The respective bid response, including the [Terms and Conditions for Bidding, Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, and Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions](#), special contract terms & conditions, any bid addenda, specifications, pricing schedules and any attachments incorporated by reference and accepted by DAS become a part of this Requirements Contract.

This Requirements Contract is effective beginning and ending on the dates noted above unless, prior to the expiration date, the Contract is renewed, terminated or cancelled in accordance with the Contract Terms and Conditions.

This Requirements Contract is available to all State Agencies, State institutions of higher education and properly registered members of the Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, as applicable.

Agencies are eligible to make purchases of the listed supplies and/or services in any amount and at any time as determined by the agency. The State makes no representation or guarantee that agencies will purchase the volume of supplies and/or services as advertised in the Invitation to Bid.

SPECIAL NOTE: State agencies may make purchases under this Requirements Contract up to \$2500.00 using the state of Ohio payment card. Any purchase that exceeds \$2500.00 will be made using the official state of Ohio purchase order (ADM-0523). Any non-state agency, institution of higher education or Cooperative Purchasing member will use forms applicable to their respective agency.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Where applicable, the following Terms and Conditions supersede any Standard Terms and Conditions shown in this Bid.

This Contract shall supersede any existing contracts for refuse services with any state agency in the manner described below.

Any contract in effect as of 08/01/07, may remain in effect until the contract expires, or December 31, 2007, whichever shall come first. At that time the agency shall begin using this Contract. The agency shall notify the awarded Contractor of this Bid that services will be needed. The agency should notify the Contractor(s) of this change at least thirty (30) days prior to taking effect, copying the Office of Procurement Services of any changes.

Each agency shall notify the Office of Procurement Services with a list of their facility(ies) and their locations using this Contract.

CONTRACT RENEWAL: This Contract may be renewed solely at the discretion of DAS for a period of one month. Any further renewals will be for an appropriate period of time. The cumulative time of all renewals may not exceed forty-eight (48) months unless DAS determines that additional renewal is necessary.

SPECIFICATION QUESTIONS: Information regarding submission of questions and clarifications for this Bid is provided on page one (1) of the Bid. Through the indicated inquiry closure date/time, Bidders may visit the Procurement Services website to post Bid related questions at <www.ohio.gov/procure>. Answers to all Bidder questions will be posted on the State Procurement Services website and linked to the Bid Number. The State will make every effort to respond to website inquiries within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt. The State will not respond to any verbal or written questions received through any other medium. No prospective Bidder shall respond to any verbal instructions or changes to this Bid. Only communications issued by the Department of Administrative Services, Office of Procurement Services, in the form of an addendum, will be considered valid.

MANDATORY/REQUIRED SUBMISSIONS: As specified, mandatory submissions must be submitted with the Bid response. Required documentation/materials should be submitted with the Bid. If not submitted with the Bid, the Bidder must provide the said documentation/materials within five (5) business days, after notification, to the Office of Procurement Services. Failure to provide mandatory submissions with the Bid response or failure to provide the required documentation/materials, as applicable, within the stated time period may result in the Bidder being deemed as not responsive.

For specific submission requirements, Bidders should refer to the Bid Submission Check List for a listing of those mandatory submissions due with the Bid response and those other submissions that should be submitted with the Bid response, but which do not become mandatory until requested during the Bid evaluation period.

SPECIAL CHARGES: There shall be no assessment, surcharges, small order charge, broken case charge, minimum order charge, single item charge nor any other unspecified additional charge allowed by the State that is not specifically mentioned in this Bid or in any contract award pursuant to this Bid. The Contractor must provide merchandise/service in unit quantity(ies) as indicated in the Bid/Bid response/contract.

TIMELINESS OF DELIVERY: All orders will be placed with the expectation of delivery within thirty (30) days After Receipt of Order (ARO) acknowledgement by the Contractor. The Contractor shall acknowledge the purchase order and verify the anticipated delivery date. If, for any reason, the verified delivery date differs from the date on the purchase order, the Contractor must notify the issuing agency and receive their agreement to the date change in writing. Merchandise delivery that exceeds the agreed upon delivery date may be subject to recovery of damages. Under these damage recovery provisions, the agency may: (1) elect to procure any portion of the original order from another source; (2) charge the Contractor for any difference in cost for the merchandise procured; and (3) cancel any portion of the original order without contract penalty. Also reference Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions, Article S-9, Time of Delivery, and the Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Section II, Contract Remedies.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

COOPERATIVE PURCHASING CONTRACT. This Contract may be relied upon by Ohio institutions of higher education and Ohio political subdivisions. Ohio political subdivisions include any county, township, municipal corporation, school district, conservancy district, township park district, park district created under Chapter 1545 of the Revised Code, regional transit authority, regional airport authority, regional water and sewer district, port authority or any other political subdivision as described in the Ohio Revised Code. To qualify to use this Contract the political subdivision must be currently enrolled in the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program. Purchases made from this Contract by a political subdivision that is not properly registered with the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program will be a violation of law and may be contrary to the political subdivision's competitive Bidding requirements. If a political subdivision or institution of higher education relies upon this Contract to issue a purchase order or other ordering document, the political subdivision or institution of higher education "steps into the shoes" of the State under this Contract. The political division's or institution of higher education's order and this Contract are between the Contractor and the political subdivision or institution of higher education. The Contractor must look solely to the political subdivision or institution of higher education for performance, including payment. The Contractor agrees to hold the state of Ohio harmless with regard to political subdivisions and institution of higher education's orders and political subdivision's and institution of higher education's performance. DAS may cancel this Contract and may seek remedies if the Contractor fails to honor its obligations under an order from a political subdivision or institution of higher education.

