This Requirements Contract is available to all State Agencies, State institutions of higher education and properly registered members of the Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, as applicable.

Agencies are eligible to make purchases of the listed supplies and/or services in any amount and at any time as determined by the agency. The State makes no representation or guarantee that agencies will purchase the volume of supplies and/or services as advertised in the Invitation to Bid.

SPECIAL NOTE: State agencies may make purchases under this Requirements Contract up to \$2500.00 using the state of Ohio payment card. Any purchase that exceeds \$2500.00 will be made using the official state of Ohio purchase order (ADM-0523). Any non-state agency, institution of higher education or Cooperative Purchasing member will use forms applicable to their respective agency.

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SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following Amendments to the Contract Terms and Conditions do hereby become a part hereof. In the event that an amendment conflicts with the Contract Terms and Conditions, the Amendment will prevail.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS: The Director, Department of Administrative Services reserves the right to bid, under a separate bid, large or unusual requirements, for items that may be a part of the awarded contract.

SPECIFICATION QUESTIONS: Information regarding submission of questions and clarifications for this bid is provided on page one (1) of the bid. Through the indicated inquiry closure date, bidders may visit the State Purchasing website to post bid related questions at <www.ohio.gov/procure>. Answers to all bidder questions will be posted on the State Purchasing website and linked to the bid number. The State will make every effort to respond to website inquires within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt. The State will not respond to any verbal or written questions received through any other medium. No prospective bidder shall respond to any verbal instructions or changes to this bid. Only bid communications, issued by the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, in a public, published format, will be considered valid.

MANDATORY/REQUIRED SUBMISSIONS: As specified, mandatory submissions must be submitted with the bid response. Required documentation/materials should be submitted with the bid. If not submitted with the bid, the bidder must provide the said documentation/materials within five (5) business days, after notification, to the Office of State Purchasing. Failure to provide mandatory submissions with the bid response or failure to provide the required documentation/materials, as applicable, within the stated time period will result in the bidder being deemed as not responsive and the bid response will be immediately disqualified with no further consideration given for potential awarding of the contract.

For specific submission requirements, bidders should refer to Specifications and Requirements and the Bid Submission Check List for a listing of those mandatory submissions due with the bid response and those other submissions that should be submitted with the bid response, but which do not become mandatory until requested during the bid evaluation period.

DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE: The Bidder shall submit descriptive literature of the supplies or services being offered as part of their bid submission. The literature will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Any references, that may appear in the descriptive literature, that may alter the terms and conditions and specifications of the bid (i.e. F.O.B. Shipping Point or Prices Subject to Change), will not be part of any contract and will be disregarded by the state of Ohio. Failure of the bidder to furnish descriptive literature as part of their bid response may deem the bidder not responsive.

AUTHORIZED DISTRIBUTOR: All bid submissions must include a letter from the manufacturer, on manufacturer's letterhead, that the bidder is authorized to represent the manufacturer in this bid effort. The letter must guarantee that all requirements of this bid will be supported by the manufacturer to include, at least as a minimum: delivery of product within the specified time frame and compliance with all bid specifications. Failure to submit the letter with the ITB shall deem your bid non responsive.

MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICATIONS: Manufacturer's specification sheets shall be submitted with the bid for each item/manufacturer bid. Specification sheets will be labeled with the name of the manufacturer, the style number, the category bid, and the corresponding NIGP Codes to which the literature applies. Failure of the bidder to furnish item specifications as part of their bid response will deem the bidder not responsive.

FIRE RESISTANCE/RETARDANCY CERTIFICATION: When required, test results and a fire resistant/retardant certificate from an independent test laboratory must be submitted for each manufacturer's item and/or style number bid within a category. The laboratory test results must certify compliance with either the test standards outlined in Title 16 C.F.R. Section 1610 Standard for the Flammability of Clothing Textiles or an equivalent nationally recognized test. Independent laboratory analysis shall be submitted within ten (10) calendar days after notification, stating the results of the flame resistance and toxicity tests. Failure of the bidder to furnish independent test laboratory results and certificates, upon request, will deem the bidder not responsive.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PRODUCT SAMPLES: The bidder(s) may be required to submit samples of the supplies being offered. The samples will be used in the evaluation process to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. If not included as part of their bid response, the bidder will be required to provide the samples within ten (10) calendar days after notification. Failure to provide the samples within the stated time period will result in the bidder being deemed not responsive. After award of the contract, the samples will be used as a basis of comparison with actual product delivered under contract. Any variation between the samples and product being delivered will be considered as an event of default. Any variations between the samples and actual product being delivered that are due to manufacturer changes may be acceptable and shall require prior written approval from DAS.

