STATE TERM SCHEDULE**

THIS CONTRACT is between the STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES ("DAS"), DIVISION OF COMPUTER AND INFORMATION SERVICES, ON BEHALF OF THE STATE OF OHIO ("State"), with offices at 30 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215 and Cisco Systems, Inc. ("Contractor") a California Corporation with its principal place of business at 170 W. Tasman Drive, San Jose, CA 95134-1706.

BACKGROUND

The State recognizes that it is sometimes advantageous to do business with some manufacturers under a State term contract rather than through a competitive bidding or proposal process. In such cases, the State will enter into a contract with the manufacturer provided that the manufacturer offers its goods and ancillary services at the same prices that the manufacturer offers those goods under the State of Mississippi Master Purchase Agreement No. 3000.

The State also recognizes that some manufacturers work primarily through dealers for various reasons, including offering customers better support through dealers that have a local presence in the service area. Because of this, the State may sometimes agree to work directly with a manufacturer's dealers. But, if the Contractor is not the manufacturer of the goods or services under this contract, the Contractor must submit a letter from the manufacturer that assures the State that the Contractor will have sufficient quantities of the offered products for the duration of the Contract and any extensions to meet the State's needs under the Contract and that the Contractor is an authorized dealer in the manufacturer's goods or services. The letter must identify each product or service that the Contractor will supply under this Contract. The letter must also contain an assurance of the availability through the dealer of repair and spare parts for equipment covered by this Contract for five (5) years from the date of purchase. It must also contain an assurance that software maintenance will be available under the terms of this Contract either from the dealer or the manufacturer for six (6) years from the date of acceptance. (This assurance is not necessary for PC and PC-based server software with a permanent license fee of less than \$5,000.00 per copy.) The manufacturer's letter must be signed by an authorized official of the manufacturer and submitted with the executed copies of this Contract.

This State Term Contract (the "Contract") establishes terms and conditions under which a State agency (including any board, instrumentality or other political body) or political subdivision may acquire the Contractor's goods or services at the Contractor's best pricing that Cisco Systems, Inc. offers to the State of Mississippi under Master Purchase Agreement No. 3000 for the same goods and services as further described herein per the discount terms set forth in Section 1 below. But this Contract only permits such; it in no manner obligates any State agency to do so.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

CERTIFICATION OF ACCURACY. The Contractor hereby certifies the following:

- (1) The Contractor agrees that the State of Ohio ("State") is a valued customer and that the competitive price under this Contract will be the same or better than the prices for Cisco Products sold under the State of Mississippi Contract, Contract No. 3000, which provides a thirty percent (30%) discount off Cisco's then-current United States Price List. Contractor will use commercially reasonable efforts to meet with the Department of Administrative Services on a quarterly basis to review pricing of Cisco Products under this contract with the State. The State reserves the right to renegotiate pricing under this Contract, and may cancel Products(s) from this contract by providing 30 days advance written notice to Contractor indicating the products(s) affected by such cancellation. Additionally, Contractor will consider meeting competitive pricing that is presented to Contractor by the State on a case by case basis and reserves the right to offer favorable discounts to the State in accordance with Cisco's then-existing and established technology migration programs.

- (2) If the Contractor has submitted a manufacturer's letter to certify that the Contractor is an authorized dealer for the manufacturer, the Contractor warrants that the information in the letter is accurate and that a duly authorized representative of the manufacturer signed the letter.

The Contractor further represents and warrants that all future pricing information submitted to revise this Contract would also be true, correct, current, accurate, and complete.

ECONOMIC PRICE ADJUSTMENT. The Contractor shall use commercially reasonable efforts to notify the State within thirty (30) calendar days of any general reduction in the price of any product or service covered by this Contract even if the general reduction does not place the price of the product or service below the price available to the State under this Contract. The purpose of this notice of a general reduction in price is to allow the State to assess the value the State believes it is receiving under this Contract in light of the general reduction. If the State believes it is appropriate, the State will ask to renegotiate the price under this Contract of the goods and services affected by the general reduction in price. If the Contractor and the State cannot agree on a renegotiated price, the State will have the right, on notice to the Contractor, to immediately remove the affected products and services from this Contract.

DELIVERABLES. Attached as Exhibit I is the Contractor's price list for the products and services that the Contractor may provide to the State under this Contract. Such price list may be updated from time to time, as is permitted under Cisco's State of Mississippi Master Purchase Agreement No. 3000. For convenience, those goods and services are referred to as "Deliverables" under this Contract. The Contractor may not provide any other goods or services under this Contract without an amendment to this Contract. Also, the Contractor may not charge any other prices for these Deliverables other than the prices on the Exhibit I. If Exhibit I contains or incorporates by reference any terms or conditions other than a description of the scope of license for software, product/service description, and product/service prices, they are excluded from this Contract and are of no effect. The Contractor's price list attached as Exhibit I is identified as the following commercial price list(s).

SALES, USE, EXCISE, AND PROPERTY TAXES. The State is exempt from any sales, use, excise, or property tax. To the extent sales, use, excise, or any similar tax is imposed on the Contractor in connection with a Deliverable; the Contractor will pay such taxes (together with any interest and penalties not disputed with the appropriate taxing authority.)

AUDITS. During the term of this Contract and for three (3) years after termination, on reasonable notice and during customary business hours, the State may audit the Contractor's records and other materials that relate to the Deliverables and to the pricing representations that the Contractor has made to acquire this Contract. This audit right will also apply to the State's duly authorized representatives and any organization providing financial support for any Deliverable.

Unless it is impracticable to do so, all records related to this Contract must be kept in a single location, either at the Contractor's principle place of business or its place of business where this Contract has been substantially performed. If this is not practical, the Contractor will assume the cost of collecting, organizing, and relocating the records, along with any technology needed for accessing the records, to its office nearest Columbus, Ohio whenever the State or anyone else with audit rights requests access to the Contractor's records. The Contractor will do so with all due speed, not to exceed thirty (30) business days.

If any audit reveals any material misrepresentation or overcharges to the State, the State will be entitled to recover damages, subject to the Limitation of Liability clause contained herein, as well as the cost of the audit that will not be subject to the Limitation of Liability clause of this Contract. The Contractor acknowledges that a misrepresentation to obtain this Contract may also be grounds for criminal prosecution.

INSURANCE. The Contractor will provide the following insurance coverage at its own expense throughout the term of this Contract:

- (1) Workers' compensation insurance, as required by Ohio law or the laws of any other state where work under this Contract will be done. The Contractor will also maintain employer's liability insurance with at least a \$1,000,000.00 limit.
- (2) Personal injury, bodily injury, and property damage liability insurance, including automobile coverage, with personal injury and bodily injury of not less than \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit, and property damage of at least \$500,000.00 for any one (1) occurrence.

The Contractor will also furnish a certificate of insurance to the State for the required coverages evidencing insurance from an insurance carrier, or carriers authorized to do business in Ohio. The certificate must be in a form that is reasonably satisfactory to the State as to the contents of the policies and the quality of the insurance carrier(s). The certificate must also provide thirty (30) days notice to the State before cancellation.

TERMINATION. The State may terminate this Contract or any order under this Contract if the Contractor defaults in meeting its obligations and fails to cure its default within the time allowed by this Contract, or if a petition in bankruptcy has been filed by or against the Contractor. The State may also terminate this Contract or any order if the Contractor violates any law or regulation while performing under this Contract, or it appears to the State that the Contractor's performance is substantially endangered through no fault of the State. In such case, the termination will be for cause.

On written notice, the Contractor will have thirty (30) days to cure any breach of its obligations under this Contract, provided the breach is curable. If the Contractor fails to cure the breach within thirty (30) days after written notice or if the breach is not one that is curable, the State will have the right to terminate this Contract or the applicable order(s). The State may also terminate this Contract in the case of breaches that are cured within thirty (30) days but are persistent. "Persistent" in this context means that the State has notified the Contractor in writing of the Contractor's failure to meet any of its obligations three (3) times. After the third such notice, the State may terminate this Contract without a cure period if the Contractor again fails to meet any obligation. The three (3) notices do not have to relate to the same obligation or type of failure. Some provisions of this Contract may provide for a shorter cure period than thirty (30) days or for no cure period at all. Those provisions will prevail over this one. If a particular section does not state what the cure period will be, this provision will govern.