MULTIPLE AWARD CONTRACT: The Purchasing portion of this Bid found on Price Schedule C are issued to establish a Multiple Award Contract (MAC). A MAC is a contract made with more than one supplier of the same or similar types of supplies or services at varying prices for delivery within the same geographic area. The state's obligations under a MAC are subject to the Ohio Controlling Board's continuing authorization to use the MAC program authorizing the use of Multiple Award Contracts. By the signature affixed to Page 1, of this Bid, the Bidder certifies that it is currently in compliance and will continue to adhere to the requirements of the Ohio Ethics Law, Ohio Revised Code Section 102.04. The Bidder affirms that, as applicable to the Bidder, no party listed in Ohio Revised Code Section 3517.13 (I) or (J) or spouse of such party has made, as an individual, within the two previous calendar years, one or more contributions totaling in excess of \$1,000.00 to the Governor or to his campaign committees.

CONTRACTOR QUARTERLY SALES/SERVICE REPORT: The Contractor must provide invoices of prior three months, including at minimum, name and location of agency, date of service, container size, number of tons and rate per ton if applicable, amount of service per item, total invoice amount. The Contractor must also report the quarterly dollar value (in U.S. dollars and rounded to the nearest whole dollar) of the sales, to include both state agencies and political subdivisions, under this Contract by calendar quarter (i.e. January-March, April-June, July-September and October-December). The dollar value of the sale/service is the price paid by the Contract user for the products and/or services listed on the purchase order or other encumbering document, as recorded by the Contractor.

The Contractor shall be required to report the quarterly dollar value of sales/services to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) on a form prescribed by DAS. If no sales/services occur, the Contractor must show zero. The report must be submitted thirty (30) days following the completion of the reporting period.

The Contractor shall also submit a close-out report within one hundred and twenty (120) days after the expiration of this Contract. The Contract expires upon the physical completion of the last outstanding task or delivery order of the Contract. The close-out report must cover all sales/services not shown in the final quarterly report and reconcile all errors and credits. If the Contractor reported all contract sales/services and reconciled all errors and credits on the final quarterly report, then the Contractor should show zero "0" sales/services in the close-out report.

The Contractor must forward the Quarterly Sales/Services Report to the following address:

If the Contractor fails to submit sales/services reports, falsifies reports or fails to submit sales/services reports in a timely manner, DAS may terminate or cancel this Contract.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Services will be performed as set forth in the Contract and in accordance with Articles S-8, S-9 and S-10 of the Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions. The location of performance will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Payment for services rendered will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the services provided conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, payment shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

SITE VISIT: Prior to submitting their Bid response, the Bidder should visit the agency(ies) they are Bidding in order to survey the facility(s) and to become familiar with the requirements of the Bid. The Bidder must contact each facility to schedule an appointment. Once a contract is awarded, failure of the Bidder to have requested a site visit to become familiar with the facility and requirements of the Bid will be insufficient reason to support any request to be released from the contract.

A listing of state agencies and cooperative members is available in Exhibit B of this Bid. This list includes any agency or cooperative member that has previously requested to be added to our contact list. It is not inclusive of every agency and/or cooperative member. The Bidder may contact the Procurement Contacts listed at <http://procure.ohio.gov/proc/viewContacts.asp> "Additional Procurement Contacts" to obtain a listing of all locations within their agency.

CONTRACT AWARD FOR PRICE SCHEDULE A: The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder by low lot total per county for all Rental and Hauling services in this Bid. Failure to Bid all items on Schedule A may result in the Bidder being deemed not responsive.

The Cost Allocation included on the Price Schedule must be completed with the Bid. Failure to complete this page will deem the Bidder as not responsive and no further consideration will be given to the Bid.

Bidders must specify their preference of Price Schedule A and/or B over Price Schedule D on the Price Schedule. Failure to indicate their preference may deem the Bidder as not responsive and no further consideration given to the Bid.

CONTRACT AWARD FOR PRICE SCHEDULE B: This is for the Ohio Expositions Center only. The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder by low lot total. Failure to Bid all items on Schedule B may result in the Bidder being deemed not responsive.

The Cost Allocation included on the Price Schedule must be completed with the Bid. Failure to complete this page will deem the Bidder as not responsive and no further consideration will be given to the Bid.

Bidders must specify their preference of Price Schedule A and/or B over Price Schedule D on the Price Schedule. Failure to indicate their preference may deem the Bidder as not responsive and no further consideration given to the Bid.

CONTRACT AWARD FOR PRICE SCHEDULE C: Each Bidder shall provide a catalog or list of prices for the option of purchasing any of the equipment. The catalog or list must consist of at a minimum all of the containers listed on the Price Schedule A of this Bid. An award will be made to the five (5) lowest responsive and responsible Bidders.

