Any purchase that exceeds \$2500.00 will be made using the official State of Ohio purchase order (ADM-0523). Any non-state agency, institution of higher education or Cooperative Purchasing member will use forms applicable to their respective agency.

AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Supplies will be delivered to the participating agency within 30 days after receipt of order and, in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The delivery location will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Acceptance (transfer of title) will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the supplies delivered conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, acceptance shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

BID QUESTIONS OR CLARIFICATION: Information regarding submission of questions and clarifications for this bid is provided on page one (1) of the bid. Through the indicated inquiry closure date, bidders may visit the State Procurement website to post bid related questions at www.ohio.gov/procure. Answers to all bidder questions will be posted on the State Procurement website and linked to the bid number. The State will make every effort to respond to website inquiries within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt. The State will not respond to any verbal or written questions received through any other medium. No prospective bidder shall respond to any verbal instructions or changes to this bid. Only communications issued by the Department of Administrative Services, State Procurement in the form of an addendum will be considered valid.

PRODUCT SAMPLES: The bidder(s) may be required to submit samples of the supplies being offered. The samples will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not included as part of their bid response, the bidder will be required to provide the samples within ten (10) calendar days after notification. Failure to provide the samples within the stated time period will result in the bidder being deemed not responsive. After award of the contract, the samples will be used as a basis of comparison with actual product delivered under contract. Any variation between the samples and product being delivered will be considered as an event of default. Any variations between the samples and actual product being delivered that are due to manufacturer changes may be acceptable and shall require prior written approval from DAS.

AUTHORIZED DISTRIBUTOR: All Bid submissions must include a letter from the manufacturer, on manufacturer's letterhead, that the Bidder is authorized to represent the manufacturer in this Bid effort. The letter must guarantee that all requirements of this Bid will be supported by the manufacturer to include, at least as a minimum: delivery of product within the specified time frame and compliance with all Bid specifications. Failure to submit the letter with the ITB may deem your Bid non responsive.

MULTIPLE AWARD CONTRACT BY CATEGORY: This bid is issued to establish a Multiple Award Contract (MAC) with manufacturers within each category. A MAC is a contract made with one or more suppliers of the same or similar types of supplies or services at varying prices for delivery within the same geographic area. The state's obligations under a MAC are subject to the Ohio Controlling Board's continuing authorization to use the MAC program authorizing the use of Multiple Award Contracts. By the signature affixed to Page 1, of this Bid, the Bidder certifies that it is currently in compliance and will continue to adhere to the requirements of the Ohio Ethics Law, Ohio Revised Code Section 102.04. The Bidder affirms that, as applicable to the Bidder, no party listed in Ohio Revised Code Section 3517.13 (I) or (J) or spouse of such party has made, as an individual, within the two previous calendar years, one or more contributions totaling in excess of \$1,000.00 to the Governor or to his campaign committees.

DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE: Prior to award of the contract, the Contractor shall furnish the participating agency and DAS Procurement with the exact descriptive literature and, if applicable, to include price lists submitted as part of the bid response. Requested literature and price lists must be provided to the requesting agency within ten (10) calendar days of the request. Furthermore, if a price increase is requested by the Contractor and granted by DAS during the term of the contract, the Contractor must submit the new price list to any participating agency within ten (10) calendar days. Failure to provide the price list and/or descriptive literature to any participating agency as stipulated herein will be considered as an event of default. Any references, that may appear in the descriptive literature, that may alter the terms and conditions and specifications of the bid (e.g. F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change), will not be part of any contract and will be disregarded by the state of Ohio.

SPECIAL CHARGES: There shall be no assessment, surcharge, small order charge, broken case charge, minimum order charge, single item charge nor any other unspecified additional charge allowed by the State that is not specifically mentioned in this bid or in any contract awarded pursuant to this bid. The contractor must provide merchandise in unit quantity(s) as indicated in the bid/bid response/contract.

ON ORDERS TOTALING LESS THAN ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS: Shipment is to be made by freight, parcel post, express or commercial package delivery, whichever is the most economical method for proper delivery of the item, F.O.B. destination. The cost of transportation from the vendor's address to the destination on such orders shall be prepaid and added to the invoice.

ORDERS TOTALING LESS THAN STATED ITEM MINIMUM: Shipment is to be made by freight, parcel post, express or commercial package delivery, whichever is the most economical method for proper delivery of the item, F.O.B. destination. The cost of transportation from the vendor's address to the destination on such orders shall be prepaid and added to the invoice. Failure to provide or state a minimum order quantity shall be interpreted as no minimum order applies to any order.

