Position Descriptions & Qualifications of Medical Professionals (in alphabetical order):

Dentist (General)

Position Description:

Incumbents may perform some or all of these duties or other job-related duties as assigned;

Perform clinical dentistry procedures in accordance with the standards of care as described/ governed by the state in which provider is contracted.

Routine dental examinations, diagnostic radiographs.

Routine preventive services, including pit and fissure sealant applications, prophylaxis, oral hygiene instruction, and fluoride varnish therapy

Routine operative dentistry, including crown preparation and fabrication, amalgams, composites, stainless steel crowns on deciduous teeth, and other restorative procedures.

Routine periodontal services, including scaling and root planning therapy, periodontal probing.

Routine endodontic services, including root canal therapy on molar teeth, using established standards of care.

Routine oral and maxillofacial surgery, including routine simple extractions. (referrals as necessary)

Routine prosthodontic procedures, including complete and partial removable dentures, and fixed partial dentures.

The contractor shall not provide oral sedation at any time, and shall not be required to perform work in and or with general anesthesia unless prior consent has been noted by facility

The contractor is required to work on all patients, with the exception of those that require referral due to situational behavioral difficulties, anxiety, or extensive therapy.

Minimum Requirements:

Minimum of (1) year relevant work experience preferred or has had current patient clinical contact within the last 12-18 months.

Must have completed an entire specialty program and an accredited dental education program.

Accredited Joint Commission

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CV –We require that each provider give a five-year chronology with explanations of gaps of more than 30 days.

References –obtain at least two peer references from those who can attest to the provider’s competence and skills and who have had clinical contact within the past 18 months.

Medicare/Medicaid Sanctions – OIG/EPLS are queried on all providers. Staff Care will not work providers who have any sanctions.

DEA – verify if providers have current Federal DEA licenses that include all six schedules (2, 2N, 3, 3N, 4, 5). An exception can be made for those providers working at government assignments, if the facility requests. The DEA is verified online, verbally, or by examination of a copy of the license.

CSR – (CDS, BNDD) requirements are the same as the DEA unless not required by a specific state.

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Mental Health Specialists

Adult Psychiatry

Position Description:

Incumbents may perform some or all of these duties or other job-related duties as assigned;

Performs psychiatric examination & evaluations for adult & geriatric mentally ill patients: diagnoses & treats mental illness using medication, psychotherapy or other treatment modalities; provides psychiatric services to forensic patients as assigned; completes mental status reports as assigned.

Participates in treatment team meetings as Treatment Team Leader: discusses patient problems, treatment & progress with hospital staff members, patients' relatives, guardians & courts

Maintains physicians' part of patients' records in compliance with professional, Departmental TJC, Medicare-Medicaid & Quality Assessment/Peer Review requirements.

Examines psychiatric patients & prepares certificates of examination & reports for judicial cases: attends court hearings & testifies; prepares other reports for courts, attorneys, Bureau of support & other agencies.

Performs other related duties: serves on various hospital committees & participates in committee meetings; assists as back-up for other psychiatrists as requested; participates in continuing professional education activities (e.g., lectures, seminars, film presentations, clinico-pathological conferences); participate in education supervision of psychiatric residents & students.

Minimum Requirements:

Minimum of (1) year relevant work experience preferred or has had current patient clinical contact within the last 12-18 months.

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Child/Adolescent Psychiatrist

Position Description:

Incumbents may perform some or all of these duties or other job-related duties as assigned;

Provides administrative direction & consultation in all areas related to behavioral health services for assigned Juvenile Correctional Facility under the administrative/clinical guidance of the Central Office Administrative Child & Adolescent Psychiatrist; provides clinical & administrative oversight to all facility staff regarding behavior health & directly supervises Psych/MR Nurse & other behavioral health staff.

Collaborates with the Facility's Health Care Administrator, Psychologist Supervisor, Program Deputy Superintendent & Social Services managers on behavioral health issues;

Participates in supervisor & peer review process;

Serves as member of treatment teams; develops Policy & Programs for the facility in compliance with DYS policy & applicable laws, rules, standards, etc.;

Develops policy & procedures for the provision of behavioral health services that includes psychiatric practices for the delivery of services;

Ensures that the facility is providing evidenced-based clinical services for all as evidenced by quality assurance measures & program improvement protocols.

Completes psychiatric evaluations to assist in diagnosis & treatment of mental illness; provides intake evaluations on newly transferred youth to assess medication needs & write prescriptions;

Responds to facility staff referrals to evaluate unidentified mental health disorders; completes risk assessments per policy & makes determinations on precautionary status levels for youth displaying suicidal behavior or ideation;

Notifies appropriate staff when youth medications are added, changed or terminated; responds as needed to evaluate a youth exhibiting behavioral issues;

Explains to youth the need, benefits, use & side effects of medication & obtains informed consent per policy;

Directs maintenance of health files & client information in a secure & confidential manner in accordance with department & local procedures & guidelines set by the State Board of Medicine & the Ohio Revised Code;

Provides emergency services to the facility via consultations with nursing and/or psychology staff 24 hours per day, 7 days per week; reports absences to Psychology Supervisor

Minimum Requirements:

Certificate to practice medicine and completion of residence training program in adult psychiatry & successful completion of a child/adolescent fellowships, as approved by the residence review committee of the American Medical Association, the committee on post-graduate education of the American Osteopathic Association Board of Neurology & Psychiatry, or has been recognized as a psychiatrist by the Ohio State Medical Association or the Ohio Osteopathic Association on the basis of formal training

Board eligibility in psychiatry-child & adolescent psychiatry preferred

Minimum of (1) year relevant work experience preferred or has had current patient clinical contact within the last 12-18 months.