CONTRACT AWARD FOR PRICE SCHEDULE D: The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder per county for the Needs Analysis Cost Per Hour. The hours are calculated from the time on site at the facility to departure of the facility. Travel time is not included in this calculation. Only one county per Price Schedule page submitted.

Bidders must specify their preference of Price Schedule A and/or B over Price Schedule D on the Price Schedule. Failure to indicate their preference may deem the Bidder as not responsive and no further consideration given to the Bid. Bidders must submit one Bidder's Preference for each county bid.

EVALUATION FOR PRICE SCHEDULE A: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". For Bid purposes only, the number of containers shall be one (1) and the number of pulls/year shall be twelve (12). The number of months/year shall be twelve (12).

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

In addition, the State will use the following calculations to determine low bid total cost by:

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

EVALUATION FOR PRICE SCHEDULE B: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders".

PACKER TRUCK (EXPO CENTER):

(number of vehicles) X (daily cost of service) X (number of days on site) = annual cost per year.

FAIR ONLY RECYCLABLE AND 55 GALLON STEEL REFUSE CONTAINERS:

Tenure of fair (12 days costing) for each type of container = annual cost per year for each type of container.

GENERAL REFUSE CONTAINER(S):

(number of containers) X (number pickups/year) X (cost per container per pickup) + (number of containers) X (monthly rental cost) X (number mos./yr.) = annual cost per specified size container.

COMPACTOR(S):

(number of containers) X (number pickups/year) X (cost per container per pickup) + (number of containers) X (monthly rental cost) X (number mos./yr.) + (per ton landfill disposal cost) X (twelve (12) tons average payload) X (number pickups/year) X (number of containers = annual cost per specified size container.

EVALUATION FOR PRICE SCHEDULE C: An award will be made to the five (5) lowest responsive and responsible Bidders. Each Bidder shall provide a listing or catalog of all equipment available to purchase. The Bidder shall specify on the Price Schedule the discount percentage applied to the published rate for each item.

EVALUATION FOR PRICE SCHEDULE D: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, the State will use the lowest, responsible, and responsive Bid of the Needs Analysis Cost Per Hour per county. A Bidder may not be awarded a county within this Price Schedule and any facilities within the same county for Price Schedule A or Price Schedule B.

Bidders must specify their preference of Price Schedule A and/or B over Price Schedule D on the Price Schedule. Failure to indicate their preference may deem the Bidder as not responsive and no further consideration given to the Bid. Bidders must submit one Bidder's Preference for each county bid.

FIXED-PRICE WITH LANDFILL COST ADJUSTMENT: During the life of an awarded contract, changes may occur in state or local rates assessed to landfills that may affect the landfill dumping rates charged to the Contractor. In such cases, the Contractor, upon thirty (30) days prior written notice, may petition DAS to increase/decrease the contract price(s) by the exact amount of the increase in landfill dumping rates. The Contractor must submit documentary evidence to fully support the claim to DAS prior to making any price adjustment to their contract price(s). If DAS approves the increase, the increase will become effective for the remaining life of the awarded contract. Approval of said increase is subject to the sole discretion of the DAS. No petitions for increase will be considered for landfill dumping fee increases assessed prior to the effective date of the contract.

The Cost Allocation included on the Price Schedule must be completed with the Bid. These figures are used to justify and properly distribute any increases or decreases in price over the life of this Contract. Failure to complete this page may result in no cost adjustments being allowed.

FIXED-PRICE WITH REFUSE CONTAINER COST ADJUSTMENTS: The Contractor agrees to adjust the total monthly pick up charges for any decrease/increase in the number of like size containers to be picked up or for any decrease/increase in frequency of pick ups due to resident program changes and/or building destruction/construction programs for the duration of the contract. Costs associated with the removal or addition of refuse containers shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. If the agency requests installation of additional containers, all costs shall be charged in accordance with the contract. Any additional or new containers added must be the same size and price as one already quoted on the contract. The volume charges will reflect a per unit cost.

INFLATION RATE ADJUSTMENT: During the life of an awarded contract, changes may occur in the overall inflation rate of the national economy that may affect the rates charged to the Contractor. In such cases, the Contractor, upon thirty (30) days prior written notice, may petition DAS to increase the contract price(s) by the exact amount of the increase in the current inflation rate as reported on http://inflationdata.com/Inflation/Inflation_Rate/InflationCalculator.asp.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The contract prices(s) will remain firm for the first twelve (12) months duration of the contract. Thereafter, the Contractor may submit a request to increase their price(s) to be effective thirty (30) calendar days after acceptance by DAS. No price adjustment will be permitted prior to the effective date of the increase on any orders received by the Contractor, or on purchase orders that are already being processed, or on purchase orders that have been filled and are awaiting shipment.

The price increase must be supported by an increase in the National Inflation Index as reported on http://inflationdata.com/Inflation/Inflation_Rate/InflationCalculator.asp. The percentage rate used shall be from the month prior to the request.

No single or aggregate increases shall exceed seven percent (7%) over the term of the Contract, including any and all renewals to this Contract. There shall be no more than two price adjustments within a twelve (12) month period.