Specification samples will be labeled with the name of the manufacturer, the style number, the Bid Index Number, the Bid Number, the category bid, and the corresponding line item NIGP Code. The State acknowledges that it may receive bids from multiple distributors bidding the same manufacturer's product. In such situations, specification samples may be submitted by manufacturer(s) on behalf of multiple distributors, provided that such specification samples are accompanied by written documentation, on manufacturer's letterhead, signed by an authorized representative of the manufacturer, listing the named distributor(s) for whom the specification samples are provided. Any bidder not appearing on this listing and/or bidders failing to furnish requested specification samples will result in the bidder being deemed non-responsive.

When submitting samples, the outside of shipping carton is to be clearly marked, "samples", with the bid number and the opening date. All samples must be tagged to clearly indicate the bid number, index number, category alpha/number, and corresponding NIGP Code for which the samples are being submitted. Unmarked samples will not be considered and the bidder will be considered not responsive.

If samples are to be returned you must include a self-addressed return mailing label and sufficient postage for said samples. Failure to comply with the foregoing will result in the samples becoming the property of the state of Ohio. The samples of the successful bidder will be retained until the expiration of this contract.

SIZES AND COLORS: Bidders shall offer all sizes and colors as stated per item within each category. Failure to bid /offer all sizes and colors stated within a category may deem your bid not responsive. If available, additional sizes and/or colors may be offered for procurement on the awarded contract.

ALTERNATE BIDS: Bidders submitting alternate bids must submit a separate, complete pricing schedule clearly marked as an alternate bid. All terms and conditions for alternate bids apply. Any alternate product offered must be equivalent to or better than those required in the Invitation To Bid. Items submitted as alternate bids that are noted in the margins of the pricing schedule are unacceptable. Such alternate bids shall be deemed not responsive.

EXCEPTIONS: Any exceptions to these specifications must be explicitly detailed in the bidder's response. Exceptions will not disqualify a bidder's response, except in cases where specifically noted. It is the intention of the State to fully evaluate all acceptable alternate equal bid responses that meet the overall requirements of these specifications. State personnel will evaluate exceptions to determine whether variances are material enough to represent a violation of the specification intent or would give the bidder a competitive advantage. However, exceptions to the stated levels of performance, reliability, and timeliness would represent such a violation of the intent of these specifications that would necessitate rejection of the bid response.

EVALUATION: Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Article I-17 of the "Instructions to Bidders". In addition, within each of the two (2) bid sections, the State will determine the low lot total price of each category item. The State will multiply the estimated annual usage of each line item of the category item by its corresponding unit price and then add these totals together. This calculation will be made using the unit prices for both above and below the \$300.00 FOB Pre-paid Freight order threshold. These totals will then be added together to determine the lot total for the category item. For any individual line item for which there was no previous usage, the State will multiply by twelve each to determine a line item value. Although there will be separate category item awards made, bidders are eligible to receive awards of multiple category items providing he/she is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder meeting all bid specifications and requirements listed within a category item. Examples of multiple category items are the three possible Section One, Category A awards for: (Item 1) Men's Jeans, (Item 2) Ladies Jeans, and (Item 3) Bib Overalls. Failure to bid all line items, specified size ranges, and/or specified colors within a category may result in the bidder being deemed as not responsive.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Notice to bidders: Bidders may offer additional sizes and colors. Pricing for additional sizes and colors offered will not be part of the bid evaluation; however, such additional items will become part of any resulting contract awarded to the bidder.

Notice to bidders: Line item usage figures given in the bid are from historical contractor sales data and agency usage estimates and may not be indicative of future requirements. Such numbers are estimates only, as actual usage may be more or less than what is indicated herein. The State is not responsible for any discrepancy between estimated annual requirements and actual usage.