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the state will evaluate one identified section of volume discount located on the "Pricing Schedule" of this Invitation to Bid.

CONTRACT AWARD: A contract will be awarded to one responsive and responsible bidder per manufacturer per category. Where two or more bidders offer the same manufacturer the contract will be awarded to the bidder offering the greatest discount to the manufacturer's price list(s).

FIXED-PRICE WITH COST ADJUSTMENT: The Contractor's catalog and/or price list submitted with the bid and included as part of the contract award will remain in effect during the first six (6) months of the Contract. Thereafter, there may be a new catalog and/or price list with additional items published. In this case it will be necessary for the Contractor to supply the Office of Procurement Services with one (1) copy of each as applicable. The State reserves the right to accept additional items which benefit the intent of this Contract and accept price increases which can be justified by the cost of finished supplies due to increases in the cost of raw materials, labor, freight, Worker's Compensation and/or Unemployment Insurance, etc. The discount awarded on the original Contract will not change. Detailed documentation to support any proposed price increase must be submitted to the Office of Procurement Services. Pricing contained in the new catalog and/or price list will become effective thirty (30) days after receipt of notice by the Office of Procurement Services. Thereafter, state agencies may obtain the new catalog and/or price list from the Contractor.

SPECIFICATIONS

The purpose of this solicitation is to establish a contract for fixed pricing for the exclusive use by the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

This will be a multi awarded contract, based on each area or the contract as a whole. Initial product lines and services covered by this invitation to bid shall include, at a minimum, the following items:

CATEGORY I: GENERAL SPECIFICATION LAMINATE COVERED SUBSTRATE (PARTICLEBOARD), SURFACES AND BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS

A. GENERAL SPECIFICATION LAMINATE COVERED SUBSTRATE (PARTICLEBOARD)

- 1. Density: 40 lb. per cubic foot minimum
- 2. Length & Width Tolerances: +/- 0.080 / inch
- 3. Modulus of Rupture: 2,103 psi minimum
- 4. Modulus of Elasticity: 326,300 psi minimum
- 5. Internal Bond: 65 psi minimum
- 6. Linear Expansion: 0.35% maximum
- 7. Face: 225 lb. minimum
- 8. Edge: 202 lb. minimum
- 9. Fermaldehyde Emissions 0.30 ppm maximum

B. GENERAL SPECIFICATION – LAMINATE SURFACES

- 1. Laminate and backer surfaces shall be hot- or cold-glued or thermally fused to the substrate (particleboard) as specified in this ITB. The face sheet shall be high pressure laminate (HPL) or NEMA HPL equivalent and shall meet the performance requirements of NEMA VGS as outlined in NEMA LD 3-2005.
- 2. Single-faced sheets shall have a phenolic backer sheet in a complimentary medium to dark brown solid color. Backer sheet shall be .028" phenolic backing material to seal the board and provide a structural balance to the laminate.
- 3. Laminate surfaces shall withstand the minimum number of cycles in resistance to wear in accordance with NEMA test 3.01 as outlined in NEMA LD 3-2005. The laminate surfaces shall be heat resistant. Surfaces shall be warranted against delamination under normal conditions.
- 4. The laminate sheeting applied to the substrate shall have a minimum thickness of 0.028" + 0.001/ -0.004".
- 5. Colors and Patterns: Bidders should include all colors and patterns to be made available to OPI as part of this bid. Non-required colors should be bid in the optional section of the bid. At a minimum, the following colors and patterns, or their equivalents, must be included in the mandatory bid item section on page 9 and 10.

- 6. OPI desires substrate (particleboard) with affixed laminate made available in the following thicknesses: 1/4", 1/2", 3/4", 1" and 1 1/8" in the sizes as specified in the Pricing Schedules. DAS on behalf of OPI is also requesting bids on the thicknesses and sizes that may be used by OPI in the future for the manufacture of office furniture. Optional thicknesses and sizes will not be included in the evaluation of the bids received. No alternatives will be accepted for thickness.

Width x Length all panels will be structurally sound within, as appropriate the 48" x 96" , 48" x 108", 60" x 108", 60" x 120" and 60" x 144" dimensions. Width x length as shipped shall be approximately 49" x 97", 49" x 109", 60 x 109", 60" x 121" and 60" x 145". Edges shall be untrimmed.

SPECIFICATIONS CONT'D.

C. BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS - LAMINATE SURFACES

To be considered for an award under this contract, the bidder shall have satisfactorily demonstrated that the following requirements have been met.

