

Clarification to the RFGA for Quality Infrastructure:

The grant is intended to assist with both the 2020 and 2025 Step Up To Quality goals. The funding may be for the following items:

1. To serve new providers not licensed, new to the system but that open to serve PFCC
2. Current licensed providers not serving PFCC that sign an agreement
3. Current licensed provider serving PFCC not rated to become rated
4. Current licensed providers serving PFCC, rated a 1 or 2 to become a 3, 4 or 5
5. Those serving PFCC rated 3, 4 or 5 that need help to maintain.

Concerns have been also raised about the template agreement attached to the RFGA. This program is not federally funded and will **not** be reimbursement based **nor** will grantees have to comply with provisions of 2 CFR Part 200.

The RFGA opportunity closes on January 15, 2019.