- * **CONTRACT AWARD:** The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder by low lot total for each Category Item of product. Failure to bid all line items within a Category Item may result in the bidder being deemed not responsive for that Category Item

BRAND SPECIFIC AND BRAND NAME OR EQUAL SPECIFICATIONS: Bid Section Two, Category B is being bid as brand specific in accordance with the Ohio Administrative Code 123:5-1-10 (I). That signifies that no alternates will be accepted for award. Elsewhere in this bid, brand names may be included as a "brand name or equal specification", in accordance with paragraph I-32 of the INSTRUCTIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BIDDING.

CONTRACT AWARD/BRAND SPECIFIC: The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder by specified manufacturer brand pursuant to OAC 123:5-1-10(I). No other brands of products will be acceptable.

SUBCONTRACTING: The awarded contractor shall be solely responsible for the contract. Subcontracting by the contractor shall not be permitted unless approved by the State. On a per project basis, the contractor shall clearly identify which requirements are subcontracted and identify the subcontracting company, corporation, etc. and responsible business contacts therein. No contractor shall engage a subcontractor for work without the prior written approval of the State and/or the agency or public entity which issued the purchase order.

INCURRED COSTS: The State is not liable for any costs incurred by the bidder prior to issuance of a contract.

PLACEMENT OF ORDERS: Purchase orders for any item(s) listed in a contract awarded pursuant to this bid will be placed directly with the successful contractor(s) by the using agency and/or COOP entity. No order shall specify delivery to exceed thirty (30) days beyond the expiration and/or cancellation date of the contract.

TRANSPORTATION CHARGES: All transportation costs shall be the responsibility of the awarded contractor.

MINIMUM ORDER: No order shall be placed against a contract awarded pursuant to this bid for less than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars. The minimum dollar value of any order placed against a contract awarded pursuant to this bid for delivery F.O.B. destination, transportation charges prepaid, at any one time to one destination, shall not be less than three hundred (\$300.00) dollars.

ON ORDERS TOTALING LESS THAN THREE HUNDRED (\$300.00) DOLLARS: Shipment is to be made by freight, parcel post, express or commercial package delivery; whichever is the most economical method for proper delivery of the item F.O.B. destination. The cost of transportation from the contractor's address to the destination on such orders shall be prepaid and added to the invoice. Also reference Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions, Article S-10, Minimum Orders – Transportation Charges,

SPECIAL CHARGES: There shall be no assessment, surcharge, small order charge, broken case charge, minimum order charge, single item charge nor any other unspecified additional charge allowed by the State that is not specifically mentioned in this bid or in any contract awarded pursuant to this bid. The contractor must provide merchandise/service in unit quantity(s) as indicated in the bid/bid response/contract.

DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE: Supplies will be delivered to the participating agency within thirty (30) days After Receipt of Order (ARO) and, in accordance with paragraphs S-8, S-9, and S-10 of the Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions. The delivery location will be noted on the purchase order issued by the participating agency. Acceptance (transfer of title) will occur upon the inspection and written confirmation by the ordering agency that the supplies delivered conform to the requirements set forth in the Contract. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, acceptance shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TIMELINESS OF DELIVERY: All orders will be placed with the expectation of delivery within thirty (30) days After Receipt of Order (ARO) acknowledgement by the contractor. The contractor shall acknowledge the purchase order and verify the anticipated delivery date. If, for any reason, the verified delivery date differs from the date on the purchase order, the contractor must notify the issuing agency and receive their agreement to the date change in writing. Merchandise delivery that exceeds the agreed upon delivery date may be subject to recovery of liquidated damages.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: In the event that an awarded contractor fails to perform within the timeframe specified by the contract and/or purchase order, the agency will contact the contractor to determine when the purchase order will be fulfilled. If the contractor cannot fulfill the purchase order requirements within a timeline acceptable to the agency, the agency may: (1) elect to procure any portion of the original order from another source; (2) charge the contractor for any difference in cost for the merchandise procured; and (3) cancel any portion of the original order without penalty from the contractor. Agency invoices for said liquidated damages must be deducted from subsequent contractor invoices prior to payment by the agency. Also reference Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions, Article S-9, Time of Delivery, and Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Section II, Contract Remedies.