MARKET DECREASES: Should a statewide or national decrease any of the costs associated with allowable increases in this Contract, that is greater than 20% of the cost at the time of Contract award or approved increase, the Contractor will advise Procurement Services of said decrease and the Contract will be adjusted accordingly. Said decrease will become effective seven (7) calendar days after notification. Failure of the Contractor to notify Procurement Services of a decrease will be considered as a default and the Contractor will be responsible to reimburse the state for any overpayments. Said increases or decreases will be effective on all orders placed on or after the approval date of the adjustment.

INSURANCE DOCUMENTS: Upon the policy renewal date, the Contractor must submit, within thirty (30) days, updated insurance documents as required by this Contract. The documents must include a current Workers' Compensation Certificate and an Accord Certificate of Liability Insurance and must include all required endorsements as described in the Supplemental Terms and Conditions of this contract.

Failure to maintain compliant insurance coverage per S-13 of the Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions will be considered a default and will be cause for cancellation of the Contract under the Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Section I, Item C, Part 1.

These documents shall be forwarded to the Office of Procurement Services, 4200 Surface Road, Columbus, OH 43228-1395, Attn: Gayle Blankenship.

RENEWAL DOCUMENTS: Upon each extension of this Contract agreed to by the State and the Contractor, the following documents must be submitted within five (5) business days prior to the effective renewal date.

- A. Current Insurance Accord Certificate with all mandatory clauses as described in the Standard Terms and Conditions of this Bid.
- B. Current Workers' Compensation Certificate
- C. Current signed DMA Form (Declaration of Materials Assistance)
- D. Invoices of prior twelve months, including at minimum, name and location of agency, date of service, container size, number of tons and rate per ton if applicable, dollar amount of service per item, total invoice amount.
- E. Signed letter of agreement to extension of term stated at the same Terms and Conditions at the time of renewal. This letter shall also include any updates to the Contractor's contact information.

CONTRACTOR REVENUE SHARE: The Contractor must pay the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) a revenue share of the sales/services transacted under this contract. The Contractor must remit the revenue share in U.S. dollars within thirty (30) days after the end of the quarterly sales/services reporting period. The revenue share equals 0.75% of the total quarterly sales/services reported. Contractors must include the revenue share in their prices. The revenue share is included in the award price(s) and reflected in the total amount charged to ordering agencies which includes both state agencies and political subdivisions using this Contract.

The Contractor must remit any monies due as the result of the close-out report at the time the close-out report is submitted to DAS. The Contractor must pay the revenue share amount due by check. To ensure the payment is credited properly, the Contractor must identify the check as a "Revenue Share" and include the following information with the payment:

If the full amount of the revenue share is not paid within thirty (30) calendar days after the end of the applicable reporting period, the non-payment constitutes a contract debt to the State. The State may either initiate withholding or setting off payments or employ the remedies available under Ohio law for the non-payment of the revenue share.

If the Contractor fails to pay the revenue share in a timely manner, DAS may terminate or cancel this Contract.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: In the event that an awarded Contractor fails to provide services or deliver equipment as specified herein, the agency will contact the Contractor to determine when the services and/or equipment will be provided. If the Contractor cannot fulfill the requirements within a timeline acceptable to the agency, the agency may procure like-kind supplies/services from another resource and invoice the contract provider for the full amount charged by the third party provider. Invoices for said liquidated damages must be deducted from subsequent Contractor invoices prior to payment by the agency.

In the event that an awarded Contractor fails to provide accurate invoicing, or corrected invoicing within a reasonable amount of time determined by the Office of Procurement Services, the Contractor may be in default of this Contract and may be subject to cancellation.

Under these damage recovery provisions, the agency may: (1) elect to procure any portion of the services and/or equipment purchase from another source; (2) charge the Contractor for any difference in cost for the merchandise or service procured; and (3) cancel any portion of the original order without Contractor penalty. Also reference Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions, Article S-9, Time of Delivery, and Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Section II, Contract Remedies.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: It is understood that some agencies may have special needs regarding their services. For example; the Ohio Expositions Center during the Ohio State Fair and other annual shows will require significantly increased service. Ohio Department of Transportation will include all offices, garages, outposts, and rest areas. The awarded Contractor ensures that they can meet the normal needs within the county and any increased needs during peak times.

Due to the special requirements of the Ohio Expositions Center and the volume of refuse during the Ohio State Fair and other events, this location will be awarded separately from District 6. Ohio Expositions Center only will be Bid under Price Schedule B.

SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS
GENERAL

I. SCOPE:*

The Contractor(s) shall provide refuse pickup/disposal services at all state agencies, and properly registered counties, townships, municipal corporations, regional transit authorities, port authorities, school districts, conservancy districts, township park districts, and park districts, pursuant to Section 125.04(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Cooperative Purchasing Act. *Effective 05/30/08, services to Van Wert County will be excluded from this Contract as a result of low usage, until such time as a new Bid is deemed necessary. In that event, the award shall be combined with this Contract.

State universities, state vocational schools, state community colleges or other institutions of higher education may use these contracts. Such use, however, is based upon each entity's procurement authority.

