CONTRACT CLARIFICATION*

The language in the following areas of the RFP/Contract reads as follows:

OBJECTIVES on page 2, item 4 titled Perform Best Management Practices reads: The contractor will be responsible for best management practices, up to 125 tons of gravel, and culverts. Gravel in excess of 125 tons required by the DOF will be supplied by the State.

SCOPE OF WORK – on page 17 item D reads: Perform BMP's and site reclamation. The successful Offeror will be responsible for Best Management Practices (BMPs), culverts, and up to 125 tons of gravel. Gravel in excess of 125 tons required by the DOF will be supplied by the State.

This clarification revised the language to reflect the state's intent:

OBJECTIVES on page 2, item 4 titled Perform Best Management Practices should read: The contractor will be responsible for best management practices, up to 125 tons of gravel per fiscal year, and culverts. Gravel in excess of 125 tons per fiscal year required by the DOF will be supplied by the State

SCOPE OF WORK – on page 17 item D should read: Perform BMP's and site reclamation: The successful Offeror will be responsible for Best Management Practices (BMPs), culverts, and up to 125 tons of gravel per fiscal year. Gravel in excess of 125 tons per fiscal year required by the DOF will be supplied by the State.

AMENDMENT 4

CONTRACT ADDITIONS AND CLARIFICATION*

The Contractor shall be responsible for the following additions and clarifications to the Scope of Work (addendum to contract):

1. Transportation of state forest logs will be from the cutting unit to the state forest log yard and shall not be interrupted other than to be weighed at an agreed commercial scale.
2. Contractor shall employ and properly utilize the provided state forest trip ticket for each and every load removed from the state forest.
3. No logs or any forest product shall be removed from the state forest without a proper state forest trip ticket.
4. Contractor will maintain records of inputs, outputs and delivery documentation relevant to this contract, including property/tract/sale name, date and time, contact information, township, and maps.
5. Contractor will not mix state forest certified logs with outside non-certified logs.
6. Contractor will not unload any logs from a loaded truck prior to arriving at the state forest log yard.
7. Contractor will not use the FSC® or SFI® trademarks for promotional purposes
8. Contractor agrees to be subject to an audit by ODNR-Division of Forestry's FSC® OR SFI® certification body upon request;
9. If the Contractor is FSC® Chain of Custody certified, the Contractor will
 - a. Provide services under the Contractor's own Chain of Custody program;
 - b. Make relevant records available to ODNR-Division of Forestry certification body as requested;
10. Contractor will complete an annual chain-of-custody training from the ODNR-Division of Forestry prior to the beginning of harvesting operations.