The State may also terminate this Contract or any order under this Contract for its convenience and without cause or if the Ohio General Assembly fails to appropriate funds for any order under this Contract. If a third party is providing funding for a Deliverable, the State may also terminate this Contract or any order should that third party fail to release any funds.

The notice of termination, whether for cause or without cause, will be effective as soon as the Contractor receives it. On receipt of the notice of termination, the Contractor will immediately cease all work on any Deliverables affected by the termination and take all steps necessary to minimize any costs the Contractor will incur related to the affected orders. The Contractor will also immediately prepare a report and deliver it to the State. The report must detail all open orders at the time of termination.

If the State terminates this Contract or any order for cause, it will be entitled to cover for any affected orders by using another contractor on such commercially reasonable terms and conditions as it and such covering contractor may agree. Subject to the Limitation of Liability clause contained herein the Contractor will be liable to the State for all costs related to covering for any affected orders to the extent that such costs exceed the costs that the State would have incurred under this Contract. The Contractor will also be liable, subject to the Limitation of Liability clause contained herein, for any other direct damages resulting from its breach of this Contract or other action leading to termination for cause.

If the termination is for the convenience of the State, the Contractor will be entitled to compensation for any Deliverable that the Contractor has delivered before the termination. Such compensation will be the Contractor's exclusive remedy in the case of termination for convenience and will be available to the Contractor only once the Contractor has submitted a proper invoice for such, with the invoice reflecting the amount determined by the State to be owing to the Contractor.

The State will have the option of suspending rather than terminating this Contract where the State believes that doing so would better serve its interest.

In the case of a suspension for the State's convenience, the amount of compensation due to the Contractor for work performed before the suspension will be determined in the same manner as provided in this section for termination for the State's convenience or the Contractor may be entitled to compensation for work performed before the suspension, less any damage to the State resulting from the Contractor's breach of this Contract or other fault.

The notice of suspension, whether with or without cause will be effective immediately on the Contractor's receipt of the notice. The Contractor will immediately prepare a report and deliver it to the State as is required in the case of termination.

EXCUSABLE DELAY. Neither party will be liable for any delay in its performance that arises from causes beyond its control and without its negligence or fault. The delayed party will notify the other promptly of any material delay in performance and will specify in writing the proposed revised performance date as soon as practicable. In the event any such excusable delay, the date of performance or of delivery will be extended for a period equal to the time lost by reason of the excusable delay. The delayed party must also describe the cause of the delay and what steps it is taking to remove the cause. The delayed party may not rely on a claim of excusable delay to avoid liability for a delay if the delayed party has not taken commercially reasonable steps to mitigate or avoid the delay.

INDEPENDENT STATUS OF THE CONTRACTOR. The parties will be acting as independent contractors. The partners, employees, officers, and agents of one party will act only in the capacity of representatives of that party and not as employees, officers, or agents of the other party and will not be deemed for any purpose to be such. Each party assumes full responsibility for the actions of its employees, officers, and agents, and agents while performing under this Contract and will be solely responsible for paying its people. Each party will also be alone responsible for withholding and paying income taxes and social security, workers' compensation, disability benefits and the like for its people. Neither party will commit, nor be authorized to commit, the other party in any manner.

SPECIFIC CHANGES. The State and the Contractor agree to the following additions, deletions, and modifications to the specific provisions of the Contractors State of Mississippi Master Purchase Agreement No. 3000.

The Contractor will not sell to the State any notebook computers with less than a 1.2 GHz internal clock - speed. And the Contractor will not sell to the State any PCs or servers using CPUs with less than a 1.6 GHz internal clock speed. All such items listed in the Contractor's Price List are deleted for purposes of this contract.

The Contractor will not sell to the State any term software licenses. All such items listed in the Contractor's Price List are deleted for purposes of this contract.

The Contractor will not sell to the State any third party software. All such software listed in the Contractor's Price List are deleted for purposes of this contract.

The Contractor will not offer to the State any product's that are not year 2000 compliant. All such items listed in the Contractor's Price List are deleted for purposes of this contract.

The parties agree that Contractors offering documentation that references the State of Mississippi Contract, No. 3000, as "The Master Agreement", for purposes of this Agreement between the State of Ohio and the Contractor, shall be modified to read "State Term Schedule Agreement".

The following amendments to the terms and conditions of Cisco Systems, Inc. State of Mississippi Master Purchase Agreement No. 3000 are hereby incorporated into this agreement between the Contractor and the State of Ohio.

Modify Article (3) page 2 Included Parties by replacing the wording "Cisco, either directly or through its Resellers, will accept orders from and furnish the Cisco routers and equipment (hereinafter referred to as "Products") under this Master Agreement to any governmental agency or institution within Mississippi, based on Cisco's then-current United States price list at no greater than the thirty percent (30%) discount specified in Cisco's Proposal submitted in response to RFP No. 3000." with

"Cisco, either directly or through its Resellers, will accept orders from and furnish the Cisco routers and equipment (hereinafter referred to as "Products") under this State Term Schedule Agreement to any governmental agency or institution within Ohio based on Cisco's then-current State Term Schedule price list at no greater than the thirty percent (30%) discount specified in Cisco's Proposal submitted in response to the State of Mississippi Master Purchase Agreement No. 3000."

Modify Article (6)(6.2) page 2 Orders and Pricing by replacing the wording "When a governmental agency or institution decides to procure any Products from Cisco, the agency/institution, after following applicable state procurement rules and regulations, may issue a purchase order to Cisco or the Cisco Reseller. The purchase order shall reference the contract/RFP number of this Master Agreement and shall set forth the Products to be procured; the prices for same; the specific details of the transaction, and any additional instructions. All purchase orders shall be governed by, and incorporate by reference, the terms and conditions of this Master Agreement. The terms and conditions of this Master Agreement shall supersede any conflicting terms and conditions set forth in any purchase order provided by Cisco or a Cisco Reseller. The parties that the governmental agency or institution has the right to adjust the quantities of purchases based upon the availability of funding or as determined necessary by the governmental agency or institution." with

"When a governmental agency or institution decides to procure any Products from Cisco, the agency/institution, after following applicable state procurement rules and regulations, may issue a purchase order to Cisco or the Cisco Reseller. The purchase order shall reference the State Term Schedule number of this Agreement and shall set forth the Products to be procured; the prices for same; the specific details of the transaction, and any additional instructions. All purchase orders shall be governed by, and incorporate by reference, the terms and conditions of this State Term Schedule Agreement. The terms and conditions of this State Term Schedule Agreement shall supersede any conflicting terms and conditions set forth in any purchase order provided to Cisco or a Cisco Reseller. The parties that the governmental agency or institution has the right to adjust the quantities of purchases based upon the availability of funding or as determined necessary by the governmental agency or institution."

Modify Article (6)(6.4) page 3 Orders and Pricing by replacing the wording "This Master Agreement is not a "state contract" and should not be construed by any party to operate in any manner except as an awarded contract which may be used by ITS staff to satisfy client requests for projects formally submitted to ITS on CP-28 forms, or made available through an alternate ITS approved purchasing mechanism. This Master Agreement may not be referenced by Cisco or any Cisco Reseller as a vehicle to market products or issue quotations in lieu of the procurement process. Further, nothing in this Master Agreement should be taken to infer or to express that this Master Agreement may be substituted or used in lieu of a formal procurement process." with

"This State Term Schedule Agreement is not a "state contract" and should not be construed by any party to operate in any manner except as an awarded contract which may be used by State agencies to satisfy client requests for projects. This State Term Schedule Agreement may not be referenced by Cisco or any Cisco Reseller as a vehicle to market products or issue quotations in lieu of the procurement process. Further, nothing in this State Term Schedule Agreement should be taken to infer or to express that this State Term Schedule Agreement may be substituted or used in lieu of a formal procurement process."

