Evaluation Scoring Formula. The evaluation team will rate the Proposals that meet the Mandatory Requirements based on the following criteria and respective weights.

Criteria	Percentage
Technical Proposal	70%
Cost Proposal	30%

To ensure the scoring ratio is maintained, the State will use the following formulas to adjust each offeror's points.

The offeror with the highest point total for the Technical Proposal will receive 700 points. The remaining offerors will receive a percentage of the maximum points available based upon the following formula:

$$\text{Technical Proposal Points} = (\text{Offeror's Technical Proposal Points} / \text{Highest Offeror's Technical Proposal Points}) \times 700$$

The offeror with the lowest proposed Total Not to Exceed Fixed Cost for the entire project (Total NTEFC) will receive 300 points. The remaining offerors will receive a percentage of the maximum cost points available based upon the following formula:
