TITLING ALL-PURPOSE VEHICLES (APVs), UTILITY VEHICLES (UTVs), AND LOW
SPEED VEHICLES (LSVs)**

**REPLACING BROADCAST 14-0813 (REPEALED) – TITLING ALL-PURPOSE VEHICLES (APVs)
AND UTILITY VEHICLES (UTVs)**

All-purpose vehicles (APVs) are required to be titled even if the APV is used exclusively on private property or for agricultural purposes.

An APV is defined as “any self-propelled vehicle designed primarily for cross-country travel on land and water, or on more than one type of terrain, and steered by wheels or caterpillar treads, or any combination thereof, including vehicles that operate on a cushion of air, vehicles commonly known as all-terrain vehicles, all-season vehicles, mini-bikes, and trail bikes.” An APV does not include “a utility vehicle as defined in section 4501.01 of the Revised Code or any vehicle principally used in playing golf, any motor vehicle or aircraft required to be registered under Chapter 4503 or 4561 of the Revised Code, and any vehicle excepted from definition as a motor vehicle by division (B) of section 4501.01 of the Revised Code.” R.C. 4519.01(B).

Utility vehicles (UTVs) are generally not required to be titled because they are excluded from the definition of “motor vehicle” that is contained in R.C. 4501.01(B). A UTV is defined as “a self-propelled vehicle designed with a bed, principally for the purpose of transporting material or cargo in connection with construction, agricultural, forestry, grounds maintenance, lawn and garden, materials handling, or similar activities.” A UTV includes “a vehicle with a maximum attainable speed of twenty miles per hour or less that is used exclusively within the boundaries of state parks by state park employees or volunteers for the operation or maintenance of state park facilities.” R.C. 4501.01(VV).

Low speed vehicles (LSVs) are titled vehicles and are defined as a “motor vehicle” pursuant to R.C. 4501.01 (B); however, there is no separate definition for LSVs until Senate Bill 114 becomes effective. Therefore, the title procedures for an LSV will be the same as a UTV until such time.

A UTV and LSV shall be titled as an APV if the owner requests that it be titled for limited on-road use as permitted by local ordinances or regulations. The owner will need to complete the BMV 3722 Affidavit



IMPORTED VEHICLES HS-7 DECLARATION FORM

- Box 1** Title & Register. Vehicle is 25 or more years old. Requires Customs document and proof of age. Acceptable proof for age of vehicle is title, registration, factory letter, or verification by a recognized club or organization.
- Box 2A** Title & Register. Certification label states that vehicle meets all Federal motor vehicle safety standards (FMVSS). Vehicles imported from Puerto Rico, the Northern Mariana Islands, Guam, American Samoa, and the Virgin Islands should have this label. Canadian vehicles manufactured before 1-1-96 may have a label that looks like the U.S. label. These vehicles require a letter from the manufacturer stating that the vehicle complies with all U.S. FMVSS and a Customs entry document. If the manufacturer's letter notes any exceptions, the vehicle must follow the procedures for Box 2B or Box 3 entry.
- Box 2B** Title & Register. Vehicle certified to Canadian standards. Requires Customs entry document and a letter from the manufacturer stating that the vehicle complies with all U.S. FMVSS except for minor labeling.

- Box 4** No title. No registration. Not for use in the U.S.
- Box 5** No title. Vehicle may be temporarily registered in the U.S. for up to one year. Vehicle cannot be sold and must be exported within one year.
- Box 6** No title. No registration. Vehicle must be registered through the State Department. Vehicle cannot be sold and must be exported after tour of duty.
- Box 7** A. No title. Requires a DOT approval letter to be temporarily registered for one year. (DOT approval not required if importer certifies vehicles for U.S. i.e. BMW, Honda, etc.) Registration may be extended if DOT has issued an approval letter extending the temporary importation of the vehicle.
B. No registration. Requires a DOT approval letter. Cannot be registered for on-road use or sold until the vehicle is 25 years old.
- Box 8** Vehicle may be titled for off-road use only. No registration.
- Box 9** Incomplete vehicle. Vehicle must be completed and certified by a final stage manufacturer before the vehicle can be titled and registered. Vehicle must have a final stage manufacturer's certification label.
- Box 12** No title. Vehicle may be temporarily registered in the U.S. for the tour of duty identified in the official orders of foreign military personnel. Vehicle cannot be sold and must be exported after tour of duty.

RE: Certificate of Title to an Unclaimed Motor Vehicle per R.C. 4505.101 Pursuant to Senate Bill 274, Effective Date 3/23/2015

R.C. 4505.101 has been amended to include towing services and storage facilities in addition to repair garages and places of storage, as authorized to file an unclaimed motor vehicle affidavit upon all of the completed requirements.