The services may include rental container(s) and ancillary equipment, refuse collection, refuse disposal, and necessary permits and licenses to provide refuse services. Rental will be inclusive of all necessary maintenance and repair to maintain all equipment in a fully functional status. In addition, the Contractor may provide Master Maintenance Agreements (MMA) on purchased equipment to any agency requesting this; outside the scope of this Contract. Any unresolved disputes as a result of an MMA may have an indirect impact upon this Contract, and should be considered while administering the Agreement.

In addition, this contract will offer the option of the agency or cooperative member to purchase any equipment offered on the Price Schedule. These purchases are at the agencies discretion and should be discussed with the awarded Contractor to ensure the service will not be interrupted.

This contract will also offer Consulting Services to allow an agency or cooperative member to seek a Needs Analysis to determine the most cost efficient needs for their facility. This analysis is at the discretion of the agency to obtain information regarding services that would increase their efficiency and potentially reduce costs.

Any agency requesting a waiver from using this Contract will be required to obtain a Needs Analysis to determine or confirm if their needs cannot be done as cost effectively inside the scope of this Contract. The Analysis must be provided/sent/submitted to the Office of Procurement Services along with the waiver request. Failure to provide this documentation may consider the waiver invalid and no consideration may be given to the request.

The objective of this Contract is to reduce the net cost to the State for trash collection and disposal through implementation of "best process" choices that include an integrated system of consultation, equipment procurement, and process improvement.

II. DEFINITIONS AND GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Contractor: The successful Bidder who shall be responsible for providing the specified types and quantities of trash containers and trash removal services as stated in the requirements herein.
- B. Refuse: Shall be defined as accumulated household trash, refuse, and other waste matter including bottles, cans, food and food containers, glass, paper products, cardboard, liquids, and other miscellaneous matter, which may not be included in a recycling contract.
- C. Facility: The locations that will receive the container rental and trash removal services from the Contractor under any contract awarded pursuant to this Bid.
- D. Equipment, Supplies and Manpower: The Contractor shall furnish all equipment, supplies and manpower required to provide the complete refuse services as specified herein. Contractor must be able to pick-up and transport each container at full capacity, within the laws set forth by the Department of Transportation Highway Regulations. Any additional pick-ups as a result of the Contractor not being able to haul legal limits per container shall be at the expense of the Contractor, unless pick-up is requested by an authorized representative of the agency.
- E. Site Clean Up: Contractor shall clean up any spillage, loose bags, or loose trash that may be around the container or may result when emptying the trash container. Contractor is responsible to rake or sweep areas if necessary to remove all debris. Contractor shall carry rakes and brooms on trucks.
- E. Damages: Any damage sustained to the property as a result of the Contractor or his representatives shall be repaired and/or replaced by the Contractor in like kind, at no cost to the State.

SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS
GENERAL

- G. Security: The Contractor and/or designated representatives shall comply with any and all security policies and security procedures at the agency during the performance and delivery of said services.

Trucks and Contractor employees will be subject to search when both entering and/or leaving the institution. The institution may provide a staff employee for escort with the truck to all areas requiring service.

Bidders please note that in the event of fog, escape, lockdown, or any other unforeseeable incident(s), the Contractor may be asked to return at a later time. Additionally, the Contractor may be detained, if an unforeseeable incident occurs while the Contractor is within the facility perimeter. The State is not responsible for any additional charges resulting from such rescheduling or detainment of the Contractor, its representative, or its equipment.

- H. Turn Around Time: Unless the Contractor is replacing an empty unit for a full unit upon pickup; the compactor unit shall be removed, emptied, and reinstalled within a three (3) hour time span on the day of the pickup, unless otherwise designated by the facility.
- I. Holidays: Should any normal pickup and delivery day coincide with a state holiday, then the pickup of trash/refuse shall be accomplished at a time and day mutually agreeable to all parties. The facility shall have the final choice if a mutual agreement cannot be reached.
- J. Inclement Weather Conditions: Should deep snow or other severe weather conditions prevent trash pickup as scheduled, pickup shall be accomplished during the next normal workday.
- K. Consultant: The person(s) or company awarded this Contract to perform Needs Assessment of the agencies as needed or requested by Office of Procurement Services or the requesting agency(ies) or cooperative purchasing (COOP) members.
- L. Secured Facility: Any facility that has a secured area in which only authorized personnel and/or visitors are permitted or additional permissions are needed to enter.
- M. Monitoring Gauge: Each compactor shall have a gauge which monitors the fullness of the container. A description of these gauges can be found in Specifications and Requirements Price Schedule A, Section I.

Compactors and roll-offs shall only be scheduled on an on call basis, or when electronically alerted from a monitor that the unit is in excess of 80% capacity.

The Contractor will supply quarterly invoices which include the number of tons hauled with each pickup. All pickups shall be for compactors and/or roll-offs at or above eighty percent (80%) capacity. If the Contractor consistently demonstrates hauling at less than 80% capacity, the Office of Procurement Services may find the Contractor in default of this contract and take measures necessary to correct, up to and including cancellation of the Contractor from this Contract.