Modify Article (7)(7.1) page 3 Method of Payment by replacing the wording "Once the Products have been accepted by Purchaser as prescribed in Article 8 herein, Cisco or the Cisco Reseller shall submit an invoice for the price of the Product purchased. Purchaser agrees to pay Cisco or the Cisco Reseller supplying the Product in accordance with Mississippi law on "Timely Payments for Purchases by Public Bodies", Section 31-7-301 et seq. of the 1972 Mississippi Code Annotated, as amended, which generally provides for

payment by the State within forty-five (45) days of receipt of the invoice. All payments shall be in United States currency, Cisco understands and agrees that Purchaser is exempt from the payment of taxes. No payment, including final payment, shall be construed as acceptance of defective Products, and Cisco shall remain responsible and liable for full performance in strict compliance with the contract documents specified in Article 39 herein.” with

“Once the Products have been accepted by Purchaser as prescribed in this Method of Payment Section herein, Cisco or the Cisco Reseller shall submit an invoice for the price of the Product purchased. Purchaser agrees to pay Cisco or the Cisco Reseller supplying the Product in accordance with Ohio law, which generally provides for payment by the State within thirty (30) days of receipt of the invoice. All payments shall be in United States currency, Cisco understands and agrees that Purchaser is exempt from the payment of taxes. No payment, including final payment, shall be construed as acceptance of defective Products, and Cisco shall remain responsible and liable.”

Delete Article (7)(7,2) page 3 Method of Payment in its entirety.

Modify Article (10)(10.3) page 4 Warranties by replacing the wording “Cisco represents and warrants that each Product delivered shall be delivered new and not as a “used, substituted, rebuilt, refurbished or reinstalled” Product. The parties agree, however that in the event Cisco is replacing defective Products pursuant to Cisco’s warranty obligations, Cisco reserves the right to provide replacement parts that are either new or refurbished parts equivalent to new in performance, at Cisco’s discretion.” with

“Cisco represents and warrants that each Product delivered shall be delivered new and not as a “used, substituted, rebuilt, refurbished or reinstalled” Product. The parties agree, however that in the event Cisco is replacing defective Products pursuant to Cisco’s warranty obligations, Cisco reserves the right to provide replacement parts that are either new or certified as new. “

Modify Article (10)(10.5) page 4 Warranties by replacing the wording “Cisco represents and warrants that all hardware provided pursuant to this Master Agreement shall, for a period of one (1) year from the date of shipment, be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use. This limited warranty extended only to Purchaser as original purchaser.” with

“Cisco represents and warrants that all hardware provided pursuant to this State Term Schedule Agreement shall, for a period of one (1) year from the date of receipt, be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use. This limited warranty extended only to the State as original purchaser.”

Modify Article (10)(10.6) page 5 Warranties by replacing the wording “Cisco warrants that for a period of one (1) year from the date of shipment from Cisco: (a) the media on which the software is furnished will be free of defects in materials and workmanship under the normal use, and (b) the software substantially conforms to its published specification. Except for the foregoing, the Software is provided AS IS. This limited warranty extends only to the Purchaser as the original licensee. In no event does Cisco warrant that the software is error free or that Purchaser will be able to operate the software without problems interruptions.” with

“Cisco warrants that for a period of one (1) year from the date of receipt from Cisco: (a) the media on which the software is furnished will be free of defects in materials and workmanship under normal use, and (b) the software substantially conforms to its published specification. Except for the foregoing, the Software is provided AS IS. This limited warranty extends only to the Purchaser as the original licensee. In no event does Cisco warrant that the software is error free or that Purchaser will be able to operate the software without problems interruptions.”

Modify Article (10)(10.8) page 5 Warranties by replacing the wording “Purchaser’s remedy under the limited warranties provided in Article 10 will be, at Cisco’s or its service Center’s option, the repair or replacement of the Product. Purchaser must return the Product to Cisco, freight and insurance prepaid, In the event Cisco cannot repair or replace the Product during the warranty period, Cisco shall refund the purchase price of the Product, and Purchaser shall have the right to terminate the purchase order and this Master Agreement in whole or in part, solely as between those two (2) parties. Cisco’s replacement parts used in

hardware repair may be new or equivalent to new. All articles must be returned in accordance with Cisco's then-current Return Material Authorization (RMA) procedure." with

"Purchaser's remedy under the limited warranties provided in Article 10 will be, at Cisco's or its service Center's option, the repair or replacement of the Product. Purchaser must return the Product to Cisco, freight and insurance prepaid by Cisco. In the event Cisco cannot repair or replace the Product during the warranty period, Cisco shall refund the purchase price of the Product, and Purchaser shall have the right to terminate the purchase order and this State Term Schedule Agreement in whole or in part, solely as between those two (2) parties. Cisco's replacement parts used in hardware repair may be new or certified as new. All articles must be returned in accordance with Cisco's then-current State Term Schedule Return Material Authorization (RMA) procedure."

Article (10)(10.10) page 5 Warranties is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- (a) Hardware. Cisco warrants that from the date of delivery by Cisco or Cisco's authorized reseller to Customer, and continuing for a period of the longer of (a) ninety (90) days or (b) the period set forth in the Warranty Card accompanying the Product, the Hardware will be free from defects in materials and workmanship, under normal use. This limited warranty extends only to the original user of the Product. Customer's sole and exclusive remedy and the entire liability of Cisco and its suppliers under this limited warranty will be at Cisco's or its service center's option, shipment of a replacement within the period and according to the replacement process described in the Warranty Card, or a refund of the purchase price, if the Hardware is returned to the party supplying it to Customer, if different than Cisco, freight and insurance to be paid by Cisco. Cisco replacement parts, used in Hardware repair, may be new or equivalent to new. Cisco's obligations hereunder are conditioned upon the returned or affected Products, in accordance with Cisco's then current Return Material Authorization (RMA) procedures.
- (b) Software. Cisco warrants that from the date of delivery by Cisco or Cisco's authorized reseller to Customer and continuing for a period of the longer of (a) ninety (90) days or (b) the period set forth in the Warranty Card accompanying the Product: (a) the media on which the Software is furnished will be free of defects in materials and workmanship, under normal use; and (b) the Software substantially conforms to its published specifications. Except for the foregoing, the Software is provided AS IS. This limited warranty extends only to the Customer who is the original licensee. Customer's sole and exclusive remedy and the entire liability of Cisco and its suppliers under this limited warranty will be, at Cisco or its service center's option, repair, replacement, or refund of the Software if reported (or, upon request, returned) to the party supplying the Software to Customer, if different than Cisco. In no event, does Cisco warrant that the Software is error free or that Customer will be able to operate the Software without problems or interruptions. In addition, due to the continual development of new techniques for intruding upon and attacking networks, Cisco does not warrant that the Software or any equipment, system on which the Software is used will be free of vulnerability to intrusion or attack.

Modify Article (14)(14.2) page 8 Assignment and Subcontracts by replacing the wording "Cisco must obtain the written approval of Purchaser before subcontracting any portion of the purchase order and this Master Agreement. No such approval by Purchaser of any subcontract shall be deemed in any way to provide for the incurrence of any obligation of Purchaser in addition to the total fixed price agreed upon in the purchase order. All subcontracts shall incorporate the terms of the purchase order and this Master Agreement and shall be subject to the terms and conditions of same and to any conditions of approval that Purchaser may deem necessary." with

"Cisco must obtain the written approval of Purchaser before subcontracting any portion of the purchase order and this State Term Schedule Agreement. No such approval by Purchaser of any subcontract shall be deemed in any way to provide for the incurrence of any obligation of Purchaser in addition to the total fixed price agreed upon in the purchase order. All subcontracts shall incorporate the terms of the State Term Schedule and shall be subject to the terms and conditions of same and to any conditions of approval that Purchaser may deem necessary. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the State acknowledges and agrees that Cisco-authorized resellers may be used by Cisco to fulfill purchase orders under this Contract. Any such Cisco-authorized reseller shall be subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein."