FIXED-PRICE WITH ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT: The contract prices(s) will remain firm for the first six (6) months duration of the contract. Thereafter, the Contractor may submit a request to increase their price(s) to be effective thirty (30) calendar days after acceptance by DAS. No price adjustment will be permitted prior to the effective date of the increase received by the Contractor from his suppliers, or on purchase orders that are already being processed, or on purchase orders that have been filled and are awaiting shipment. If the Contractor receives orders requiring quarterly delivery, the increase will apply to all deliveries made after the effective date of the price increase.

The price increase must be supported by a general price increase in the cost of the finished supplies, due to increases in the cost of raw materials, labor, freight, Workers' Compensation and/or Unemployment Insurance, etc. Detailed documentation, to include a comparison list of the contract items and proposed price increases, must be submitted to support the requested increase. Supportive documentation should include, but is not limited to: copies of the old and the current price lists or similar documents which indicate the original base cost of the product to the Contractor and the corresponding increase, and/or copies of correspondence sent by the Contractor's supplier on the supplier's letterhead, which contain the above price information and explains the source of the increase in such areas as raw materials, freight, fuel or labor, etc.

Should there be a decrease in the cost of the finished product due to a general decline in the market or some other factor, the Contractor is responsible to notify DAS immediately. The price decrease adjustment will be incorporated into the contract and will be effective on all purchase orders issued after the effective date of the decrease. If the price decrease is a temporary decrease, such should be noted on the invoice. In the event that the temporary decrease is revoked, the contract pricing will be returned to the pricing in effect prior to the temporary decrease. For quarterly deliveries, any decrease will be applied to deliveries made after the effective date of the decrease. Failure to comply with this provision will be considered as a default and will be subject to Provision I.C. "Termination / Suspension" and Provision II. of the "Contract Remedies:" of the "Standard Contract Terms and Conditions".

COOPERATIVE PURCHASING CONTRACT: This Contract may be relied upon by Ohio institutions of higher education and Ohio political subdivisions. Ohio political subdivisions include any county, township, municipal corporation, school district, conservancy district, township park district, park district created under Chapter 1545 of the Revised Code, regional transit authority, regional airport authority, regional water and sewer district, port authority or any other political subdivision as described in the Ohio Revised Code. To qualify to use this Contract the political subdivision must be currently enrolled in the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program. Purchases made from this Contract by a political subdivision that is not properly registered with the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program will be a violation of law and may be contrary to the political subdivision's competitive bidding requirements. If a political subdivision or institution of higher education relies upon this Contract to issue a purchase order or other ordering document, the political subdivision or institution of higher education "steps into the shoes" of the State under this Contract. The political division's or institution of higher education's order and this Contract are between the Contractor and the political subdivision or institution of higher education. The Contractor must look solely to the political subdivision or institution of higher education for performance, including payment. The Contractor agrees to hold the State of Ohio harmless with regard to political subdivision's and institution of higher education's orders and political subdivision's and institution of higher education's performance. DAS may cancel this Contract and may seek remedies if the Contractor fails to honor its obligations under an order from a political subdivision or institution of higher education.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

CONTRACTOR QUARTERLY SALES REPORT: The Contractor must report the quarterly dollar value (in U.S. dollars and rounded to the nearest whole dollar) of the sales, to include both state agencies and political subdivisions, under this Contract by calendar quarter (i.e. January-March, April-June, July-September and October-December). The dollar value of the sale is the price paid by the Contract user for the products and/or services listed on the purchase order or other encumbering document, as recorded by the Contractor.

The Contractor shall be required to report the quarterly dollar value of sales to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) on a form prescribed by DAS. If no sales occur, the Contractor must show zero. The report must be submitted thirty (30) days following the completion of the reporting period.

The Contractor shall also submit a close-out report within one hundred and twenty (120) days after the expiration of this Contract. The Contract expires upon the physical completion of the last outstanding task or delivery order of the Contract. The close-out report must cover all sales not shown in the final quarterly report and reconcile all errors and credits. If the Contractor reported all contract sales and reconciled all errors and credits on the final quarterly report, then the Contractor should show zero "0" sales in the close-out report.