III. BID SUBMITTAL

- A. Mandatory: These items shall be included at the time of the Bid. Failure to provide these items with the Bid or by the Bid Opening date and time as stated on Page 1 of this Bid may deem the Bid as not responsive and no further consideration will be given to the Bid. A list of these Mandatory items can be found on the last page of this Bid.
- B. Required: These items shall be included at the request of Office of Procurement Services. Failure to provide these items within the specified timeframe stated on the last page of this Bid may deem the Bid as not responsive and no further consideration will be given to the Bid. A list of these required items can be found on the last page of this Bid.

IV. REFERENCES:

Bidder must provide with their Bid at least four (4) positive references for jobs of similar scope which may include government agencies and private industries. The reference must provide the name and address of the company, the name and telephone number(s) of the contact person, a brief description of services provided and the length of service for that company. The references must include the annual volume, in tons, the annual dollar amount of the contract, and a list of the equipment rented and/or serviced.

Upon request from Office of Procurement Services, the Bidder will provide additional references if needed. Failure to provide references that are able and available to answer questions pertinent to the Bidder's performance and job satisfaction may deem the Bidder as not responsive and their Bid may be disqualified.

PRICE SCHEDULE A

I. EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS AND MAINTENANCE:

- A. Containers: The State will require access to specific types of compaction containers, and containers configured for general refuse collection. The Contractor is responsible for ensuring that the size containers needed will suit the needs of each facility and provide the most economical and best fit for each area in which the containers are placed.
1. Compaction containers should be constructed with design features according to intended end-use application. Examples of minimal features include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Construction of prime structural steel sheet, plate, channel, and tubing.
 - b. Compactor shall have the ram finish in a forward position to prevent access into the container.
 - c. Compactor shall have a locking doghouse containment enclosure with barn door style steel doors.
 - d. Compactor shall have a payload weight capacity of not less than ten (10) tons.
 - e. Compactor shall have a liquid sump and the container body shall be liquid tight.
 - f. Any liquids that bypass the ram shall be drained back into the container body.
 - g. Compactor area behind ram shall be accessible for cleaning/sanitizing.
 - h. Compactor and roll-offs shall have a waste compactor monitoring system. The system shall alert one or more parties when reaching maximum capacity. The alert is to be sent no less than five (5) business days to desired pick-up. See Item C below in this section for a detailed description of these gauges.
 - i. Compactor controls shall be lockable to prevent unauthorized access and operation.
 2. Front loader and rear loader general refuse containers should be constructed with design features according to intended end-use application. Examples of minimal features include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Construction of prime structural steel sheet, plate, channel, and tubing.
 - b. On appropriate sized containers, caster pads with casters or bump pads as appropriate to installation requirements.
 - c. Grease fittings for all moving parts.
 - d. All general refuse containers will be furnished with a tight fitting lid.
 - e. All general refuse containers will be furnished with casters if so requested by the facility and meets safety standards for that type container.
 - f. All general refuse containers provided for use on State property must have lockable lids if requested and must be closed when leaving the facility.
 3. All containers or compactors brought onto agency grounds will be empty. The agency representative is permitted to inspect all compactors upon arrival and departure from the facility without any advance notice.
 4. Contractor shall provide at no additional cost, any covers, lids, tarps required for any containers as requested by the facility and/or mandated by EPA guidelines, and/or state or local law.
- B. Equipment Maintenance: Contractor shall assume all maintenance costs, travel, parts and labor for rental equipment, to provide preventive maintenance and all necessary repairs to maintain the equipment in a fully operational condition.
1. The Contractor shall clean and spray the refuse containers and surrounding container areas on a regular basis with disinfectant to prevent contamination and odors, which are detrimental to maintaining sanitary conditions. Contractor will be responsible for keeping the containers clean and in good repair. Contractor shall wash, steam clean containers a minimum of once per month during warm weather (May through September) or as requested by the agencies. The balance of the year, containers shall be washed and steam cleaned every two (2) months or as requested by the agencies.
 2. The containers must be painted not less than once a year as a minimum.
 3. Damaged containers/container parts must be repaired/replaced by the Contractor within seven working days, upon agency request.
 4. If the compactor or roll-off container malfunction and are estimated to be out of service for more than eight (8) hours, the Contractor shall provide sufficient front loader general refuse container units to accommodate the waste stream. There shall be no rental charge or pickup charges for these emergency placement units.
 5. If the compactor malfunctions and can not be repaired to a fully functional status within one (1) week after notification by the facility, the Contractor shall replace the compactor, at no cost to the State.