Division (A) of section R.C. 4505.101 sets forth the requirements for any repair garage or place of storage in order to file an unclaimed motor vehicle affidavit.

- Motor vehicle value must be less than \$3500 (*motor vehicle value to be discussed below*).
- The motor vehicle has been unclaimed for 15 days or more following the completion of the requested repairs or the agreed term of storage.
- A search of the records of the bureau of motor vehicles must be completed. (*Pursuant to R.C. 4505.14 a search of the records of the bureau of motor vehicles upon application and payment of the proper fee may be conducted by the registrar of motor vehicles or the clerk of courts.*)
- Notification to the last known address of any owner and any lienholder (that includes where the motor vehicle is located and the value of the vehicle) shall be sent by certified mail with the request of a returned receipt.
- If the motor vehicle remains unclaimed by any owner or lienholder for 15 days after notices were mailed and a signed receipt from the certified mail or notification the delivery was not possible has been received, they may file an unclaimed motor vehicle affidavit to obtain the certificate of title.

Division (B) of section R.C. 4505.101 sets forth the requirements for any towing service or storage facility in order to file an unclaimed motor vehicle affidavit.

- The vehicle was towed under division (B) of section R.C. 4513.601 Private tow-away zones.
- Motor vehicle value must be less than \$3500 (*motor vehicle value to be discussed below*).
- A search of the records of the bureau of motor vehicles must be made immediately. (*Pursuant to R.C. 4505.14 a search of the records of the bureau of motor vehicles upon application and payment of the proper fee may be conducted by the registrar of motor vehicles or the clerk of courts.*)
- Notification to the last known address of any owner and any lienholder shall be sent by certified mail or express mail with the request of a returned receipt, within 5 **business** days of the removal of the motor vehicle.
- If the motor vehicle remains unclaimed for 30 days from the 1st notice, and there is **no evidence** of a receipt signed by any person or notification the delivery was not possible, the towing service or storage facility shall send notification to the last known address of any owner and any lienholder by certified mail or express mail with the request of a returned receipt.
 - The R.C. is specific to the number of days, therefore the notice must be sent NO LATER than the 31st day.
- If the motor vehicle remains unclaimed for 45 days from the 1st notice, and there is **no evidence** of a receipt signed by any person or notification the delivery was not possible, the towing service or storage facility shall send notification to the last known address of any owner and any lienholder by certified mail or express mail with the request of a returned receipt.
 - The R.C. is specific to the number of days, therefore the notice must be sent NO LATER than the 46th day.
- If the motor vehicle remains unclaimed for 60 days from **any notice** and **evidence of a receipt signed by any person or notification the delivery was not possible, has been received** by the towing service or storage facility, they may initiate the unclaimed motor vehicle affidavit process.
- If the motor vehicle remains unclaimed and **evidence of a receipt signed by any person or notification the delivery was not possible, has NEVER been received** by the towing service or storage facility, they shall **NOT** obtain or attempt to

obtain a certificate of title to the motor vehicle using the unclaimed motor vehicle affidavit. They **must** apply for a court ordered title.

The "**Value**" means the wholesale value for the make and model of the motor vehicle as provided in a vehicle valuation guide that is recognized by the motor vehicle industry.

Both of the following deductions may be subtracted:

1. Estimated cost of repairs to restore the motor vehicle to the wholesale value for that make and model of motor vehicle.
2. The cost of the agreed-upon repairs.

NOTE: Owners of a towing service or storage facility may obtain a title for those motor vehicles that they came into possession between January 31, 2012 and March 23, 2015 (the effective date of S.B. 274). The following requirements are as follows:

- The vehicle must have been towed under division (B) of section 4513.60 Private tow-away zones.
- The value of the motor vehicle is less than \$3500 (see value above).
- The initial notification to the last known address of any owner and any lienholder shall be sent by certified mail or express mail with the request of a returned receipt **not later than 30 days after March 23, 2015** (effective date of S.B. 274).
- If the motor vehicle remains unclaimed for 30 days from the 1st notice, and there is **no evidence** of a receipt signed by any person or notification the delivery was not possible, the towing service or storage facility shall send notification to the last known address of any owner and any lienholder by certified mail or express mail with the request of a returned receipt.
 - The R.C. is specific to the number of days, therefore the notice must be sent NO LATER than the 31st day.
- If the motor vehicle remains unclaimed for 45 days from the 1st notice, and there is **no evidence** of a receipt signed by any person or notification the delivery was not possible, the towing service or storage facility shall send notification to the last known address of any owner and any lienholder by certified mail or express mail with the request of a returned receipt.
 - The R.C. is specific to the number of days, therefore the notice must be sent NO LATER than the 46th day.

