COST NARRATIVE

1. The format and general content for the online score reporting, data file formats and other reports and documents will be finalized with the first operational use.
2. The RFP requires 9,800 Test Administrator Kits. AIR successfully delivered the AASCD in Spring 2013 with 7,221 TA Kits. To meet the annual budget target of the RFP, AIR proposes to deliver 8,700 TA Kits, which is the quantity ODE has approved for Spring 2014. However, we understand and agree that we must provide 9,800 TA Kits at no additional cost if required to successfully administer the program.
3. In the event of a reduction or change in the scope of work or partial termination for convenience, AIR assumes that any adjustment in contract price will account for potential increases in the price of the remaining tasks occasioned by such reduction or change in the scope of work.
4. AIR and ODE will agree to a Limitation of Liability with a cap of 10% of the annual Contract value for the year in which the event causing damages occurs.

Specific Deliverables

Deliverable 21

As the exact specifications for future physical manipulatives required cannot be determined until tasks and items are developed, the costs include an allowance of \$12,500 per year for these items. AIR created this estimate based on both Ohio's current materials list and on AIR's experience with physical manipulative requirements in similar programs in Delaware, Hawaii, New Mexico, and South Carolina (adjusted for Kit quantities).

Deliverable 26

Based on results from the spring 2013 standard setting workshops for the AASCD, including panelists' positive evaluations of the process and satisfaction with the recommended performance standards, AIR proposes that ODE maintain the current AASCD cut scores and did not include pricing for the standard setting workshops as part of the base pricing. If there are circumstances that require ODE to re-establish AASCD performance standards, AIR offers to conduct new standard setting workshops as a cost option for \$250,000.

**Deliverable 29**

In this deliverable AIR describes its understanding of the set of studies to be conducted. AIR understands there are some validity studies (e.g., Webb alignment) that must be contracted, designed, and executed by ODE and conducted independently of AIR's work as the AASCD vendor. While the budget does not include the costs for these studies, AIR included costs to provide inputs needed for these studies and to incorporate the results of those studies into the Technical Reports and other related deliverables.