If the Contractor fails to submit sales reports, falsifies reports or fails to submit sales reports in a timely manner, DAS may terminate or cancel this Contract.

CONTRACTOR REVENUE SHARE: The Contractor must pay the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) a revenue share of the sales transacted under this contract. The Contractor must remit the revenue share in U.S. dollars within thirty (30) days after the end of the quarterly sales reporting period. The revenue share equals 0.75% of the total quarterly sales reported. Contractors must include the revenue share in their prices. The revenue share is included in the award price(s) and reflected in the total amount charged to ordering agencies which includes both state agencies and political subdivisions using this Contract.

The contractor must remit any monies due as the result of the close-out report at the time the close-out report is submitted to DAS. The Contractor must pay the revenue share amount due by check. To ensure the payment is credited properly, the Contractor must identify the check as a "Revenue Share" and include the following information with the payment:

If the full amount of the revenue share is not paid within thirty (30) calendar days after the end of the applicable reporting period, the non-payment constitutes a contract debt to the State. The State may either initiate withholding or setting off payments or employ the remedies available under Ohio law for the non-payment of the revenue share.

If the Contractor fails to pay the revenue share in a timely manner, DAS may terminate or cancel this Contract.

SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

INSURANCE DOCUMENTS: Upon the policy renewal date, the contractor must submit, within thirty (30) days, updated insurance documents showing compliance with all applicable coverages required by this contract. As required, the documents must include a current Workers' Compensation Certificate and an Acord Certificate of all applicable insurance coverages and must include all required Commercial General Liability endorsements as described in Articles S-12 and S-13 of the Supplemental Terms and Conditions of this contract.

Failure to maintain compliant insurance coverage per Article S-14 of the Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions will be considered a default and will be cause for cancellation of the contract under the Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Section I, Item C, Part 1.

These documents shall be forwarded to the Office of State Purchasing, 4200 Surface Road, Columbus, OH 43228-1395, Attn: Ed Jenkins.

E.D.G.E CERTIFICATION: The Office of State Purchasing has identified those Contractors who were E.D.G.E. certified at the time of award of the Contract. It is possible that a Contractor's certification status may change during the term of the Contract. ***USAGE REPORTS:** Every three (3) months the contractor must submit a report (written or on disk or via email in Excel format) indicating sales generated by this contract. The report shall list usage by customer, by line item, showing the quantities/dollars generated by this contract. SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS
Section One
Institutional Resident and Correctional Facility Inmate Use

I. SCOPE

These specifications for Bid Section One cover the purchase of general clothing for various state agencies, and properly registered cooperative purchasing entities to include dress trousers, sweatshirts, sweatpants, football jerseys, bib overalls, jeans, hooded parkas, windbreakers, lined coats, raincoats, and crew socks. The intended use of these garments is for residents of state mental health institutions and for inmates of adult and juvenile correctional and rehabilitation facilities.

II. CLASSIFICATION

Section One Bid Categories:

Category A. Men's Dress Trousers

Category B. Men's and ladies Jeans, Bib Overalls

Category C. Hooded Sweatshirts, Long & Short Sleeve Crewneck Sweatshirts, Sweatpants, Football Jerseys, Crew Socks

Category D. Lined Coats, Hooded Parkas, Unlined Windbreaker Jackets, Raincoats

III. GENERAL CATEGORY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Instructions on measurements and/or applicable sizing charts must be submitted with the bid.
- B. Bidders must also specify if they are using standard or metric system measurements in their measurement and/or sizing charts.
- C. Each item is to be packaged and marked for the individual or ordering agency as specified.
- D. Where applicable all garments must be designed to withstand institutional laundry.
- E. All items must be stamped or labeled, including care instructions where applicable, indicating size and other information pertinent to labeling laws.
- F. All items must have loose threads removed and be pressed, shaped and properly finished in accordance with industry standards.
- G. All materials must be new, unused and without flaws or defects, which adversely affect appearance, durability or function.
- H. All items found to be defective, improper sizing or not in accordance with specifications, although accepted through oversight or otherwise, must be replaced, repaired or altered at the expense of the vendor, including all transportation costs. Reference Supplemental Contract Terms and Conditions, Article S-18, Return Goods Policy.

