## SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS:** The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

**BIDDER REQUIREMENTS:** Bidders shall read this bid carefully in its entirety and obtain a complete understanding of the Instructions to Bidders, Terms and Conditions for Bidding, the Standard Contract Terms and Conditions and Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions all of which are available through the link on the first page of this Bid. Additionally Bidders shall carefully read and understand all provisions of the Special Contract Terms and Conditions and Bid Specifications on Bid pages 3 through 10 below and shall complete all required information below. These resources contain conditions vital to this Bid and any ensuing Contract which require Bidder/Contractor knowledge and compliance. Failure to comply with or falsification of any of the certifications contained therein shall result disqualification from further consideration of your Bid or in the case of an awarded contract, contract suspension or termination for cause.

**BIDDER RESPONSIBILITY:** As part of the test for Responsibility as defined in section I-21 of the Instructions, Terms and Conditions for Bidding incorporated by reference on page one of this Bid, DAS may require Bidders to provide information related to the Bidder's ability to perform the work or provide the goods and/or services requested in this Bid. Information required may include but may not be limited to references for whom the contractor has provided the same or similar work or goods and services within the last two calendar years, proof that the Bidder is an authorized distributor or manufacturer's representative, Bidder financial records, actual invoices and/or other proof of responsibility. If requested, unless otherwise provided Bidder will have seven (7) calendar days to provide such information after requested in writing. Failure to provide the information requested within the time frame specified may result in the Bidder being determined not responsive and disqualified from further consideration for award. These tests may also be applied to subcontractors or fulfillment houses utilized by the Bidder in the performance of the contract.

**DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE:** Supplies will be delivered to the participating agency within thirty (30) days after receipt of order and, in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The delivery location will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Acceptance (transfer of title) will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the supplies delivered conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, acceptance shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

**EVALUATION:** Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the state will multiply the price bid by each bidder for each item by the estimated annual usage for that item. The resulting quantity will be summed to determine the single lowest cost responsive and responsible state of Ohio Equal Opportunity Division (EOD) Certified Minority Business Enterprise bidder.

**CONTRACT AWARD:** The contract will be awarded to the single lowest responsive and responsible state of Ohio EOD Certified Minority Business Enterprise bidder by low lot. Failure to bid all items may result in the bidder being deemed not responsive and disqualified from further consideration for award.

**SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS (Continued)**

**MINIMUM ORDER:** Subject to section S-10. of the Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions the minimum dollar value of any order placed against a contract awarded pursuant to this bid for delivery F.O.B. destination, transportation charges prepaid, at any one time to one destination, shall not be less than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars.

**DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE:** The Bidder should submit descriptive literature of the supplies or services being offered as part of their bid submission. The literature will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Any references, that may appear in the descriptive literature, that may alter the terms and conditions and specifications of the bid (e.g. F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change), will not be part of any contract and will be disregarded by DAS. Failure of the bidder to furnish descriptive literature as part of their bid response will deem the bidder not responsive.

**PRODUCT SAMPLES:** The bidder(s) may be required to submit samples of the supplies being offered. The samples will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not included as part of their bid response, the bidder will be required to provide the samples within seven (7) calendar days after notification. Failure to provide the samples within the stated time period will result in the bidder being deemed not responsive. After award of the contract, the samples will be used as a basis of comparison with actual product delivered under contract. Any variation between the samples and product being delivered will be considered as an event of default. Any variations between the samples and actual product being delivered that are due to manufacturer changes may be acceptable and shall require prior written approval from DAS.

**REFERENCES TO ALTERNATE TERMS:** Any reference, which may appear on any price list or literature, to any terms and conditions, such as F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change, will not be part of any contract with the successful bidder(s) and will be disregarded by DAS.

**SPECIAL CHARGES:** There shall be no assessment, surcharge, small order charge, broken case charge, minimum order charge, single item charge nor any other unspecified additional charge allowed by the State that is not specifically mentioned in this bid or in any contract awarded pursuant to this bid. The contractor must provide merchandise in unit quantity(s) as indicated in the bid/bid response/contract.

**FIXED-PRICE WITH ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT:** The contract prices(s) will remain firm for the first twelve (12) months duration of the contract. Thereafter, the Contractor may submit a request to increase their price(s) to be effective thirty (30) calendar days after acceptance by DAS. No price adjustment will be permitted prior to the effective date of the increase received by the Contractor from his suppliers, or on purchase orders that are already being processed, or on purchase orders that have been filled and are awaiting shipment. If the Contractor receives orders requiring quarterly delivery, the increase will apply to all deliveries made after the effective date of the price increase.