37.2.1 **License.** Subject to the terms and conditions of and except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, Cisco and its suppliers grant to Customer a nonexclusive and

nontransferable license to use the specific Cisco program modules, feature set(s) or feature(s) for which Customer has paid the required license fees (the "Software"), in object code form only. In addition, the foregoing license shall also be subject to each of the following limitations as applicable:

- a) Unless otherwise expressly provided in the documentation, Customer shall use the Software solely as embedded in, for execution on, or (where the applicable documentation permits installation on non-Cisco equipment) for communication with Cisco equipment owned or leased by Customer;
- b) Customer's use of the Software shall be limited to use on a single hardware chassis, on a single central processing unit, as applicable, or use on such greater number of chassis or central processing units as Customer may have paid Cisco the required license fee; and
- c) Customer's use of the Software shall also be limited, as applicable and set forth in Customer's purchase order or in Cisco's product catalog or user documentation, to a maximum number of (a) seats (i.e. users with access to the installed Software), (b) concurrent users, sessions, ports, and/or issued and outstanding IP addresses, and/or (c) central processing unit cycles or instructions per second. Customer's use of the Software shall also be limited by any other restrictions set forth in Customer's purchase order or in Cisco's product catalog or user documentation for the Software.

37.2.2 **General Limitations.** Except as otherwise expressly provided under this Agreement Customer shall have no right, and Customer specifically agrees not to:

- (a) transfer, assign or sublicense its license rights to any other person, or use the Software on unauthorized or secondhand Cisco equipment, and any such attempted transfer, assignment or sublicense shall be void;
- (b) make error corrections to or otherwise modify or adapt the Software or create derivative works based upon the Software, or to permit third parties to do the same; or
- (c) decompile, decrypt, reverse engineer, disassemble or otherwise reduce the Software to human-readable form to gain access to trade secrets or confidential information in the Software.

Customer shall observe strict obligations of confidentiality with respect to such information.

The Special License Terms contain certain terms which apply to certain current Special License Software product offerings by Cisco. In the future, Cisco may develop or acquire new Special License Software products which may be governed by other Special License Terms, or Cisco may change its current terms, which will govern future license purchases by Customer. With respect to these new Special License Terms, Cisco may require that Customer acknowledge and accept these new terms prior to purchase by methods chosen by Cisco including by electronic means. Cisco will use commercially reasonable efforts to notify the Customer of any new Special License terms. Customer will have the right to review and accept or reject such new Special License Terms prior to purchase of the applicable product.

37.2.3 **Upgrades and Additional Copies.** For purposes of this Agreement, "Software" shall include (and the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall apply to) any upgrades, updates, bug fixes or modified versions (collectively, "Upgrades") or backup copies of the Software licensed or provided to Customer by Cisco, or an authorized distributor for which

Customer has paid the applicable license fees. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS AGREEMENT: (1) CUSTOMER HAS NO LICENSE OR RIGHT TO USE ANY SUCH ADDITIONAL COPIES OR UPGRADES UNLESS CUSTOMER, AT THE TIME OF ACQUIRING SUCH COPY OR UPGRADE, ALREADY HOLDS A VALID LICENSE TO THE ORIGINAL SOFTWARE AND HAS PAID THE APPLICABLE FEE FOR THE UPGRADE; (2) USE OF UPGRADES IS LIMITED TO CISCO EQUIPMENT FOR WHICH CUSTOMER IS THE ORIGINAL END USER PURCHASER OR LESSEE OR WHO OTHERWISE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE TO USE THE SOFTWARE WHICH IS BEING UPGRADED; AND (3) USE OF ADDITIONAL COPIES IS LIMITED TO BACKUP PURPOSES ONLY.

37.2.4 **Proprietary Notices.** Customer agrees to maintain and reproduce all copyright and other proprietary notices on all copies, in any form, of the Software in the same form and manner that such copyright and other proprietary notices are included on the Software. Except as expressly authorized in this Agreement, Customer shall not make any copies or duplicates or any Software without the prior written permission of Cisco. Customer may make such backup copies of the Software as may be necessary for Customer's lawful use, provided Customer affixes to such copies all copyright, confidentiality, and proprietary notices that appear on the original.

37.2.5 **Protection of Information.** Customer agrees that aspects of the Software and associated documentation, including the specific design and structure of individual programs, constitute trade secrets and/or copyrighted material of Cisco. Customer shall not: disclose, provide, or otherwise make available, such trade secrets or copyrighted material, in any form to any third party, without the prior written consent of Cisco. Customer shall implement reasonable security measures to protect such trade secrets and copyrighted material. Title to Software and documentation shall remain solely with Cisco.

37.2.7 **Term and Termination.** This license is effective until terminated. Customer may terminate this license at any time by destroying all copies of Software including any documentation. Customer's license rights under this license will terminate immediately, upon notice, from Cisco if Customer fails to comply with any provision of this license. Upon termination, Customer must destroy all copies of Software in its possession or control."

Modify Article (38)(38.1) pages 17 and 18 Entire Agreement by replacing the wording "This Master Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes and replaces any and all prior negotiations, understandings and agreements, written or oral, between the parties relating hereto, including all terms of any unsigned or "shrink-wrap" license included in any package, media or electronic version of Cisco-furnished software. The ITS Contract Addendum, the purchase order, RFP No. 3000 and Cisco's Proposal submitted in response to RFP No. 3000 are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Master Agreement." with

"The State Term Schedule and this Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes and replaces any and all prior negotiations, understandings and agreements, written or oral, between the parties relating hereto, including all terms of any unsigned or "shrink-wrap" license included in any package, media or electronic version of Cisco-furnished software."

Delete Article (38)(38.2) page 18 Entire Agreement in its entirety.

Those terms and conditions of the Contractor's State of Mississippi Master Purchase Agreement No. 3000 not specifically referenced by the Amendments delineated under this heading shall remain unchanged.

CONTRACTOR QUARTERLY SALES REPORT. The Contractor must report the quarterly dollar value (in U.S. dollars and rounded to the nearest whole dollar) of the sales under this Contract by calendar quarter (i.e., January-March, April-June, July-September and October-December). The dollar value of the sale is the price paid by the schedule user for the products and services on a schedule contract task or delivery order, as recorded by the Contractor.

The Contractor shall be required to report the quarterly dollar value of sales to the State on a form prescribed by DAS. If no sales occur, the Contractor must show zero. The report must be submitted thirty (30) days following the completion of the reporting period.

The Contractor shall also submit a close - out report within one hundred and twenty (120) days after the expiration of this Contract. The contract expires upon the physical completion of the last, outstanding task or delivery order of the Contract. The close - out report must cover all sales not shown in the final quarterly report and reconcile all errors and credits. If the Contractor reported all contract sales and reconciled all errors and credits on the final quarterly report, then the Contractor should show zero "0" sales in the close - out report.

If the Contractor fails to submit sales reports, falsifies sales reports or fails to submit sales reports in a timely manner the State may terminate or cancel this Contract.

CONTRACTOR REVENUE SHARE. The Contractor must pay the State a revenue share of the sales transacted under this Contract. The Contractor must remit the revenue share in U.S. dollars within thirty (30) days after the end of the quarterly sales reporting period. The revenue share equals .0075 of the total quarterly sales reported. Contractors must include the revenue share in their prices. The revenue share is included in the award price(s) and reflected in the total amount charged to ordering activities.

The Contractor must remit any monies due as the result of the close - out report at the time the close - out report is submitted to DAS.

The Contractor must pay the revenue share amount due by check. To ensure the payment is credited properly, the Contractor must identify the check as a "Revenue Share" and include the following information with the payment:

If the full amount of the revenue share is not paid within thirty (30) calendar days after the end of the applicable reporting period, the non-payment constitutes a contract debt to the State. The State may either initiate withholding or setting off of payments or employ the remedies available under Ohio law for the non-payment of the revenue share.

If the Contractor fails to pay the revenue share in a timely manner the State may terminate or cancel this Contract.

CONTRACTOR'S WARRANTY AGAINST AN UNRESOLVED FINDING FOR RECOVERY. Contractor warrants that it is not subject to an unresolved finding for recovery under ORC 9.24. If the warranty is deemed to be false on the date the parties sign this Contract, this Contract is void *ab initio*.