- If the motor vehicle remains unclaimed for 60 days from any notice and evidence of a receipt signed by any person or notification the delivery was not possible, has been received by the towing service or storage facility, they may initiate the unclaimed motor vehicle affidavit process.
- If the motor vehicle remains unclaimed and evidence of a receipt signed by any person or notification the delivery was not possible has NEVER been received by the towing service or storage facility, they shall **NOT** obtain or attempt to obtain a certificate of title to the motor vehicle using the unclaimed motor vehicle affidavit. They **must** apply for a court ordered title.

NOTE: The owner of a repair garage or place of storage may obtain a title for those motor vehicles that they came into possession between January 31, 2012 and March 23, 2015 (the effective date of S.B. 274). The following requirements are as follows:

- The value of the motor vehicle is at least \$2500 but less than \$3500 (see value above).
 - The value of the motor vehicle may be less than \$2500 for those vehicles that came into possession prior to March 23, 2015 (effective date of S.B. 274).
- The motor vehicle has been unclaimed for 15 days or more following the completion of the requested repair or the agreed term of storage.
- The initial notification to the last known address of any owner and any lienholder shall be sent by certified mail with the request of a returned receipt not later than 30 days after March 23, 2015 (effective date of S.B. 274).

If a clerk feels that the documentation submitted with an unclaimed motor vehicle affidavit is not complete or does not satisfy the requirements, the clerk may request additional documentation.

REPLACING BROADCAST 15-0210 (REPEALED) – OUT OF STATE INSPECTIONS

Effective immediately, the State of Ohio will no longer accept out of state inspections unless the inspection is completed by an Ohio Licensed Motor Vehicle Dealer, Ohio Deputy Registrar, or Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) Investigator and is reported on a BMV 3706 form. This Broadcast supersedes and repeals previous Broadcast 15-0210. Inspections reported on forms issued by any state other than Ohio shall not be accepted.

Only two exceptions are permitted:

1. An inspection report completed by a United States Military Authority for an Ohio military person or dependent who holds an Ohio Driver License or Ohio identification (ID) card, but is stationed outside the state of Ohio; and,
2. An inspection report completed by an out-of-state Law Enforcement Officer for an Ohio resident who holds an Ohio Driver License or Ohio identification (ID) card, but is living temporarily outside the state of Ohio. [For example, Ohio residents living out-of-state temporarily (“Snowbirds,”) attending schools or colleges out-of-state, or temporarily working construction out-of-state, etc.).

The BMV is preparing a new form for use by persons who may qualify for exceptions 1 and 2 above, and will post the form on the BMV website as soon as possible.

Vehicles Imported from Canada and Other Foreign Countries

This Broadcast 15-1016 replaces and repeals Title Broadcast 15-0508.

A resident of Ohio or a business operating at a specific location within the State of Ohio may apply for an Ohio title for a motor vehicle imported into Ohio from Canada or other foreign country. Imported vehicles coming into Ohio from Canada and other foreign countries should include all of the following documents:

- 1- **Bill of sale.**
- 2- **Canadian or foreign title or registration.**
- 3- **United States Customs Entry Form 7501**, stamped or signed verifying that **Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) document 3520** and U.S. Department of Transportation (**DOT) Form HS-7** have been viewed and approved.
- 4- **U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) Form HS-7** stating that the vehicle meets all U.S. DOT safety standards, **or, if box #3** is checked, an **Original Bond Release Letter** from US Department of Transportation National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to verify that Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards have been, or will be, met. In addition, if any other box is checked, any additional requirements specified on the HS-7 Declaration form also must be met.
- 5- **Odometer Statement(s) signed by both the Seller and Purchaser** in accordance with federal and Ohio requirements.
- 6- **Out of State Inspection BMV Form 3706.** The BMV 3706 must be completed and signed by an Ohio Licensed Auto Dealer or an Ohio Deputy Registrar Agency. Inspections performed by other state dealers or authorities are not acceptable, see Title Broadcast 15-1006.
- 7- **English translations** of all documents written in a foreign language. The foreign documentation must be translated by an accredited institution and submitted on that institution's letterhead.

If you are presented with the above items, you are within Ohio guidelines to issue a title. Otherwise, you may reject the application. You are not required to issue a title to any

individual who is not a resident of the State of Ohio or to any business or entity that does not maintain a place of business in Ohio.




