide a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) for any hazardous chemical that he brings onto the facility property for the performance of this contract. The MSDS shall verify the Contractor's compliance with OSHA Hazard Communications Standard 29 CFR 1910.1200. The MSDS shall be given to the facility contact person prior to use of the hazardous chemical on the facility property.

SPECIFICATION QUESTIONS: Information regarding submission of questions and clarifications for this Bid is provided on page one (1) of the Bid. Through the indicated inquiry closure date, Bidders may visit the Procurement Services website to post Bid related questions at <www.ohio.gov/procure>. Answers to all Bidder questions will be posted on the Procurement Services website and linked to the bid number. Bidders can make their own inquiry and/or review all inquiry questions/responses from the same website page from which the bid document is downloaded. The State will make every effort to respond to website inquires within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt. The State will not respond to any verbal or written questions received through any other medium. No prospective Bidder shall respond to any verbal instructions or changes to this Bid. Only Bid communications, issued by the Department of Administrative Services, Office of Procurement Services, in a public, published format, will be considered valid.

USAGE REPORTS: Every six (6) months the Contractor must submit a report (written or on disk) indicating sales generated by this contract. The report shall list usage by customer, by line item, showing the quantities/dollars generated by this contract. The report shall be forwarded to the Office of Procurement Services, 4200 Surface Road, Columbus, OH 43228-1395, Attn: Harry Graham.

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SPECIFICATIONS FOR PERIMETER FENCE SECURITY

I. SCOPE

The service required in this bid is to provide complete Perimeter Security System maintenance for the components specified in accordance with operational requirements. This service is to be performed and completed during the normal working hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., unless noted otherwise herein. Any work not completed is to be scheduled for the following day unless other arrangements are made with the facility contact person.

The bidder is required to read carefully the specifications for all parts of the work so as to become familiar with the work covered by the contract. The bidder should visit the sites and become familiar with the existing conditions before submitting a bid. No additional compensation will be awarded due to unfamiliarity with the specifications and/or sites. It shall be assumed bidder has full knowledge of existing conditions and accepts them as-is (see Site Visit, page 3).

Due to the importance of maintaining these systems in an operational mode, before any award is finalized, the potential awardee may be required to demonstrate to the Operations Director or his designee his ability to report to the facility within the four (4) hours response time as specified (or as noted otherwise herein) and give a walk-through demonstration as to how he plans to carry out the requirements of the contract. Awarded Contractor(s) failing to respond as required may be found in default of the contract, with possible cancellation of the contract.

Additional requirements/specifications particular to agency locations are included on the pricing page(s) for those locations.

This bid/contract includes the requirements of the previous contract for Northeast Pre-Release Center, Contract No. OT907202, Index No. DRC041.

II. REQUIREMENTS

- A. Contractor shall not perform any repair work that is not covered under this contract, without prior approval of the agency. A written detailed estimate of the Contractor's cost for repairs to be made shall be submitted to the agency for their prior approval. Any repairs made by the Contractor without prior approval that are not covered under this contract shall be at the Contractor's expense.
- B. Contractor shall submit to the Business Office of the agency a report covering the various repairs made on equipment listing the date of repair, item repaired, labor used, material used, etc., that is covered by this contract. Unless otherwise stated, this report shall be submitted to the Business Office monthly.
- C. Contractor's maintenance personnel must sign-in upon arrival at the agency and must sign-out upon departing the agency. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to coordinate with the agency's Business Administrator a procedure for the Contractor's maintenance personnel to follow when entering or leaving the agency.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

- A. The Contractor shall use trained technicians supervised by their firm. They shall be qualified to keep the equipment properly adjusted, and they shall use all reasonable care to maintain the equipment in proper and safe operating condition.
- B. The Contractor shall be one regularly engaged in the business of servicing equipment of the type and character as herein described. If needed by the state, the bidder may be required to demonstrate how they will meet the requirements of this bid.
- C. To show proof of satisfactory maintenance performance on equipment of the same type and operation as described herein where the bidder has sustained a full maintenance contract, bidder is to submit with their bid a list of names of three (3) firms within the last two (2) years with whom they have or have had such contracts (See Business References on page 3).
- D. Bidders shall also provide with the bid a list of their service facilities, capacity, and experience.

