The respective bid response, including the [Terms and Conditions for Bidding, Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, and Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions](#) (Revised 10/2013), special contract terms & conditions, any bid addenda, specifications, pricing schedules and any attachments incorporated by reference and accepted by DAS become a part of this Requirements Contract.

This Requirements Contract is effective beginning and ending on the dates noted above unless, prior to the expiration date, the Contract is renewed, terminated or cancelled in accordance with the Contract Terms and Conditions.

This Requirements Contract is available to OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, STATE HIGHWAY PATROL, 1970 WEST BROAD STREET, COLUMBUS, OH 43223, as applicable.

Agencies are eligible to make purchases of the listed supplies and/or services in any amount and at any time as determined by the agency. The State makes no representation or guarantee that agencies will purchase the volume of supplies and/or services as advertised in the Invitation to Bid.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** State agencies may make purchases under this Requirements Contract up to \$2500.00 using the state of Ohio payment card. Any purchase that exceeds \$2500.00 will be made using the official state of Ohio purchase order (ADM-0523). Any non-state agency, institution of higher education or Cooperative Purchasing member will use forms applicable to their respective agency.

## SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Supplies will be delivered to the participating agency within sixty (60) days after receipt of order and, in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The delivery location will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Acceptance (transfer of title) will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the supplies delivered conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, acceptance shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

PRODUCT SAMPLES: The Bidder(s) may be required to submit samples of the supplies being offered. The samples will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not included as part of their bid response, the bidder will be required to provide the samples within seven (7) calendar days after notification. Failure to provide the samples within the stated time period will result in the bidder being deemed not responsive. After award of the contract, the samples will be used as a basis of comparison with actual product delivered under contract. Any variation between the samples and product being delivered will be considered as an event of default. Any variations between the samples and actual product being delivered that are due to manufacturer changes may be acceptable and shall require prior written approval from DAS.

AUTHORIZED DISTRIBUTOR OR MANUFACTURERS REPRESENTATIVE: Bidders responding to this Bid must be authorized distributors, manufacturers or representatives of manufacturers of the items bid. Bidders may be required to submit proof of the above. If requested, bidders will have seven (7) calendar days to provide proof of the relationship. If requested Bidders shall submit certification attesting that they are the manufacturer or an authorized dealer, distributor or manufacturer's representative of the products being bid. This certification must be on the manufacturer's letterhead, signed by a duly authorized employee of the manufacturer.

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the state will multiply the bid unit price per item times the estimated annual usage per item and sum the totals for all items to arrive at the lowest overall cost for all items. Failure to bid all items may result in the bidder being deemed not responsive.

CONTRACT AWARD: The contract will be awarded to one lowest responsive and responsible bidder by low lot total.

BRAND SPECIFIC AND BRAND NAME OR EQUAL SPECIFICATIONS: Where specified, the products in this Invitation To Bid (ITB) are being bid as BRAND SPECIFIC. Category A, Items 1a. 1b. 1c. 1d. 1e. and 1f. and all items in Category B. are being bid as brand specific. That signifies that no alternates will be accepted for award. Bid is in accordance with the Ohio Administrative Code 123:5-1-10 (K). Elsewhere in this bid, brand names are included as a "brand name or approved specification", in accordance the Ohio Administrative Code 123:5-1-10 (I) and with paragraph I-32 of the INSTRUCTIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BIDDING.

FIXED-PRICE WITH ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT: The contract prices(s) will remain firm for the first twelve (12) months duration of the contract. Thereafter, the Contractor may submit a request to increase their price(s) to be effective thirty (30) calendar days after acceptance by DAS. No price adjustment will be permitted prior to the effective date of the increase received by the Contractor from his suppliers, or on purchase orders that are already being processed, or on purchase orders that have been filled and are awaiting shipment. If the Contractor receives orders requiring quarterly delivery, the increase will apply to all deliveries made after the effective date of the price increase.