GENERAL REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES. The Contractor warrants that :

- (1) the recommendations, guidance, and performance of the Contractor under this Contract will be in accordance with the sound professional standards applicable to the work performed at the time of performance and the requirements of this Contract and without any material defect;
- (2) its Products delivered hereunder will not intentionally and willfully infringe on the intellectual property rights of any third party that are registered with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office or U.S. Copyright Office as of the date of this Contract in any manner that will have a material adverse effect on the State's use of the Products or Cisco's ability to perform its obligations under the Contract. Additionally, with respect to the Contractor's activities under this Contract, the Contractor further warrants that:
- (3) All warranties provided in Subsection (4) below are in accordance with Contractors standard business practices attached.
- (4) That the Deliverables hereunder are warranted as follows:
 - (a) Hardware. Cisco warrants that from the date of delivery by Cisco or Cisco's authorized reseller to Customer, and continuing for a period of the longer of (a) ninety (90) days or (b) the period set forth in the Warranty Card accompanying the Product, the Hardware will be free from defects in materials and workmanship, under normal use. This limited warranty extends only to the original user of the Product. Customer's sole and exclusive remedy and the entire liability of Cisco and its suppliers under this limited warranty will be at Cisco's or its service center's option, shipment of a replacement within the period and according to the replacement process described in the Warranty Card, or a refund of the purchase price, if the Hardware is returned to the party supplying it to Customer, if different than Cisco, freight and insurance to be paid by Cisco. Cisco replacement parts, used in Hardware repair, may be new or equivalent to new. Cisco's obligations hereunder are conditioned upon the returned or affected Products, in accordance with Cisco's then current Return Material Authorization (RMA) procedures.
 - (b) Software. Cisco warrants that from the date of delivery by Cisco or Cisco's authorized reseller to Customer and continuing for a period of the longer of (a) ninety (90) days or (b) the period set forth in the Warranty Card accompanying the Product: (a) the media on which the Software is furnished will be free of defects in materials and workmanship, under normal use; and (b) the Software substantially conforms to its published specifications. Except for the foregoing, the Software is provided AS IS. This limited warranty extends only to the Customer who is the original licensee. Customer's sole and exclusive remedy and the entire liability of Cisco and its suppliers under this limited warranty will be, at Cisco or its service center's option, repair, replacement, or refund of the Software if reported (or, upon request, returned) to the party supplying the Software to Customer, if different than Cisco. In no event, does Cisco warrant that the Software is error free or that Customer will be able to operate the Software without problems or interruptions. In addition, due to the continual development of new techniques for intruding upon and attacking networks, Cisco does not warrant that the Software or any equipment, system on which the Software is used will be free of vulnerability to intrusion or attack.

(c) Restrictions. This warranty does not apply if the Product (a) has been altered, except by Cisco, (b) has not been installed, operated, repaired, or maintained in accordance with instructions supplied by Cisco, (c) has been subjected to abnormal physical or electrical stress, misuse, negligence, or accident; or (d) is sold or, in the case of Software, licensed, for beta, evaluation, testing or demonstration purposes for which Cisco does not receive a payment or purchase price or license fee.

(d) In order to meet the State's one (1) year warranty requirement, Contractor will provide its 90-day warranty for Cisco Products and an additional nine (9) months of Cisco SMARTnet Maintenance at no additional cost. The description of SMARTnet Maintenance is provided as Exhibit J to this Contract.

Additionally, with respect to the Contractor's activities under this Contract, the Contractor warrants that:

- (1) The Contractor has the right to enter into this Contract.
- (2) The Contractor has not entered into any other contracts or employment relationships that restrict the Contractor's ability to perform under this Contract.
- (3) The Contractor will observe and abide by all applicable laws and regulations, including those of the State regarding conduct on any premises under the State's control.
- (4) The Contractor has good and marketable title to any goods delivered under this Contract and which title passes to the State. The parties acknowledge and agree that this is not a warranty against the infringement of a third party(s) intellectual property rights.
- (5) The Contractor has the right and ability to grant the license granted in any Deliverable in which title does not pass to the State.

If any work of the Contractor or any Deliverable fails to comply with these warranties, and the Contractor is so notified in writing, the Contractor will correct such failure with all due speed or will refund the amount of the compensation paid for the Deliverable. The Contractor will remain liable to the State for any direct damages that result from a breach of these warranties. The parties agree that all such damages for breach of these warranties shall be limited to the amount set forth in Paragraph 3 of the State Term Schedule Limitation of Liability provision herein, on page 19.

EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED IN THIS WARRANTY SECTION, ALL EXPRESS OR IMPLIED CONDITIONS, REPRESENTATIONS, AND WARRANTIES INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OR CONDITION OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR PARTICULAR PURPOSE, NONINFRINGEMENT, SATISFACTORY QUALITY OR ARISING FROM A COURSE OF DEALING, LAW, USAGE, OR TRADE PRACTICE, ARE HEREBY EXCLUDED TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY APPLICABLE LAW. TO THE EXTENT AN IMPLIED WARRANTY CANNOT BE EXCLUDED, SUCH WARRANTY IS LIMITED IN DURATION TO THE WARRANTY PERIOD. This disclaimer and exclusion shall apply even if the express warranty set forth above fails of essential purpose. The date of shipment of a Product by Cisco is set forth on the packaging material in which the Product is shipped.

INDEMNITY. The Contractor will indemnify the State against all liability or expense resulting from bodily injury to any person (including injury resulting in death) or damage to tangible personal property arising out of the performance of this Contract, providing such bodily injury or tangible personal property damage is due to the negligence of the Contractor, its employees, agents, or subcontractors. The Contractor will also defend the State against any claim of infringement of a United States copyright, patent, trade secret, or similar intellectual property rights existing or issued as of the date of this Contract, with respect to any Cisco Product supplied under this Contract. Cisco will indemnify the State against any final judgment entered in respect of such claim by a court of competent jurisdiction and against any settlement arising out of such claim. This obligation of indemnification will not apply where the State has modified the Deliverable and the claim of infringement, is based on the modification. The state agrees to give the Contractor notice of any such claim as soon as reasonably practicable. The State will grant the Contractor authority to settle or

otherwise defend any intellectual property claim and subsequent appeal upon consultation with the Office of the State Attorney General. The State further agrees to provide the Contractor all information and assistance reasonably requested by the Contractor in connection with the conduct of the defense and settlement of the intellectual property right claim and any subsequent appeal. If a successful claim of infringement is made, or if the Contractor reasonably believes that an infringement claim that is pending may actually succeed, the Contractor will do one, (1) of the following four (4) things:

- (1) Modify the Deliverable so that is no longer infringing.
- (2) Replace the Deliverable with an equivalent or better item.
- (3) Acquire the right for the State to use the infringing Deliverable.
- (4) Remove the Deliverable and refund the fee the State paid for the Deliverable.

Cisco has no duty to indemnify if State modifies a deliverable, and claim is based on its modification. State has no duty to indemnify Cisco.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, Contractor has no liability for any intellectual property rights claim arising from: (a) the combination, operation, or use of a Product supplied under this Contract with any product, device, or software not supplied by Cisco; (b) the amount or duration of use which the State makes of the Product, revenue earned by the State from services it provides which utilize the Product, or services offered by the State to external or internal customers; (c) the alteration or modification of any Product supplied under this Contract; (d) Cisco's compliance with the State's designs, specifications, or instructions; or (e) the State's use of the Product after Cisco has informed the State of modifications or changes in the Product required to avoid such an intellectual property rights claim if the alleged infringement would have been avoided by implementation of Contractor's recommended modifications or changes.

THIS SECTION STATES THE ENTIRE OBLIGATION OF CONTRACTOR AND ITS SUPPLIERS, AND THE EXCLUSIVE REMEDY OF THE STATE, IN RESPECT OF ANY INFRINGEMENT OR ALLEGED INFRINGEMENT OF ANY INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS OR PROPRIETARY RIGHTS. THIS INDEMNITY OBLIGATION AND REMEDY ARE GIVEN TO THE STATE SOLELY FOR ITS BENEFIT AND IN LIEU OF, AND CONTRACTOR DISCLAIMS, ALL WARRANTIES, CONDITIONS AND OTHER TERMS OF NON-INFRINGEMENT WITH RESPECT TO ANY PRODUCT.

ACCEPTANCE. The acceptance procedure for Deliverables will be an informal review by the agency acquiring the Deliverables to ensure that each Deliverable meets the warranties in this Contract. The State will have up to three (3) days after receipt of shipment to do this. The State will not issue a formal letter of acceptance, and passage of three (3) days will imply acceptance, though the State will issue a notice of noncompliance if a Deliverable does not meet the warranties in this Contract. If the State issues a letter of noncompliance, then the Contractor will have thirty (30) calendar days to correct the problems listed in the noncompliance letter. If the Contractor fails to do so, the Contractor will be in default without a cure period. If the State has issued a noncompliance letter, the Deliverable will not be accepted until the State issues a letter of acceptance indicating that each problem noted in the noncompliance letters has been cured. If the problems have been fixed during the thirty (30) day period, the State will issue the acceptance letter within fifteen (15) days after all defects have been fixed.

