The Offeror shall obtain and comply with any/all air quality, water quality and other permits that may be required such as a site Stormwater Discharge Permit or National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit, if required. The Contractor shall install silt fencing to manage storm water runoff in the immediate work area as necessary.
2. For projects extending longer than two months in duration, the Offeror will be responsible for monthly progress reporting, a summary of work completed each month, and revised cost and schedule estimates based on completed work. Contractors must submit with each invoice, copies of daily logs, certified weight tickets, and receipts and any other materials deemed relevant to the progress of the Project.
3. It is expressly understood that none of the rights, duties and obligations described in this Proposal shall be binding on the State if the State has not obtained a lawful right of entry onto the property or properties.