C. Waste Compactor Monitoring System:

1. The system shall electronically monitor the fullness level of the compactor container, using on-site hardware.
2. If deemed necessary by the facility due to no phone lines present in the area of the compactor, the system shall operate on a wireless connection, enabling system to operate without standard telephone lines.
3. The system shall have remote programmable 'Full' call-out level, using hydraulic pressure, exclusively.
4. Compactor information shall be available on an Internet-based compactor monitoring site and shall display status of one or thousands of compactor containers, on the Web. The system shall provide the following:
 - a. Secure, password access to compactor data on any standard Web browser.
 - b. Automatically provide pick-up notification via e-mail, to one or up to 4 Internet address recipients. Pick-up request will be made only when container has reached designated fullness level.
 - c. Interactive capability to change full and empty pick-up pressure settings along with required consecutive pressure readings to determine full and empty status.
 - d. The website provides two (2) updates per day regarding current status of compactor fullness level, hauler pick-up times and dates, list of compactors which need to be emptied and verification of compactors which have been emptied.
 - e. Screen reports which can be sorted by compactor site, region, hauler or account.
 - f. Shall be able to download reports into Windows® programs such as Excel®.
 - g. Analyze how the compactor is operating and report maintenance needs.
 - h. Provide historical data from inception through end of Contract, or a mutually agreeable date.
5. The system shall have these features:
 - a. Digital pressure transducer with snubber (hydraulic surge protector).
 - b. Built-in board level PC.
 - c. Built-in RS232 port.
 - d. Programmable spare inputs and outputs.
 - e. Power filter with surge protection.
 - f. On-board LED status lights.
 - g. Non-volatile memory to prevent any data loss, in case of power failure.
 - h. For disaster and power outages, the system shall have redundancy to guard the primary system from failure.
 - i. Reconnect feature to ensure that call goes through.
 - j. System intelligence to eliminate false 'FULL' readings caused by jams and temporary pressure surges.
 - k. For disaster and power outages, the system shall have redundancy to guard the primary system from failure.
6. The system shall:
 - a. Operate on 120 VAC, 60 HZ, and ½ AMP.
 - b. Operate in temperatures ranging from -40 F to +140 F degrees.
 - c. Be enclosed in a NEMA weatherproof steel enclosure. Hasp for locking.
 - d. The system shall have a safety listing, such as Electrical Testing Laboratories (E.T.L.) or Underwriters Laboratories (U.L.) safety rating.
 - e. Operate with a standard line with a RJ-11 jack, or wireless connection.
7. LED affixed to monitor enclosure which will light to indicate that a 'Full' report has been generated and sent to designated e-mail recipient (s).
8. All maintenance, repair, and/or replacement is the responsibility of the Contractor. The monitoring gauge is considered a part of the compactor unit and will be part of the rental terms of this Contract.

II. CONTAINER RENTAL, ALL TYPES, AND HAULING/DISPOSAL SERVICE:

This is a mandatory use portion of this Contract for all state agencies, excluding Van Wert County which was removed by amendment effective 05/30/08.*

- A. Monthly rental charge will include all costs associated with placement of the equipment on site, preventive maintenance, repair parts, and all labor associated with maintaining the equipment in full operational status. No additional taxes, fees, or charges above the monthly rental charge will be charged to the State for any reason. Invoices shall be provided with landfill disposal weigh slips on a monthly basis. Invoices shall include, but not limited to; landfill trash/waste removal cost, rental fees, and pick-up and delivery costs.
- B. Pick up charges; unless otherwise noted on the Price Schedule, will include pickup, hauling and disposal. No other Contractor charges will be considered.
- C. Frequency of Trash Pickup Schedule: The use of this term in this contract shall be defined to mean a truck and a driver going to pickup locations to remove all accumulated trash and/or refuse per the institution's specifications. Additional pickup/disposal services, requested by each facility, shall be supplied within twenty-four (24) hours after receipt of order or as mutually agreed upon by the institution and the Contractor. In the event of an institutional emergency, the Contractor shall provide equipment/disposal within twenty-four (24) hours of notification.
- D. Disposal of Trash: Contractor shall provide hauling and disposal services for refuse at the facilities to which they are awarded in this Contract. Contractor shall not use any part of the facility for dumping trash.
 - 1. The Contractor will be required to provide landfill disposal for all facility solid waste collected in an approved solid waste sanitary landfill. Contractor collection/transport procedures and landfill operations must be in compliance with all applicable regulations of the Local County Health Department, Local County Solid Waste Management District, and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.
 - 2. The Contractor must provide the name and address of the landfill(s) or transfer station receiving the institution waste. The Contractor must also declare the actual landfill cost per ton charged to the Contractor for the institution waste.
- E. Cost Per Container Per Pull:
 - 1. General refuse containers: shall be defined as the Contractor's total charge for collection and disposal of one (1) container of refuse and/or trash from designated facility.
 - 2. Compactor(s) and Roll-Off container(s): shall be defined as the Contractor's charge to collect and transport one (1) compactor/container round trip from the facility to the landfill site.
- F. Rate Per Ton to the Landfill: Applies only to compactor and roll-off containers transported to the landfill for disposal of accumulated refuse. Rate per ton is the charge per ton transported to the landfill. Per ton charges are assessed according to the landfill weight slip tonnage. A copy of the weight slip showing the amount disposed of, date, time, facility's name and driver signature must accompany the invoice. Invoices without landfill receipt documentation will not be honored for payment. No other Contractor charges will be considered.
- G. The facility will determine location(s) of containers. Any additional units, required by a facility, shall be furnished at the contract rate. The Contractor, as determined by the facility, will remove any surplus units, within two (2) working days of notification by the facility.
- H. Number of Containers: The facility shall determine their individual needs as to number, type, and placement of containers. Once determined, Contractor shall supply the number of containers needed. Contractor shall be able to supply additional containers and trash pick up service should the volume of trash increase. Contractor shall remove at the request of the State any unnecessary containers should the volume of trash decrease. Any additional containers supplied shall be at the Bid quoted price. Additional rental containers, requested by the facilities, shall be supplied and/or removed within two (2) working days after receipt of order. The facility reserves the right to make the final determination as to what size or type of containers are utilized provided they are a standard size and/or listed on the Price Schedule A.