PASSAGE OF TITLE. Title to any Deliverable will pass to the State only on acceptance of the Deliverable. All risk of loss will remain with the Contractor until title to the Deliverable passes to the State.

SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE. In order to meet the State's one (1) year warranty requirement, Contractor will provide its 90-day warranty for Cisco Products and an additional nine (9) months of Cisco SMARTnet Maintenance at no additional cost. The description of SMARTnet Maintenance is provided as Exhibit J to this Contract.

For Commercial Software other than PC or PC-based server software costing less than \$5,000.00 per copy or license, the Contractor will provide maintenance during the warranty period at no cost to the State. That

maintenance will be the standard maintenance program that the licensor, whether the Contractor or a third party, normally provides to its client base. But, at a minimum, that maintenance program must include all new releases, updates, patches, and fixes to the commercial Software. It will also include a commitment to keep the software current with the operating environment in which it is designed to function and to correct material defects that the State finds in the software in a timely fashion.

Contractor offers support for products commercially available and listed on exhibit I for so long as such products are available and listed. In addition, Contractor's current End of Life Policy (Exhibit K), described, provides the following extended support for products subject to End of Life or End of Sale announcements (provided the customer has a current and fully-paid support contract for Cisco maintenance):

- Access to Cisco's Technical Assistance Center (TAC) will be available 24 hours a day, seven days a week for a period of 5 years from the end-of-sale date for hardware and operating system software issues and for a period of 3 years from the end-of-sale date for application software issues.
- Spares or replacement parts for hardware will be available for a period of 5 years from the end-of-sale date. Contractor will provide spares and replacement parts in accordance with Cisco's Return Materials Authorization (RMA) process.
- Where available, Contractor will provide bug fixes, maintenance releases, work around, or patches for critical bugs reported via the TAC or Cisco.com Web site for a period of 5 years from the end-of-sale date for operating system software and for a period of 3 years from the end-of-sale date for application software. It may be necessary to use a software upgrade release to correct a reported problem.

For Commercial Software designed for PC or PC-based server platforms and costing less than \$5,000.00 per copy or license, the Contractor will provide the maintenance and/or user assistance during the warranty period at no additional cost to the State that the Contractor or the third-party licensor makes generally available at no additional charge to its other customers.

That maintenance will be the standard maintenance program that the licensor, whether the Contractor or a third-party, normally provides to its client base.

EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE. If this Contract involves computer or telecommunications hardware or other mechanical or electrical Equipment (use of the word "Equipment" means all the foregoing) as a Deliverable, then, during the warranty period and during any subsequent period covered by annual maintenance and upon payment of the maintenance fees for subsequent maintenance the Contractor will provide Equipment maintenance to keep the Equipment in or restore the Equipment to good working order. This maintenance will include preventative and remedial maintenance, installation of safety changes, and installation of engineering changes based upon the specific needs of the individual item of Equipment. This maintenance will also include the repair, replacement, or exchange deemed necessary to keep the Equipment in good working order. For purposes of this Contract, Equipment restored to good working condition means Equipment that performs in accordance with the manufacturer's published specifications. The Contractor will exert its best efforts to perform all fault isolation and problem determination attributed to the Equipment covered under this Contract. The following services are outside the scope of this Contract:

- (1) Maintenance to bring the Equipment into compliance with any law, rule, or regulation if such law, rule, or regulation was not in effect on the acceptance date.
- (2) Repair and replacement work or increase in maintenance time as a result of damage or loss resulting from accident, casualty, neglect, misuse, or abuse if such is the State's fault (and beyond normal wear and tear), damage resulting from improper packing or failure to follow prescribed shipping instruction (If such is done by the State), failure of electrical power, air conditioning or humidity control, use of supplies not approved by the original manufacturer of the Equipment as describe or included in the Contractor's proposal, or causes other than ordinary use of Equipment.

- (3) Furnishing platens, supplies, or accessories, making specification changes, or adding, or removing approved accessories, attachments or other devices except as set forth herein.
- (4) Maintenance or increase in maintenance time resulting from any improper use, maintenance, or connection to other equipment (not done by the Contractor) that results in damage to the Equipment.
- (5) Activities required restoring the Equipment to good operating condition if the problem has resulted from someone other than Contractor's authorized service personnel repairing, modifying or performing any maintenance service on the Equipment.

EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE STANDARDS. For Cisco SMARTnet Maintenance, Contractor has established the problem priority definitions as set forth in Appendix A to Exhibit J of the Contract (SMARTnet Services description). These definitions assist Contractor in allocating the appropriate resources to resolve problems. The State assigns a priority to all problems submitted to Contractor. The Cisco Manager to which the problem is escalated will take ownership of the problem and provide the State with updates on its resolution. Cisco's response times are as set forth in Exhibit J and commence upon Cisco's problem diagnosis.

EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE CONTINUITY. This section applies if Equipment will be a Deliverable under this Contract. If the Contractor is unable to provide maintenance services to meet the State's ongoing performance requirements and if, in the State's sole opinion, the Contractor is unlikely to resume providing warranty services that meets the State's ongoing performance requirement, the Contractor will be in default, and the State will be entitled to the remedies in the default section of this Contract. But the State will also be entitled to the following items from the Contractor:

- (1) All reasonable information necessary for the State to perform the maintenance, which is not proprietary or trade secret information of the Contractor, including but not limited to logic diagrams, maintenance manuals and system and unit schematics with all changes noted.
- (2) A listing of suppliers capable of supplying necessary spare parts.
- (3) A listing of spare parts and their recommended replacement schedule that will enable the State to create a centralized inventory of spare parts.

Any information in items (1) through (3) above that the Contractor rightfully identifies as proprietary information will be maintained in confidence by the State except where disclosure to a third-party is necessary for the State to continue the maintenance. However, the State will require any third-party to whom disclosure is made to agree to hold the proprietary information in confidence and to make no further disclosure of it. Further, the State agrees that any such proprietary information will be used solely to perform maintenance for the State and will be returned to the Contractor or destroyed on completion of such use.

PRINCIPAL PERIOD OF MAINTENANCE (GENERAL). This section applies if software or Equipment will be a Deliverable under this Contract. Maintenance will be available nine (9) working hours per weekday, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time. Travel time and expenses related to remedial and preventative maintenance will not be considered billable but will be included in the price of the maintenance.

MAINTENANCE ACCESS (GENERAL). The section applies if any software or Equipment will be a Deliverable under this Contract. The State will provide the Contractor with reasonable access to the Deliverable to perform maintenance. All maintenance that requires the Deliverable to be inoperable must be performed outside the State's customary working hours except when the Deliverable is already inoperable. Preventative or scheduled maintenance will be performed at mutually agreeable times, within the parameters of the manufacturer's published schedule.

DISTRIBUTORS AND DEALERS. The State authorizes the Contractor to name one or more dealers to work with the State on behalf of the Contractor. But if the Contractor decides to use any dealers, the Contractor must submit the name, address, and telephone number of any such dealer, as well as the dealer's purchase order and payment address (es) and Federal tax identification number. The Contractor must also submit a completed W9 form for each dealer it wishes to name under this section. The Contractor's submission must be on its official letterhead, signed by an authorized representative, and addressed to the Deputy Director, Division of Computer and Information Services.

In doing so, the Contractor warrants that:

- (1) The dealer has been given a copy of this Contract, and a duly authorized representative of the dealer has agreed, in writing, to be bound by the terms and conditions in this Contract.
- (2) Such agreement specifically provides that it is for the benefit of the State as well as the Contractor.
- (3) The Contractor agrees to remain liable under this Contract for the services of any dealer to perform and any breach of the dealer under this Contract.
- (4) Payments under this Contract for the services of any dealer may be made directly to that dealer, and the Contractor will look solely to the dealer for any payments due the Contractor once the State has paid the dealer.
- (5) To the extent that there is any liability to the State arising from doing business with a dealer that has not signed the agreement required under this section with the Contractor, the Contractor would indemnify the State for such liability.