The price increase must be supported by a general price increase in the cost of the finished supplies, due to increases in the cost of raw materials, labor, freight, Workers' Compensation and/or Unemployment Insurance, etc. Detailed documentation, to include a comparison list of the contract items and proposed price increases, must be submitted to support the requested increase. Supportive documentation should include, but is not limited to: copies of the old and the current price lists or similar documents which indicate the original base cost of the product to the Contractor and the corresponding increase, and/or copies of correspondence sent by the Contractor's supplier on the supplier's letterhead, which contain the above price information and explains the source of the increase in such areas as raw materials, freight, fuel or labor, etc.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS (Continued)

Should there be a decrease in the cost of the finished product due to a general decline in the market or some other factor, the Contractor is responsible to notify DAS immediately. The price decrease adjustment will be incorporated into the contract and will be effective on all purchase orders issued after the effective date of the decrease. If the price decrease is a temporary decrease, such should be noted on the invoice. In the event that the temporary decrease is revoked, the contract pricing will be returned to the pricing in effect prior to the temporary decrease. For quarterly deliveries, any decrease will be applied to deliveries made after the effective date of the decrease. Failure to comply with this provision will be considered as a default and will be subject to the provisions of Article 6, "Contract Terms and Conditions".

SPECIAL CHARGES: There are to be no assessments, up-charges, single item charge, surcharge, re-stocking fee, minimum order charge nor will any additional charges be allowed that are not specifically mentioned under the provisions of the standard terms and conditions of this bid and any ensuing contract awarded pursuant to this bid.

MINIMUM ORDER: No order shall be placed against a contract awarded pursuant to this bid for less than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars.

USAGE REPORTS: Every six (6) months for the periods January through June and July through December the contractor must submit a report (written or on disk, zip drive or via email in Excel format) indicating sales generated by this contract. The report shall list usage by customer, by line item, showing the quantities/dollars generated by this contract. The report must be submitted within thirty (30) days following the completion of the reporting period. The report shall be forwarded to the Office of State Purchasing, 4200 Surface Road, Columbus, OH 43228-1395, Attn: Walter Schneider, CPPB or to: [walter.schneider@das.ohio.gov](mailto:walter.schneider@das.ohio.gov)

SWEATSHOP FREE: By the signature affixed to this ITB, Bidder certifies that all facilities used for the production of the supplies or performance of services offered in the bid are in compliance with applicable domestic labor, employment, health and safety, environmental and building laws. This certification applies to any and all suppliers and/or subcontractors used by the Bidder in furnishing the supplies or services described in the bid and awarded to the Bidder. If DAS receives a complaint alleging non-compliance with sweatshop free requirements, DAS may enlist the services of an independent monitor to investigate allegations of such non-compliance on the part of the Contractor, any sub-contractors or suppliers used by the Contractor in performance of the Contract. If allegations are proven to be accurate, the Contractor will be advised by DAS of the next course of action to resolve the complaint and the Contractor will be responsible for any costs associated with the investigation. Items that will be considered in an investigation include, but are not limited to standards for wages, occupational safety and work hours.

SPECIFICATIONS

I. SCOPE

These specifications cover the purchase of specified uniform apparel and accessories for the Ohio State Highway Patrol with delivery required to locations in Columbus, OH as specified by individual purchase orders.

II. REQUIREMENTS

- A. Where applicable instructions on measurements and/or applicable sizing charts should accompany this bid. If not submitted with the bid, Bidder(s) will have seven (7) calendar days after notification to provide same. Failure to provide instructions on measurements and/or applicable sizing charts as requested may result in the bidder being deemed not responsive. Bidders must specify if they are using standard or metric system measurements in their measurement and/or sizing charts.
- E. Each item shall be packaged and marked for the individual or ordering agency as specified.
- E. All items shall be stamped or labeled, including care instructions where applicable, indicating size, product origin and other information pertinent to labeling laws.
- D. Where applicable all items shall have loose threads removed and be pressed, shaped and finished properly in accordance with industry standards.
- E. All materials shall be first quality, new, unused and without flaws or defects which adversely affect appearance, durability or function.

SPECIFICATIONS (Contd)

- F. Where applicable, emblems supplied by the agency(s) shall be sewn on or affixed as specified at no charge.
- G. Any items found to be defective, improperly sized, or not in accordance with specifications, although accepted through oversight or otherwise, shall be replaced, repaired or altered at the expense of the contractor, including all transportation costs.
- H. Any order placed pursuant to this contract the delivery of such which contains items which do not conform to these item specifications which is received through oversight or otherwise, may be rejected at any time. Any part of the order found not in compliance with specifications due to the fault of the contractor (e.g., color, defective or improper sizing), shall be altered or replaced by the contractor at his/her expense, including all transportation costs. Any rejected item that cannot be altered to meet all terms and conditions of the specifications shall not be offered for sale to anyone else or otherwise disposed of as a wearable garment by the contractor or manufacturer without approval of the Superintendent of the State of Ohio Highway Patrol.