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Psychologist

Position Description:

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Supervises psychology staff; schedules & assigns work to psychology staff; monitors & evaluates services (e.g., case notes, written assessments, crisis intervention activities) & staff performance; consults with Superintendent & other Administrative staff regarding assessments, Counseling services & clinical work; plans, develops, implements & administers, comprehensive psychological evaluation & assessment programs .

Ensures compliance with certifying & accrediting agencies.

Writes &/or approves Behavior Management Plans

Screens, scores, interviews & recommends applicants for psychology positions

Represents psychological unit at meetings, conferences & seminars as assigned

Serves as on-site after hours designee in matters of youth crisis

Makes clinical recommendations & notifies appropriate administrative personnel as necessary

Minimum Requirements:

License to practice psychology in Ohio, 12 mos. exp. as a licensed psychologist; 1 course in employee trg. & development or 3 mos. exp. providing work direction & training or supervision to psychology students, assistants, or psychologists

Minimum of (1) year relevant work experience preferred or has had current patient clinical contact within the last 12-18 months.

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Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner/APRN

Position Description:

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Advanced Practice Nurse- Psychiatric/MH will provide direct psychiatric/mental health care (e.g. administers comprehensive psychiatric &/or neurological examinations, diagnoses & treats patients consistent with formulary; orders lab tests; may include care for offenders in crisis)

Writes mental health evaluations & reports for offenders in need of and/or receiving psychiatric level of care (i.e. offenders with need for psychiatric medication); prescribes medication as needed; interprets & analyzes laboratory reports & findings; writes summary & maintains written account of patient progress; Acts as the lead of treatment team meetings (in absence of psychiatrist) and is instrumental in the development of treatment plans for offenders on the mental health caseload

Direct delivery psychiatric/mental health care services to offenders incarcerated in correctional institutions.

Provide clinical supervision for registered nurses & other subordinate mental health staff

Minimum Requirements:

Valid license as Registered Nurse; completion of advanced level practice nurse program for Clinical Nurse Specialist or Certified Nurse Practitioner in psychiatric/mental health specialty & certified by Ohio Board of Nursing for advanced practice with valid certificate of authority & certificate to prescribe

Minimum of (1) year relevant work experience preferred or has had current patient clinical contact within the last 12-18 months.

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Physician-Primary Care

Nurse Practitioner-Primary Care

Position Description:

Incumbents may perform some or all of these duties or other job-related duties as assigned;

Creates & implements patient care plan & performs advanced nursing duties within boundaries of licensure.

Monitors progress of patients & intervenes in the course of chronic illnesses using DRC and policies & protocols for guidance.

Performs routine physical examinations of patients to determine control of status of chronic conditions & diagnose new conditions.

Evaluate acute & chronically ill patients & prescribes medications or administers treatment of acute & chronically ill patients.

Performs minor surgery as training & competency allows.

Evaluates necessity for referral consultations inside or outside the institution.

Orders and reviews results of laboratory, x-ray & other diagnostic testing.

Inoculates or vaccinates patients against communicable diseases.

Monitor progress of and intervene in the course of chronic illnesses, using the DRC policies and protocols for guidance.

Inoculate or vaccinate against communicable diseases & prescribe medications or administer treatment of acute and chronically ill patients and perform minor surgery as training & competency allows.

Perform routine physical exams of patients to determine control or status of chronic conditions & diagnose new conditions.

Evaluate patients for the necessity of specialty referral consultations inside or outside the institution & review said consult reports for the recommendations, approving or disapproving accordingly.

Order & review the results of laboratory, x-ray, and other diagnostic testing as appropriate.

Facilitate, with the institutional Chief Medical Officer (CMO), the completion of medical reclassification & requests for non-formulary medications as necessary.

Provides clinical direction to registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, phlebotomists & other caregivers.

Minimum Requirements:

Minimum of (1) year relevant work experience preferred or has had current patient clinical contact within the last 12-18 months.

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Documents medical information gathered during patient interviews according to agency guidelines, policies, protocols & ACA standards.

Documents assessments & diagnostic impressions including treatment plans & follow up parameters.

Cooperates with monthly institutional CMO medical quality oversight.

General & Family Practice Physician

Position Description:

Incumbents may perform some or all of these duties or other job-related duties as assigned;

Performs routine & emergency medical care of patients.

Examine, diagnose, and treat patients, using the DRC policies and protocols for guidance.

Evaluate patients for the necessity of specialty referral consultations inside or outside the institution & review said consult reports for the recommendations, approving or disapproving accordingly.

Order & review the results of laboratory, x-ray, and other diagnostic testing as appropriate.

Facilitate with Chief of Staff, the completion of medical reclassification & requests for non-formulary medications as necessary.

Writes medical evaluations & reports, admission, discharge, & death summaries.

Reviews and ensures appropriateness of emergency transfers to outside hospitals.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

Skills in administering treatments and medication.

Ability to deal with many variable & determine specific course of action; interpret extensive variety of technical material in medical journals; handle sensitive contacts with persons who are ill.

Certificate to practice medicine issued by State Medical board, pursuant to Section 4731.14 of ORC & certificate registration issued by State Medical Board, pursuant to Section 4731.281 of ORC or limited registration with subsequent application for next available biennial medical state board examination to test for limited certificate per Section 473.292 of ORC as it applies to foreign medical graduates.
