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### SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Supplies will be delivered to the participating agency within thirty (30) days after receipt of order and, in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The delivery location will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Acceptance (transfer of title) will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the supplies delivered conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, acceptance shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

SPECIAL NOTE: DAS / OPI reserves the right to add any additional institutional sites for shipment. Primary shipment institutions are listed on page 6 all other potential institutional locations for shipment are listed on page 7.

DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE: The Bidder may be required to submit descriptive literature of the supplies or services being offered. If requested, the literature will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not provided as part of the bid response, the Bidder must provide said literature within ten (10) calendar days after request/notification by the Office of Procurement Services to do so. Any references, that may appear in the descriptive literature, that may alter the terms and conditions and specifications of the bid (i.e. F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change), will not be part of any contract and will be disregarded by the state of Ohio. Failure of the bidder to furnish descriptive literature either as part of their bid response or within the time specified herein will deem the bidder not responsive.

PRODUCT SAMPLES: The bidder(s) may be required to submit samples of the supplies being offered. The samples will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not included as part of their bid response, the bidder will be required to provide the samples within ten (10) calendar days after notification. Failure to provide the samples within the stated time period will result in the bidder being deemed not responsive. After award of the contract, the samples will be used as a basis of comparison with actual product delivered under contract. Any variation between the samples and product being delivered will be considered as an event of default. Any variations between the samples and actual product being delivered that are due to manufacturer changes may be acceptable and shall require prior written approval from DAS.

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the state will multiply the estimated annual usage of each item by its corresponding unit price and then add these totals together. If unknown usages a quantity of one will be used for the evaluation. Failure to bid all items may result in the bidder being deemed as not-responsive.

CONTRACT AWARD: The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder by low lot total. Low lot total will be determined by multiplying the unit cost by the estimated usage listed in the bid and then adding each of the totals together to arrive at a total for all items. Failure to bid all items may result in the bidder being deemed not responsive. Bidder shall offer only one (1) make of slide: (i.e. Accuride , Knappe & Vogt etc.) for all items, if available, except for OPI item #010532 (Flipper Door Slide).

MINIMUM ORDER: No order shall be placed against a contract awarded pursuant to this bid for less than One-Hundred (\$100.00) dollars. The minimum dollar value of any order placed against a contract awarded pursuant to this bid for delivery F.O.B. destination, transportation charges prepaid, at any one time to one destination, shall not be less than as stated in the minimum order quantity on page nine (9) of the bid.

ON ORDERS TOTALING LESS THAN MINIMUM ORDER QUANTITY: Shipment is to be made by freight, parcel post, express or commercial package delivery, whichever is the most economical method for proper delivery of the item F.O.B. destination. The cost of transportation from the contractor's address to the destination on such orders shall be prepaid and added to the invoice.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS (cont.)

FIXED-PRICE WITH ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT: The contract prices(s) will remain firm for the first six (6) months duration of the contract. Thereafter, the Contractor may submit a request to increase their price(s) to be effective thirty (30) calendar days after acceptance by DAS. No price adjustment will be permitted prior to the effective date of the increase received by the Contractor from his suppliers, or on purchase orders that are already being processed, or on purchase orders that have been filled and are awaiting shipment. If the Contractor receives orders requiring quarterly delivery, the increase will apply to all deliveries made after the effective date of the price increase.

The price increase must be supported by a general price increase in the cost of the finished supplies, due to increases in the cost of raw materials, labor, freight, Workers' Compensation and/or Unemployment Insurance, etc. Detailed documentation, to include a comparison list of the contract items and proposed price increases, must be submitted to support the requested increase. Supportive documentation should include, but is not limited to: copies of the old and the current price lists or similar documents which indicate the original base cost of the product to the Contractor and the corresponding increase, and/or copies of correspondence sent by the Contractor's supplier on the supplier's letterhead, which contain the above price information and explains the source of the increase in such areas as raw materials, freight, fuel or labor, etc.

Should there be a decrease in the cost of the finished product due to a general decline in the market or some other factor, the Contractor is responsible to notify DAS immediately. The price decrease adjustment will be incorporated into the contract and will be effective on all purchase orders issued after the effective date of the decrease. If the price decrease is a temporary decrease, such should be noted on the invoice. In the event that the temporary decrease is revoked, the contract pricing will be returned to the pricing in effect prior to the temporary decrease. For quarterly deliveries, any decrease will be applied to deliveries made after the effective date of the decrease. Failure to comply with this provision will be considered as a default and will be subject to Provision I.C. "Termination/Suspension" and Provision II. of the "Contract Remedies:" of the "Standard Contract Terms and Conditions".

USAGE REPORTS: Every six (6) months the contractor must submit a report (written or on disk) indicating sales generated by this contract. The report shall list usage by customer, by line item, showing the quantities/dollars generated by this contract. The report shall be forwarded to the Office of Procurement Services, 4200 Surface Road, Columbus, OH 43228-1395, Attn: Jennifer Dammeyer.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS (cont.)

## SPECIFICATIONS

### I. SCOPE AND CLASSIFICATION

The Office of State Procurement is requesting competitive bids for OPI Correctional Industries for different models and different lengths of drawer slides to be used in the manufacture of furniture for resale in the OPI Furniture Factories at Madison, Marion and Ross Correctional Institutions.

### II. GENERAL DRAWER SLIDE REQUIRED FEATURES:

- A. All full extension drawer slides shall have a minimum of three (3) per inch metal ball bearing actions.
- B. All 3/4 inch extension drawer slides shall have a minimum of three (3) per inch metal ball roller bearing.
- C. All slides shall have a liftoff, trigger or friction disconnect.
- D. All slides shall have felt pads or rubber/plastic bumper cushioned stops.
- E. Finish shall be zinc plated with clear chromate finish or equal.
- F. All slides shall include necessary mounting screws or hardware.

### III. PACKAGING AND SHIPPING:

- A. Individual cartons shall not exceed 25 pair or 50 left or 50 right handed slides.
- B. Corrugated cartons shall be of sufficient bursting strength, have separators and have a method of closure that will withstand normal transportation and factory movement/use and insure protection of the slides.

### IV. QUALITY AND STANDARDS

- A. All items offered shall be of top grade quality and workmanship, for example, Accuride, Knape & Vogt (or equivalent).
- B. All items offered should meet national industry standards.