IV. ITEM SPECIFICATIONS

A. CATEGORY A. SIDEARM DUTY HOLSTERS AND ACCESSORY ITEMS

1. Category A. Items 1a. and 1b. Sidearm Duty Holster System Right and Left Hand Models. Brand Specific Only Safariland Model 295 Holsters as specified below.

a. General Description

Duty holster designed to accommodate the SigArms Model P-226 DAK, .40 S&W caliber, semi-automatic pistol. Holster designed for use on the Sam Browne belt. Holster shall be identified as either right-handed Model Number 295-177-91 or left-handed Model Number 295-177-92.

b. Product Function

Holster shall maintain handgun in a stable, tactically ready configuration. Holster shall have medium height ride and straight drop carry. Front unlocking design shall utilize wraparound retaining flap with conventional snap assembly with stiff socket. Internal trigger guard lock shall hold weapon on each side of the trigger guard. Holster shall have a belt loop tension device, a covered trigger guard, and shall be weatherproof.

SPECIFICATIONS (Contd)

- c. Belt Loop
- Model 2955 shall accommodate a one and one half (1.5") inch drop in the worn height of the holster. Belt loop shall be identified as either right-handed Model Number 2955-177-91 or left-handed Model Number 2955-177-92.
- d. Construction Materials
- The holster body shall be constructed of a lamination of engineered materials, polyurethane and orthopedic grade suede leather, sewn with 207 and 277 grade nylon cord stitching. Holster shall have case hardened Nyloc screws and tee-nuts. Holster shall have Aeron 120 Engineered Synthetics as reinforcement in strategic areas. Holster shall have a conventional snap assembly with stiff socket. Holster shall have an injected molded, three-piece trigger guard mechanism.
- e. Finish
- Holster shall have a high gloss Porvair finish.
- f. Manufacturing Process
- Holster body shall be heat and pressure molded with a wraparound, weltless construction to accommodate the SigArms P-226 DAK .40 S&W caliber pistol. The sight channel shall be molded into the holster body. The belt shank shall be heat and pressure molded for body curvature. The shank shall be bolted onto the holster body with case hardened hardware. The injected molded trigger guard shall be bolted into the holster with case hardened screws.
- g. Letter of Authorization
- All Bid submissions should include a letter from Safariland LTD. Inc., that the vendor is authorized to represent Safariland in this bid effort. The letter must guarantee that all requirements of this bid will be supported by the manufacturer to include, at least as a minimum: delivery of product within the specified time frame and compliance with all OSHP (Ohio State Highway Patrol) product specifications and requirements as stated in this bid. Failure to submit the letter with the ITB may deem your bid non-responsive and no further consideration for award shall be given.
2. Category A. Items 1c, 1d 1e, and 1f. Sidearm Duty Holster System Right and Left Hand Models (Brand Specific Only – Safariland Model 6280 holsters (Kydex and high gloss finish) as specified below
- a. General Description
- Duty holster designed to accommodate the SigArms Model P-226 DAK, .40 S&W caliber, semi-automatic pistol. Holster designed for use on the Sam Browne belt. Holster shall be identified as one of the following models:
- 1) 6280-277-131 (right handed, STX tactical finish)
  - 2) 6280-277-132 (left handed, STX tactical finish)
  - 3) 6280-277-91 (right handed, STX high gloss finish)
  - 4) 6280-277-92 (left handed, STX high gloss finish)
- b. Product Function
- Product features a Self-Locking System (SLS) rotating hood and the Universal Belt Loop (UBL) that mounts to a 2 in. (50 mm) or 2.25 in. (58 mm) duty belt. It features a tensioning device which, when firmly adjusted, provides for Level III Retention. Includes a molded sight track, suede lining.
- c. Finish
- Holster shall be available in two distinct finishes, the STX hardshell tactical finish and the STX high gloss finish.

SPECIFICATIONS (Contd)

d. Letter of Authorization

All Bid submissions should include a letter from Safariland LTD. Inc., that the vendor is authorized to represent Safariland in this bid effort. The letter must guarantee that all requirements of this bid will be supported by the manufacturer to include, at least as a minimum: delivery of product within the specified time frame and compliance with all OSHP (Ohio State Highway Patrol) product specifications and requirements as stated in this bid. Failure to submit the letter with the ITB may deem your bid non-responsive and no further consideration for award shall be given.