The price increase must be supported by a general price increase in the cost of the finished supplies, due to increases in the cost of raw materials, labor, freight, Workers' Compensation and/or Unemployment Insurance, etc. Detailed documentation, to include a comparison list of the contract items and proposed price increases, must be submitted to support the requested increase. Supportive documentation should include, but is not limited to: copies of the old and the current price lists or similar documents which indicate the original base cost of the product to the Contractor and the corresponding increase, and/or copies of correspondence sent by the Contractor's supplier on the supplier's letterhead, which contain the above price information and explains the source of the increase in such areas as raw materials, freight, fuel or labor, etc.

Should there be a decrease in the cost of the finished product due to a general decline in the market or some other factor, the Contractor is responsible to notify DAS immediately. The price decrease adjustment will be incorporated into the contract and will be effective on all purchase orders issued after the effective date of the decrease. If the price decrease is a temporary decrease, such should be noted on the invoice. In the event that the temporary decrease is revoked, the contract pricing will be returned to the pricing in effect prior to the temporary decrease. For quarterly deliveries, any decrease will be applied to deliveries made after the effective date of the decrease. Failure to comply with this provision will be considered as a default and will be subject to Provision I.C. "Termination/Suspension" and Provision II. of the "Contract Remedies:" of the "Standard Contract Terms and Conditions".

**USAGE REPORTS:** Every six (6) months the contractor must submit a report (written or on disk or via email in Excel format) indicating sales generated by this contract. The report shall list usage by customer, by line item, showing the quantities/dollars generated by this contract. The report shall be forwarded to the Office of Procurement Services, 4200 Surface Road, Columbus, OH 43228-1395, Attn: Walter Schneider ([walter.schneider@das.state.oh.us](mailto:walter.schneider@das.state.oh.us)).

**SWEATSHOP FREE:** By the signature affixed to this RAQS/Bid submission, Bidder certifies that all facilities used for the production of the supplies or performance of services offered in this Invitation To Bid are in compliance with applicable domestic labor, employment, health and safety, environmental and building laws. This certification applies to any and all suppliers and/or subcontractors used by the Bidder in furnishing the supplies or services described in the bid and awarded to the Bidder. If DAS receives a complaint alleging non-compliance with sweatshop free requirements, DAS may enlist the services of an independent monitor to investigate allegations of such non-compliance on the part of the Contractor, any subcontractors or suppliers used by the Contractor in performance of the Contract. If allegations are proven to be accurate, the Contractor will be advised by DAS of the next course of action to resolve the complaint and the Contractor will be responsible for any costs associated with the investigation. Items that will be considered in an investigation include, but are not limited to standards for wages, occupational safety and work hours.

## GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

### **I. SCOPE**

- A. The purpose of this Invitation To Bid is to establish a contract between the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services on behalf of the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections Ohio Penal Industries (OPI). OPI requires various items for use in the manufacture of garments and other textile and fabric articles at OPI factories located at various OPI facilities as indicated in this Invitation To Bid. The resulting contract is to contain the following components:

### **II. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

- A. All materials and supplies are to be new and unused, of first quality, meet industry acceptability standards and free from any type of manufacturing defect(s), dirt, and/or debris. Defective materials discovered when opened and inspected for use will be returned immediately at the contractor's expense.
- B. All materials and supplies are to be packaged to meet the normal rigors of transportation to arrive clean, dry and damage free. Any materials delivered in damaged condition will be refused, placed back on the transportation vehicle for return to the contractor at the contractor's expense.
- C. Required thread colors are indicated in the material specifications and pricing schedule of this Invitation To Bid. Those and as indicated all other of the manufacturer's standard colors shall also be made available at the contract price as bid.
- D. If requested, the awarded contractor shall provide OPI with four (4) each color charts that indicate the colors and shades with numbers and names for all thread available from the manufacturer. Exact thread colors per item will be agreed upon between the OPI Garment Shop at the appropriate Correctional Institution and the awarded contractor.
- E. All thread provided shall be on Cones or spools as specified and/or packaged by the manufacturer. Bid pricing for Cotton Wrapped Polyester Core thread shall be by cone (and will be evaluated by price per cone comprised of 6000 linear yards) however the contract Unit of Measure shall be by Carton (bid prices per cone will be extended by the number of cones per carton for the winning bidder and priced on any awarded contract accordingly.