If the Contractor wants to designate a dealer that will not receive payments (a "distributor"), the Contractor may do so by identifying the person or organization as a distributor in the authorizing letter. In such cases, information regarding taxpayer identification and payment addressing may be omitted, as may the distributor's W9 form. All other requirements and obligations for designating a dealer apply to designating a distributor.

Limitation of Liability Notwithstanding any limitation provisions contained in the documents and materials incorporated by reference into this Agreement, the parties agree as follow:

1. The limitation in paragraph 3 does not apply to liability arising from third party claims or the sections in this document where the sections expressly provide a right to particular damages such as indemnity.
2. Neither party will be liable for any indirect, incidental or consequential loss of damage of any kind, including but not limited to lost profits, even if the parties have been advised, knew, or should have known of the possibility of such damages.
3. The Contractor further agrees that the Contractor shall remain liable for all direct damages due to the Contractor's fault or negligence up to three (3) times the amount of the corresponding Purchase Order per purchase event, with an aggregate limit of the amount paid to Contractor under this Agreement during the twelve (12) month period preceding the event or circumstances giving rise to such liability, whichever is greater.

PAYMENT DUE DATE. Payments will be due on the thirtieth (30) day after the later of:

- (1) The date the State actually receives a proper invoice at the office designated in the applicable purchase order to receive it; or

- (2) The date the State accepts the products or services. The date the State issues a warrant (the State's equivalent to a check) in payment of an invoice will be considered the date payment is made. Without diminishing the Contractor's right to timely payment, the payment will be overdue only if it is not received by the thirtieth (30th) day after the payment's due date. If the State has not issued payment by then, interest will begin to accrue under Ohio Revised Code ("Code") Section 126.30.

INVOICE REQUIREMENTS. The Contractor must submit an original invoice with three (3) copies to the office designated in the purchase order as the "bill to" address. To be a proper invoice, the invoice include the following information:

- (1) Name and address of the Contractor as designated in this Contract.
- (2) The Contractor's Federal tax identification number as designated in this Contract.
- (3) The Contractor's invoice remittance address as designated in this Contract.
- (4) The purchase order number authorizing the delivery of products or services.
- (5) A description of what the Contractor delivered, including, as applicable, the time period, serial number, unit price, quantity, and total price of the products and services. If the invoice is for a lease, the Contractor must also include the payment number (e.g., 1 of 36). If an authorized dealer has fulfilled the purchase order, then the dealer's information should be supplied in lieu of the Contractor's information. If an invoice does not meet this section's requirements or if the Contractor fails to give proper notice of a price increase (see the next section), the State will send the Contractor written notice. The State will send the notice, along with the improper invoice, to the Contractor's address designated for receipt of purchase orders within fifteen (15) days. The notice will contain a description of the defect or impropriety and any additional information the Contractor needs to correct the invoice. If such notification has been sent, the payment due date will be thirty (30) days after the State receives a proper invoice and has accepted the Contractor's product or service.

NOTIFICATION OF PRICE INCREASES. If this Contract permits any price increases, the Contractor must notify DAS and any affected State customers of the increase at least sixty (60) days before the effective date of the price increase. State customers must be notified at their purchase order "bill to" address contained in the applicable purchase order(s). This notification must specify, when applicable, the product serial number, location, current price, increased price, and applicable purchase order number.

NON-APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS. The State's funds are contingent on the availability of lawful appropriations by the Ohio General Assembly. If the Ohio General Assembly fails to continue funding for the payments due hereunder, this Contract will terminate as of the date that the funding expires, and the State will have no further obligation to make any payments.

CONFIDENTIALITY. The State may disclose to the Contractor written material or oral or other information that the State treats as confidential ("Confidential Information"). Title to the Confidential Information and all related materials and documentation the State delivers to the Contractor will remain with the State. The Contractor agrees to treat such Confidential Information as secret if it is so marked, otherwise identified as such, or when, by its very nature, it deals with matters that, if generally known, would be damaging to the best interests of the public, other contractors or potential contractors with the State, or individuals or organizations about whom the State keeps information during the term of this Contract and for a period of at least three (3) years after its Termination the Contractor agrees not to disclose any Confidential Information to third parties and to use it solely to perform under this Contract.

The State acknowledges that, in connection with this Agreement and its relationship with Contractor, it may obtain information relating to the Products or to Contractor that is of a confidential and proprietary nature ("Confidential Information"). Such Confidential Information may include, but is not limited to, trade secrets, know how, inventions, techniques, processes, programs, schematics, software source documents, data,

financial information, and sales and marketing plans or information which the State knows or has reason to know is confidential, proprietary or trade secret information of Contractor. The State shall at all times, both during the term of this Agreement and for a period of at least three (3) years after its termination, keep in trust and confidence all such Confidential Information, and shall not use such Confidential Information other than as expressly authorized by Contractor under this Agreement, nor shall the State disclose any such Confidential Information to third parties without Contractor's written consent.

The parties' obligation to maintain the confidentiality of the Confidential Information will not apply where such: (1) was already in the possession of the Receiving Party before disclosure by the Disclosing Party, and was received by the Receiving Party without obligation of confidence; (2) is independently developed by the Receiving Party, provided documentary evidence exists to support the independent development; (3) is or becomes publicly available without breach of this Contract; (4) is rightfully received by the Receiving Party from a third party without obligation of confidence; (5) is disclosed by the Receiving Party with the written consent of the Disclosing Party; or (6) is released under a valid order of a court or governmental agency, provided that the Receiving Party (a) notifies the Disclosing Party of the order immediately upon receipt of it and (b) makes a reasonable effort to obtain a protective order from the issuing court or agency limiting disclosure and use of the Confidential Information solely for the purposes intended to be served by the original order of production. The Receiving Party will return all originals of any Confidential Information and destroy any copies it has made for its own internal use on termination or expiration of this Contract or as requested by the Disclosing Party.

The parties agree that the disclosure of the Confidential Information of the Disclosing Party in a manner inconsistent with the terms of this provision may cause the Disclosing Party irreparable damage for which remedies other than injunctive relief may be inadequate, and each Receiving Party agrees that in the event of a breach of the Receiving Party's obligations hereunder, the Disclosing Party shall be entitled to temporary and permanent injunctive relief to enforce the provisions hereof without the necessity of proving actual damages. This provision shall not, however, diminish or alter any right to claim and recover damages.

OBM CERTIFICATION. This Contract is subject to Code Section §126.07. Any orders under this Contract are void until the Director of the Office of Budget and Management certifies that there is a balance in the appropriation available to pay for the order.

TAXES. The State is exempt from all state and local taxes and does not agree to pay any taxes.

CANCELLATION. The State or the Contractor may cancel this Contract without cause and on thirty (30) days written notice. But, in the case of any lease of goods or services or any license of software or other intangible property entered before the effective date of the termination, the State will have the right to continue such lease or license after termination on the terms contained in this Contract.

AUTOMATIC RENEWAL. This Contract expires one (1) year after it has been signed by the State. But this Contract may be automatically renewed for one (1) year upon written notice to Contractor, unless it is terminated according to its terms. Termination under this Section will not relieve the Contractor of its obligations, including any applicable warranty or maintenance obligations, for products or services ordered before the date of termination.

DELIVERIES. All deliveries will be F.O.B. Destination.

EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY. The Contractor will comply with all Ohio laws regarding equal employment opportunity including Ohio Revised Code Section §125.111, and all related Executive Orders of the Governor of Ohio.

DRUG FREE WORKPLACE. The Contractor will comply with all applicable Ohio laws regarding maintaining a drug-free workplace. The Contractor will make a good faith effort to ensure that all its employees, while working on State property, do not possess and will not be under influence of illegal drugs or alcohol or abuse prescription drugs.

OHIO ETHICS AND ELECTIONS LAW. The Contractor certifies that it is currently in compliance and will continue to adhere to the requirements of the Ohio ethics law, Ohio Revised Code Section §102.04. The Contractor affirms that, as applicable to the Contractor, no party listed in Division (I) or (J) of Section §3517.13 of the Ohio Revised Code or spouse of such party has made, as an individual, within the two previous calendar years, one or more contributions totaling in excess of \$1,000.00 to the Governor or to his campaign committees.