3. Category A. Items 2a, 2b, and 2c. Sam Browne Belt, Sam Browne Shoulder Strap and Duty Belt. Brand name or approved equal as specified below.

a. General Description – Item 2a and 2b – Sam Browne Belt and Shoulder Strap

All outside finish material shall be high gloss Porvair. Belt constructed with ambidextrous “D” rings. Belt width 2 ¼ inches. Buckle and “D” ring to be nickel plated solid brass. Shoulder cross strap made of leather lined high gloss Porvair with nickel plated solid brass buckle.

b. Detailed Description- Item 2a Sam Browne Belt, Equal to Gould & Goodrich KPA-CL and item 2b Sam Browne Shoulder Strap – Equal to Gould & Goodrich H99-CL

1) Materials: Sam Browne Belt made of high gloss Porvair outer layer laminated to a full grain tanned leather liner. Overall thickness of the belt is 13-14 oz. Belt buckle and “D” rings nickel plated solid brass. Hook and stud are matte black finish. Shoulder strap made of high gloss Porvair laminated to 6/7 oz. russet leather. Buckle and studs nickel plated solid brass.

2) Design: The belt shall be 2 ¼” wide and shall be furnished with two (2) nickel plated, solid brass D rings held in place by a sewn down keeper that uses a snap closure. All belts shall be equipped with four (4) snap fasteners for easy removal from the Sam Browne belt and shoulder strap. The location of the four (4) snap fasteners shall enable the utilization of the Sam Browne belt by either left or right-handed shooters. Belt shall have a nickel plated solid brass belt buckle measuring 1 7/8” x 2 7/8”. Buckle chafe on the hook end 3” wide. Belts shall be sized in two inch increments, with five adjustment holes per belt. An additional two inches to be added to the length of the belt to ensure good fit. Belt edges to be rounded and burnished. Belt shall have one keeper loop 3/4” wide.

c. Detailed Description – Item 2b – Sam Browne Shoulder Strap, Equal to Gould & Goodrich H99-CL

1) Sam Browne shoulder strap shall be sewn with Dacron polyester thread. Strap shall have six adjustment holes spaced 3/4” apart. Lead up strap to be 8 ¼” long, 1 ¼” wide tapering to 7/8” wide at the buckle. There shall be loops at each end of the strap for placement of Dee rings. The loops shall hook over a matte black stud for ease of replacing the Dee rings. The lead up strap shall also have a snap that allows the buckle to be changed from a chrome finish to brass finish. The shoulder strap shall have one 3/8” belt keeper.

2) All material and workmanship must match existing equipment presently being worn by the Ohio State Highway Patrol.

3) The size of the belt or shoulder strap must be stamped on the back of the item in such a manner that the size of the item is easily readable.

d. General Description – Item 2c – Duty Belt – Brand name or equal to Bianchi 7980 – Plain Finish

Duty Belt – Four part laminate construction for firmness and holster support. It features a Duraskin exterior with loop lining. It features a tri-release shatter-resistant polymer buckle. Its 3-point release provides extra security from inadvertent release. Plain black finish, 2.25” wide belt.

e. Sizes

1) Item 2a Sam Browne Belt: Shall be offered in size range 28” to 48”.

2) Item 2b Shoulder Straps: Shall be offered in size range 30” to 50”.

3) Item 2c Duty belt shall be offered in size range 28-34, 34-40, 40-46, and 46-52.

SPECIFICATIONS (Contd)

4. Category A. Item 3a and 3b. Handcuff Case. Brand name or approved equal as specified below.

a. Detailed Description – Item 3a – Handcuff Case, Equal to Gould & Goodrich H583CLHS

Rugged and stylish handcuff case has full flap held closed with a hidden snap. The case will be slotted to slide onto a Sam Browne belt that is 2 ¼ inches in width. The handcuff case must accommodate a pair of Peerless brand double hinged handcuffs. The case shall be manufactured from high gloss Porvair laminated to a 4 to 5 ounce russet leather liner. Handcuff case is to be head and pressure molded with a 4 to 5 ounce black insert. Thread shall be Dacron polyester with 5 to 7 stitches per inch. All edges are to be finished with black dye and rubbed. The flap is to have a single hidden snap for closure.

b. Detailed Description – Item 3b Handcuff Case, Equal to Safariland 90H-22HS

Designed to fit Peerless brand double hinged handcuffs. The case is constructed of durable SafariLaminate material and is designed for 2.25 in. (58 mm) duty belts. This unit has a full flap with a single hidden snap for closure. Hardshell STX, with STX tactical finish.