SPECIFICATIONS (Cont'd)

IV. CONTRACTOR'S REQUIREMENTS - FULL MAINTENANCE SERVICE

- A. It is the intent of this contract to cover full maintenance on the equipment listed herein, and equipment and accessories thereto whether or not such equipment and accessories are listed herein, except such circumstances as specifically listed in Section IV. C.
- B. The Contractor will regularly and systematically examine the equipment, make necessary inspections and tests, monthly or as otherwise specified herein, to maintain proper operating conditions and shall repair or replace all mechanical and electrical parts necessary to maintain the system in proper operating condition.
- C. Contractor will provide service and parts (small parts: wire, nuts, screws, etc.) at the bid contract price with no additional cost to the customer. In the event of a prolonged outage, Contractor will install loaner equipment to maintain system integrity at no additional cost.
- D. Contractor will respond to emergency service calls within four (4) hours of notification of equipment failure (see Section V.).
- E. The Contractor will, as part of this contract, install MOV (metal oxide varistors) to every outside camera at the various Correctional Institutions, within 30 days of notification of award of service contract. In the event of a lightning strike, should the lightning destroy an MOV, the Contractor will replace the arrestor at no additional charge to the customer within two (2) days.
- F. While MOV's are the best protection against a lightning strike to the cameras and associated equipment, there is no guarantee that the MOV will protect the equipment 100% of the time. The Contractor will not be held responsible for the damage to the equipment that should occur in this instance, but will repair it at wholesale prices on parts and labor, submitting invoices to reflect costs of parts and at the labor rate quoted herein.
- G. The Contractor will warranty all equipment listed against any and all failures, which are a result of lightning, electrical storms, electrical power surges, and any act of nature that is electrically charged that would or could damage the above-listed equipment.
- H. This section also to include arrestors on coax cable lines, and surge suppressors on all AC receptacles, to protect equipment from both sides.
- I. The Contractor must submit with his bid a schedule for inspection and maintenance and the number of man-hours to be worked.
- J. Hours of Service: Normal service shall be from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm daily, (unless noted otherwise herein), Monday through Friday, state holidays excepted. Emergency service shall be available at any hour, any day, including holidays, with a 4-hour response time after notification by agency personnel. (NOTE: Some locations require a shorter response time. These times are indicated within individual location specifications/requirements.)
- K. Telephone Consultation: a trained technician must be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for telephone consultation to assist Facility Maintenance Department.

V. EMERGENCY SERVICE

All repairs and replacements shall be scheduled during regular working hours, Monday through Friday, unless a situation arises requiring immediate attention. The Contractor shall provide, at no additional cost, emergency service twenty-four (24) hours per day with a four (4) hour maximum response time (unless otherwise noted herein) from time of call to arrival at the facility requiring service, after which liquidated damages shall accrue in the amount of the successful vendor's emergency service hourly rates for each additional hour, or fraction thereof until emergency service begins.

Message machines or other mechanical recording devices are not acceptable as a communications center.

SPECIFICATIONS (Cont'd)

VI. AGENCY APPROVAL

All repair and parts replacement not covered under Section IV. shall be done only with prior approval of the agency. The Contractor shall submit to the agency contact person a detailed quotation of each item that requires repair or replacement.

VII. PARTS REPAIR AND/OR REPLACEMENT

All parts used for repair or replacement shall be new. Parts installed in existing systems, unless otherwise approved by the agency, shall be of the same manufacturer as the original. If replacement parts of other manufacturers are approved, such parts shall be equal to or better than the original part and shall be completely compatible with the existing system in function and performance.

VIII. PARTS/MATERIAL COST UPCHARGE

All parts and material to be supplied by the Contractor that are not covered under Section IV shall be invoiced at no more than the quoted percentage rate over the Contractor's cost (not to exceed fifteen [15%] percent) as indicated on the bid response sheet. Copies of the Contractor's invoice shall be submitted to the agency showing the actual cost of each part. The facility contact person may also acquire parts from the Contractor at no more than the Contractor's listed percentage rate over manufacturer's invoice.

IX. EQUIPMENT LIST:

Each facility's equipment is listed on the respective bid proposal pages. Due to program changes and/or equipment updates, actual inventory may vary from quantities shown.

This Contractor is to provide the following:

- I. Limited services on an "as-required" basis. This would involve a per-hour charge for labor, a per-hour charge for emergency service and a trip charge rate, if applicable (the total of which is the basis for award) and the parts necessary to repair defective equipment on-site or at the Contractor's place of business.
- II. The facility would also require parts, at the Contractor's quoted markup, to be utilized by Allen Correctional Institution staff, to repair, modify, or update equipment on-site by facility staff.
- III. The institution's electronic technician performs routine maintenance of the perimeter security system. For Contractor's information, listed below is a comprehensive list of equipment currently in use at Allen Correctional Institution.
- IV. Under the terms of this contract, the normal hours for service response are between 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday with the exception of state holidays. In addition to normal service calls, the Contractor shall provide an emergency response of not more than four (4) hours.