*Services to Van Wert County were removed by amendment effective 05/30/08.

- I. Emergency Service: In the event that the compactor is reported by the agency to the Contractor, as non-functional, the Contractor shall respond within a twenty-four (24) hour time frame. The agency shall contact the Contractor of such condition and the Contractor is required to either service the compactor and make operational, or replace the compactor within this time frame.

In the event, equipment owned by the State is out of service for repairs, the facility may request the awarded Contractor for Price Schedule A in their county to provide temporary equipment rental at the contracted prices. Should the Contractor be unable to provide this equipment, and has documented that decision to the office of Procurement Services, the facility may use their direct procurement authority to obtain these rentals.

This is a temporary provision only and any time exceeding sixty (60) days shall be approved by a waiver from the Office of procurement Services.

- J. Time(s) of Service: The Contractor shall adhere to the time frames as specified by the facility. Due to security measures at some of the institutions, these timeframes may be predetermined and cannot be altered by the Contractor without approval of the facility. In some instances, the times cannot be altered, and the Contractor agrees to accommodate these facilities.

Any change or deviation to designated times is at the discretion of the facility and no additional charge may be assessed to the State.

There may be instances in which the Contractor will be detained in a secured facility in excess of the normal allotted time for secured areas. In the event that this should occur and the Contractor must remain at the facility greater than one hour after performing their services, and is idle; the Contractor may charge an additional fee of \$10.00 per quarter hour for each delay. This time must be acknowledged and documented by the facility manager prior to leaving the facility. A copy of this signed acknowledgement must be included with the invoice for payment to be remitted. Failure on the Contractor's part to obtain this signed statement may relieve the State of any obligation to pay this additional fee.

- K. Any vehicles parked inside a secured perimeter will have their keys removed from the ignition and steering wheel secured with anti-theft device. Pickup inside a perimeter security fence will be permitted only in the following manner:
1. Contractor shall limit the time spent within the perimeter fence to the minimum amount of time required to either pickup or switch out the containers.
 2. Once inmate count begins, the Contractor will be released to leave only when the inmate count is completed and all inmates are accounted for. It is anticipated that inmate count will typically require thirty (30) minutes or less.
 3. Trucks and Contractor's employees will be subject to search when both entering and/or leaving the institution. The institution may provide a staff employee for escort with the truck to all areas requiring service. Bidders please note that in the event of fog, escape, or any other unforeseeable incident(s), the Contractor may be asked to return at a later time. Additionally, the Contractor may be detained, if an unforeseeable incident occurs while the Contractor is within the facility perimeter. The State is not responsible for any additional charges resulting from such rescheduling or detention of the Contractor, its representative, or its equipment.

SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS
PRICE SCHEDULE B

These requirements are in addition to any other items listed in any part of this Bid, Exhibits or attachments. The Bidder shall provide a Bid for this site only on Price Schedule B of this Bid.

This is mandatory use for Ohio Expositions Center (OEC). These services for the OEC, under the scope of this Contract, shall be effective November 01, 2007 through June 30, 2010 and any renewals thereafter.

Ohio Expositions Center:

- A. Contractor must be able to provide service seven (7) days per week if required for day-to-day and Emergency Service. Contractor is to include a phone number and names of contact persons to the Maintenance Office of the OEC. Any permanent change in the frequency of pick-up not approved by Office of Procurement Services with an amendment to the contract could result in the contract being cancelled.
- B. Shall be suitable for containing the previously defined trash. All containers shall have a tight fitting lid and be fire and varmint proof. Container must be constructed so that an average size person can reach the opening(s) to deposit trash.
- C. Service And Hauling - Servicing (emptying) of all units shall be performed only when ordered by an authorized representative of the OEC. When service is required the Contractor will normally be called 12-24 hours in advance of the required service. However if emergency service should be necessary, the Contractor must be able to respond in four (4) hours or less. In that time the units must be picked up, emptied, replaced and back in operation. The response time during major events such as the Quarter Horse Congress, Street Rod events, and similar events using the majority of the facility, must be within three (3) hours or less for removal and return of any containers.

This time period includes weekend service.

- D. Packer Truck Service - Non-Fair Only: (On call basis) When the packer truck is requested it will be to empty any open top units designated by the Maintenance Director. Pricing is to include: vehicle, personnel, mileage, tipping at landfill and all other costs not mentioned herein.
- E. Packer Truck Service - Fair Only: Contractor shall provide ~~a minimum of~~ * one (1) packer truck on the grounds at all times during the Fair. The truck is to be in place on the eve of the fair, the twelve (12) days of the fair and for four (4) days after the fair ends. Daily pricing is to include: vehicle, personnel, unlimited number of trips to the landfill, cost per ton transported to the landfill, entry tickets for all personnel and vehicle to the fair grounds and all other costs not mentioned herein.
- F. Entrance to Fair - Ohio State Fair I.D. badges will be required for each employee. The cost for each badge will be \$45.00. I.D. photos will be taken at the OEC after June 10 each year.