5. Category A. Item 4a and 4b, Double Magazine Pouch. Brand name or approved equal as specified below.

a. Detailed Description – Item 4a, Double Magazine Pouch, Equal to Safariland 77-76-9HS

The magazine pouch shall be black and accommodate two magazines for a 40 caliber Sig Sauer model P-226 DAK pistol. There are to be separate compartment for each magazine. Shall be high gloss Porvair finish and be manufactured with four slots to allow it to be worn in either the vertical or horizontal position. The overall size of the pouch shall be approximately 4" wide by 6" long. The depth of the compartments shall be approximately 3 ½". The magazine pouch is to be constructed of high gloss Porvair laminated to a 4 to 5 ounce vegetable tanned cowhide. The pouches are to be molded using heat and pressure. All stitching is to be 6 to 7 stitches per inch using black Dacron polyester thread. All edges are to be burnished to a smooth finish and dyed black. The covers shall be secured using a single hidden snap on each cover.

b. Detailed Description – Item 4b, Double Magazine Pouch, Equal to Safariland 77-76-13PBL

The magazine pouch shall be black and accommodate two magazines for a 40 caliber Sig Sauer model P-226 DAK pistol. There are to be separate compartment for each magazine. Holder is designed to carry two magazines on a 2.25 in. (58 mm) duty belt. Holder features both vertical and horizontal belt slots, allowing it to ride in either a vertical or low-profile horizontal position. A magazine tension screw located between the two pouches allows for easy retention adjustment. Hardshell STX, with STX tactical finish.

6. Category A. Item 5a and 5b. Chemical Mace Holder. Brand name or approved equal as specified below.

a. Detailed Description- Item 5a, Chemical Mace Holder, Equal to Safariland 38-4-9HS

Mace holder shall be black and designed to accommodate an MK III style aerosol canister mace. Top flap to have hidden snap closure. Holder shall be designed to attach to a 2 ¼" wide duty belt. Overall height of pouch when snapped approximately 5". Holder to be constructed of high gloss Porvair laminated to 4 to 5 ounce cowhide. Thread shall be Dacron polyester with 5 to 7 stitches per inch. All edges are to be finished with black dye and burnished to a smooth finish. The flap shall have a single hidden snap for closure.

b. Detailed Description – Item 5b, Chemical Mace Holder, Equal to Safariland 38-4-13PBL

The holder is designed for 2.25 in. (58 mm) duty belts to accommodate an MKIII style aerosol canister mace. Top flap to have black snap closer. Hardshell STX with STX tactical finish.

7. Category A, Item 6a.and 6b. Belt Keeper, 2 snap. Brand name or approved equal as specified below.

a. Detailed Description Item 6a, Belt Keeper, 2 snap, Equal to Safariland 65-4-2PBL

2 snap belt keeper designed for a 2.25" wide duty belt. Each individual keeper approximately 8' long with plain black finish and black snap closure. Each package includes 4 keepers.

SPECIFICATIONS (Contd)

b. Detailed Description for Item 6b. High Gloss Belt Keeper 2 snap, Equal to Gould & Goodrich H76CLHS.

2 snap belt keeper designed for a 2.25: wide duty belt. Each keeper shall be constructed of black dyed leather approximately 1" by 8" in length finished in high gloss Porvair. Closure design shall be hidden snap.

8. Category A. Item 7. Leather Trouser Belt

a. Design and Detailed Description, item 7. Leather Trouser Belt

- 1) Trouser belt is to be black, 1 ¾" wide finished in high gloss Porvair. At the buckle end of the belt there shall be two snaps to allow for the removal of the buckle to allow for replacement with a new buckle if needed. After the buckle is in place a ½ inch belt keeper will be placed between the two snaps. The snaps are to be black on the finished side to match the belt material. On the opposite end of the belt starting approximately 3 ½ inches from the end there shall be five or six round or oval holes spaced approximately 1 inch apart for adjustment of the buckle.
- 2) The belt is to be finished full grain tanned leather weighing 4 ½ to 5 ounces finished with high gloss Porvair. A trouser belt with a synthetic backing laminated to a Porvair outer layer will not be accepted.
- 3) The buckle is to be style 8402 solid brass finished in nickel.
- 4) Thread shall be vat dyed black three strand Polyester to match the color finish of the belt. Stitching shall be approximately six to seven stitches per inch.