- c. All measurements listed within these specifications, can fluctuate slightly but must be within industry standards of +/- 1/4 inches. The following specifications are to set a level of function and quality.
2. Front Design
There are to be two flaps on the upper portion of the fronts. The flaps are to measure 5-3/4" with 2" side points and 2-3/4" center. There is to be a buttonhole designed to accommodate a 24 ligne metal button, and is to be placed at the center point with the sides of the flap stitched down. The flaps are to be self-lined. The two lower pockets are to be single welt construction, measuring 1" by 7". The pocket lining is to be self-material and to be made in a kidney shape, measuring 5" deep from the lower welt.  4. Lining Fabric
The lining fabric is to be 100% nylon taffeta bright, semi-bright or semi-dull, plain weave with 70 denier warp and filling. Warp count to be 104 with fill count of 86+/-2. Weight is to be 1-3/4 ounces/sq. yard. Color fastness and crocking to be good. Color is black.
 5. Interlining
The interlining is to be non-woven heavy-duty Lantuck, color gray. Firm hand.
 6. Collar

8. Telescopic sleeves
An armhole gusset is to be formed on each side and the gusset is to open all around the armhole except at the shoulder seam. Two self-material pieces are joined to the front and sleeve and two self-material pieces are joined to the back and the remaining portion of the sleeve. The top pieces are sewn at their inner circular edges to the body and the under pieces are sewn at their inner circular edges to the top of the sleeve. The top and under pieces are joined to each other at the outer circular edges. The depth of the gusset is to be at least 2". Elastic is used to keep the gussets in place.
9. Sleeves
The sleeves are to be two-piece coat sleeves with the bottom of the sleeve to have leather trim sewn between the cuff and cuff facing. Inside of the sleeve there is to be an opening to allow access to the backside of the Comfortex to permit sealing of the sewing on of the emblems or in the event of a rip in the material. A bar tack is to be on each sleeve 3" from cuff.
10. Side Zippers
There are to be one-way zippers, #5 size, 10 inches long, sewn into each side seam so that the vent can be opened and a weapon, radio or other large piece of equipment can be worn through the vent. 15. Construction
The small parts are to be topstitched with a 5/16" gauge. The lower welts and cuffs have a single stitching. The front edges and bottom are to be topstitched with a 7/16" gauge. All sewing is to be lock stitch, except for buttonholes and tacks.
16. Liner/Jacket
There is to be a 4" facing sewn on the outside of the liner at the front edges and the facing will extend from the bottom of the liner up to the shoulder seam. On each facing there is to be a 2-1/4" wide placket with 7/16" gauge topstitching. On the right side a zipper is to be sewn into the right edge of the placket seam for liner attachment. On the left side a zipper is to be sewn into the left edge of the placket seam for liner attachment.

17. Liner/Jacket Front Closure

On the right placket there is to be a 1" wide piece of hook closure material approximately 7" long. There will also be one side of a one-way zipper sewn under the leading edge of the hook and loop closure. On the left placket underneath there is to be a 1" wide piece of loop closure 7" long, placed to match up with the piece on the right placket. There is to be the other side of the one-way zipper running beside the hook and loop closure. There are to be snaps at the top and bottom of the placket.

18. Liner/Jacket Inside Facing

There is to be a 2-1/2" wide facing on inside edges. Placed onto the facing will be a separately cut zipper facing that will be used when the jacket is used without the thermal liner.

19. Inside Pockets

On both the right and left side of the quilted lining there is to be an inside pocket measuring 7" wide by 8 1/2". Both inside pockets are to have one edge sewn under the edge of the facing and the top openings are to close with hook and loop closure. The top corners of the pockets are to be bar-tacked or back tacked.

20. Liner/Jacket Gussets

There are to be knit gussets on the outer shell and inner lining of the liner/jacket, which join the sleeves to the body. The gussets are to measure 1-3/4".

21. Knit Wristlets

There is to be a nylon knit wristlet on each liner cuff and there is to be 24 ligne snaps at the cuff to hold the liner into the coat.

22. Knit Collar