1. That it has in operation a factory, or is an authorized agent for a factory, adequate for, the manufacture and delivery of the product which it proposes to furnish.
2. Upon the request of DAS, bidders may be required to provide up to five (5) 48" x 96" panels of each 1/2", 3/4", 1" and 1-1/8" thick panels (in any color or pattern) for testing in its manufacturing facilities and approved for use by OPI / DAS prior to the award of this contract.

D. REQUIREMENTS – LAMINATE SURFACES

1. Quality & Standards: All items must be of first quality and free from material defects. All items in this ITB, shall, meet or exceed the bid specifications. Bidders (s) may be required to provide performance test results for any item(s) bid within ten (10) calendar days after the initial request from the Office of State Procurement.
2. Warranty: The Contractor(s) must warrant the offered product(s) to be free from material and workmanship defects at the time the shipment is made from the factory / warehouse and that this product will provide the measure of service expected.
3. Discontinued Items: In the even that an item is discontinued by an awarded Contractor, the Contractor shall notify the Office of State Procurement in writing, of such discontinuation. A sixty (60) day notice, prior to discontinuation, shall be provided to the Office of State Procurement.

CATEGORY II: MELAMINE COVERED SUBSTRATE (PARTICLEBOARD) AND SURFACES

A. GENERAL SPECIFICATION - MELAMINE COVERED SUBSTRATE (PARTICLEBOARD)

Substrates for melamine covered particleboard, as specified, shall meet or exceed the following specifications:

B. GENERAL SPECIFICATION - MELAMINE SURFACES

1. Melamine surfaces, faces and backer sheet, shall be thermally fused to the particleboard substrate, as specified in this ITB.
2. Single-faced sheets shall have a melamine balance backer sheet in a complimentary medium to dark brown solid color.
3. OPI desires substrate (particleboard) with affixed melamine made available in the following thicknesses: 1/4", 1/2", 3/4", 1", and 1 1/8" in the sizes as specified in the bid price schedules. DAS on behalf of OPI is also requesting bids on thicknesses and sizes that may be used by OPI in the future for the manufacture of office furniture. Optional thicknesses and sizes will not be included in the evaluation of the bid. No alternates will be accepted for thicknesses.

Width x Length all panels will be structurally sound within, as appropriate the 48" x 96" , 48" x 108", 60" x 108", 60" x 120" and 60" x 144" dimensions. Width x length as shipped shall be approximately 49" x 97", 49" x 109", 60 x 109", 60" x 121" and 60" x 145". Edges shall be untrimmed.

4. Melamine surfaces shall conform to the wear resistance requirements in accordance with NEMA test 3.01 as outlined in NEMA LD 3-2005 3, 13. Surfaces shall be warranted against delamination under normal conditions.

SPECIFICATIONS CONT'D.

5. Colors and Patterns: Bidders should include all colors and patterns to be made available to OPI as a part of this bid. Non-required colors should be bid in the optional section of the bid. At a minimum, the following colors and patterns, or their equivalents, must be included in the mandatory bid item section on pages 11 and 12.

CATEGORY III: EDGEBANDING

A. Edgebanding shall be a minimum of .018 thickness, PVC, with a glueable back.

- i. All edgebanding shall match all colors and patterns of laminate covered substrate (particleboard) and melamine covered particleboard.
- ii. Edgebanding shall be available in the following widths: 15/16", 7/8", 1 1/4" and 1 1/2" with the length of the roll of 250 ft minimum.

CATEGORY IV: T-MOLD

The T-Mold shall be available in the following minimum widths: 5/8", 7/8" and 1 1/4" with the length of the roll of 250 ft minimum. The widths and lengths shall be available in the following colors: black, grey and sand.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Discounts: Volume discounts are to be applied against the price list submitted with the solicitation. All bidders must specify in writing that the prices quoted to OPI are as competitive in comparison to the same products being offered to similar customers.
2. Marketing Requirements: OPI may sell the finished products, without restriction, to any legal entity in the United States as governed by the Ohio Revised Code.
3. Quantities: OPI reserves the right to order any quantity necessary to meet the requirements of OPI. No guarantee is made by OPI to purchase any amount of product from any awarded contractor.
4. Recycled Content/Green Initiatives: The awarded contractor(s) shall be able to supply, upon request, the material origins and recycle content of all purchased components. Awarded contractor(s) shall also be able to assist OPI in achieving GreenGuard Certification for indoor air quality and shall also be able to assist OPI when presenting the finished products to customers seeking LEED-certification on new projects.