PUBLICITY. The Contractor will not advertise that it is doing business with the State or use this Contract as a marketing or sales tool, unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the State.

CONTROLLING BOARD AUTHORIZATION. The State's obligations under this Contract are subject to the Ohio Controlling Board's continuing authorization to use state term contracts. If the Ohio Controlling Board fails to authorize or withdraws its authorization for this program, this Contract will terminate, and the Contractor may not take any more orders under this Contract.

TRAVEL EXPENSES. Any travel or per diem required by the Contractor to do its obligations under this Contract will be at the Contractor's expense. The State will pay for any additional travel that it requests only with prior written approval. All additional travel and per diem that the State requests in addition to what this Contract requires the Contractor to provide at the Contractor's expense will be paid in accordance with the Office of Budget and Management's Travel Rules in Section §126-1-02 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS. This Contract may be relied on by Ohio political subdivisions, including Ohio cities and counties ("Political Subdivisions"). Whenever a Political Subdivision relies on this Contract to issue a purchase order, the Political Subdivision will step into the shoes of the State under this Contract for purposes of its order, and, as to the Political Subdivision's order, this Contract will be between the Contractor and the Political Subdivision. The Contractor will look solely to the Political Subdivision for performance, including but not limited to payment, and will hold the State harmless with regard to such orders and the Political Subdivision's performance. But the State will have the right to terminate this Contract and seek such remedies on termination as this Contract provides should the Contractor fail to honor its obligations under an order from a Political Subdivision. Nothing in this Contract requires the Contractor to accept an order from a Political Subdivision where the Contractor reasonably believes that the Political Subdivision is or will be unable to perform its obligations in relation to that order.

HEADINGS. The headings used in this Contract are for convenience only and will not be used in interpreting this Contract.

ASSIGNMENT. The parties will not assign this Contract without the written consent of the other party which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

ENTIRE DOCUMENT. This Contract consists of this document and Exhibits I, J, and K. The foregoing constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and any change or modification to this Contract must be in writing, as mutually agreed to by the parties.

BINDING EFFECT. This Contract will be binding on and inure to the benefit of the respective successors and assigns of the State and the Contractor.

AMENDMENTS – WAIVER. No amendment or modification of this Contract will be effective unless it is in writing and signed by both parties. The failure of either party at any time to demand strict performance by the other party of any of the terms of this Contract will not be construed as a waiver of any such term, and either party may at any time demand strict and complete performance by the other party.

SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Contract is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be contrary to law, the remaining provisions of this Contract will remain in full force and affect.

CONSTRUCTION. This Contract will be construed in accordance with the plain meaning of its language and neither for nor against the drafting party.

NOTICES. For any notice under this Contract to be effective it must be made in writing and sent to the address of the appropriate party first appearing above, unless such party has notified the other party, in accordance with the provisions of this section, of a new mailing address. This notice requirement will not apply to any notices that this Contract expressly authorizes to be made orally.

CONTINUING OBLIGATIONS. The terms, conditions, representations, and warranties contained in this Contract will survive the termination or expiration of the time for completion of any Deliverable and the time for meeting any final payment of compensation.

ORDER OF PRIORITY. If there is any inconsistency or conflict between this document and any provision of anything incorporated by reference, this document will prevail.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This Contract consists of this document and Exhibit I, J, and K. The foregoing constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and any changes or modifications to this Contract must be in writing, as mutually agreed to by the parties.

LAW. This Contract is governed by and will be construed under Ohio law, and venue for any dispute will be with the appropriate court in Franklin County, Ohio.

TO SHOW THEIR AGREEMENT, the parties have executed this Contract on the date(s) below and unless otherwise indicated is effective as of the date of signature by the State.

THIS ADDENDUM (the "Addendum") is between the State of Ohio (the "State"), through its Department of Administrative Services, and GoldTech of Ohio, an authorized agent on the Cisco Systems, Inc. State Term Schedule ("Goldtech"). This Addendum contains additional contractual terms between the State and Contractor under Cisco's State Term Schedule Number 533110-3 (the "Contract").

This Addendum establishes additional terms for a two-year period between the State and GoldTech related to provision of enterprise Cisco SMARTnet Services for Participating State Agencies. The term begins July 1, 2011 and ends June 30, 2013. Some State agencies have expressed interest in participating in a fixed-price, two-year enterprise Cisco SMARTnet Services commitment for fiscal year 2012 and fiscal year 2013 providing additional discounting based upon the State's aggregated volume for the two-year period. That additional discounting will represent a minimum discount of 25% from Cisco's current list price for its SMARTnet Services. In the event that not all agencies initially expressing interest in participating in this Addendum commit to participating in the program, the parties agree that the level of discounting and pricing quoted for the remaining agencies (each a "Participating State Agency") will remain unchanged. Agencies that do not participate in this special program will not be entitled to this level of discounting.

Purchase Orders: Each Participating State Agency with funds appropriated to cover their Cisco SMARTnet Services will annually issue a purchase order in an amount equal to that agency's Annual Payment amount for the applicable fiscal year. Participating State Agencies will issue a purchase order preferably by no later than July 30th of each fiscal year, unless an extension is mutually agreed upon by both parties. Establishing a July 30th purchase order deadline allows for a maximum thirty-day grace period for a Participating State Agency to complete processes required to issue a purchase order at the beginning of each fiscal year. The Participating State Agency's purchase order must state that it is for Cisco SMARTnet Services at Enterprise Rates.

Payments: Each Participating State Agency shall promptly pay annual payments upon receipt of a proper invoice from GoldTech in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in the Contract. The payment obligations hereunder of each Participating State Agency are subject to the non-appropriation provisions in the Contract as well as all prerequisites therein for a payment obligation to be binding on the State.

Annual Reconciliation: GoldTech agrees that items that are taken out of service can be removed from Cisco SMARTnet Services, and that a credit will be issued for the remaining prorated amount of services from the date GoldTech acknowledges receipt of the Participating Agency's request to remove the item from service coverage. Cisco requires a sixty (60) day notice for credit requests. Any potential credits issued will not be issued until the following yearly renewal, and will be limited to a credit with GoldTech for Cisco SMARTnet Services. GoldTech agrees that items may be added to maintenance as necessary, for an amount prorated through the end of the FY in which they were added, and then annually for the duration of this contract, at the same discount level afforded by this Addendum. All items will have a maintenance end


date of June 30th of the FY in which they were added. Annual Reconciliation: GoldTech agrees that items that are taken out of service can be removed from Cisco SMARTnet Services, and that a credit will be issued for the remaining prorated amount of services from the date GoldTech acknowledges receipt of the Participating Agency's request to remove the item from service coverage. Cisco requires a sixty (60) day notice for credit requests. Any potential credits issued will not be issued until the following yearly renewal, and will be limited to a credit with GoldTech for Cisco SMARTnet Services. GoldTech agrees that items may be added to maintenance as necessary, for an amount prorated through the end of the FY in which they were added, and then annually for the duration of this contract, at the same discount level afforded by this Addendum. All items will have a maintenance end date of June 30th of the FY in which they were added. Any items that are added after this Addendum begins will require additional payment and will be billed to the participating state agency that placed the item on the maintenance agreement when added. Additions, changes and removals from maintenance will be reported to GoldTech for proper tracking via email; which will include model number and serial number of the device being reported-on. GoldTech has an established point of contact for all SMARTnet matters to include reporting of changes, additions and removals. GoldTech will respond to all requests for such changes in a prompt manner not to exceed 3 business days. All individual Cisco SMARTnet Service items pricing afforded by this addendum is fixed for the duration of this addendum.

Reporting:

GoldTech shall provide a copy of all orders actually placed by participating state agencies under this addendum including annual reconciliations to the Department of Administrative Services. This information will be delivered within thirty (30) days of the order, or reconciliation in pdf format via email to: State.ITStandards.Manager@OIT.Ohio.Gov

Except as expressly modified in this addendum, all of GoldTech's and the State's rights and obligations under the contract will remain unchanged. This Addendum will be deemed as fully executed upon signature of all referenced parties.
